

- Visitors can take the Doha Metro directly to five of the nine stadiums, with the remaining three venues served by a combination of metro and shuttle bus services.
- The Doha Metro is also directly connected to Hamad International Airport, the main hub for visitors travelling to Qatar.
- Taxis are plentiful and competitively priced, with multiple ridesharing apps available in Qatar. This also includes the possibility of booking wheelchair accessible taxis.
- Msheireb Downtown Doha, Education City and Lusail all have light rail tram systems in addition to the city's public transportation system.

The average temperature in January and February – when the tournament will be held – is 15-24C (59-75F).




Qatar has extensive international cuisine options and a host of food delivery services. All food in Qatar is Halal compliant and most restaurants offer vegetarian options.



Media Accreditation

Accreditation is an integral part of the overall security and access management of the AFC Asian Cup Qatar 2023™. Accredited media will have access to the certain matches, once they are confirmed with their media ticket. Every media must apply for a media ticket to cover the matches:

An additional ticket will be issued electronically with an assigned seat for the Media Tribune.

Bib tickets (physical ticket) will be issued to Photographers indicating position on the field of play from positions 1 -150.



Accreditation Terms & Conditions

The Accreditation Card is the property of the AFC and can be withdrawn, with immediate effect for any reason, with or without cause. This Accreditation Card does not give the bearer the right to a spectator seat to watch any AFC Asian Cup Qatar 2023™ match and must be always worn visibly.

The Accreditation Card is personal to the bearer named in this card and strictly non-transferable. If this Accreditation Card is lost or found, please contact the Accreditation Desk at the venues or at the Main Accreditation Centre (DEC) or at the Main Media Centre (MMC) in Msheireb.

Media Ticketing

The Accreditation Card does not guarantee the holder a seat at the Media Tribune or the Photo positions behind the A-boards. Each stakeholder – PRE, PHO and NRH – will have to apply for a match ticket to be able to have a position during the match.

Below is the priority procedure which will be applied for allocation of seats (approval):

- 1. Media from the playing countries (Team A & Team B)
- 2. Media from the host country (Qatar)
- 3. All other media



Media Tribune

- Written Press (PRE) and Non-Rights Holding broadcasters (NRH) will have to apply for a particular match ticket through their respective AFC Media Channel accounts.
- The application window for each match will open 48 hours prior to the kickoff until 24 hours to the kickoff. The AFC will review the application against the number of seats available in the Media Tribune. Written Press then needs to go and select their seat while Non Rights Holders will be automatically allocated an Observer seat.
- Once approved, the written press applicant may login to their respective account and select their preferred seat in the tribune.
- The written press applicant will then receive an email with an
 e-ticket for their selected seat. This e-ticket must be presented
 at the entrance of the Media Tribune together with the holder's
 accreditation card.
- Upon review of applications based on the priority list, the photographers will receive approval/rejection email from the AFC on MD-1. Those approved photographers will have to login again to their AFC Media Channel accounts at provided timings (based on the priority list) to select the seat (e.g. seats from 1-150).



Photographer Positions (Pitch and Media Tribune)

- Like the Media Tribune concept, the Photographers (PHO) wishing to cover the match from the pitch positions, or the Media Tribune photo positions will have to apply for a ticket online through their respective AFC Media Channel accounts.
- The application window for each match will open 48 hours prior to the kickoff until 24 hours to the kickoff.
- While applying for the match ticket, the photographer will have to select whether he/she would like to cover the match from the Media Tribune photo position or the pitch position.
- Upon review of applications based on the priority list, the photographers will receive approval/rejection email from the AFC on MD-1. Those approved photographers will have to login again to their AFC Media Channel accounts to select the seat (e.g. seats from 1-150).



- Upon selection of the seat, the photographers will receive an email confirmation of their selected seat, which they will have to present to collect the bib ticket at the Main Media Centre (MMC) on MD-1 or the Stadium Media Centre (SMC) on the match day.
- Those who missed the ticket application deadline (-48 to -24 hours to kickoff) and wish to cover the match, may register their names on the waitlist at the MMC until end of the MD-1 operation hours. Waitlisted media will receive an email notification (only if they are approved), and the tickets shall be collected from the Stadium Media Centre (SMC) on match day.



Accreditation collection


All the media who have received accreditation confirmation email, may collect their accreditation cards from the Main Accreditation Centre at the Doha Exhibition Centre (DEC) or from the Main Media Centre (MMC) in Msheireb.

The media will have to present the approval email apart from his or her passport or Qatar Resident ID as proof to collect the card.

Photographer bib collection

All accredited photographers will have to always wear a bib (dark green) during official activities. The bibs can be collected from the Main Media Centre at Msheireb after collecting the accreditation card.





Hayya Media Portal (HMP)

The Hayya Media Portal (HMP) offers media and broadcast representatives attending the AFC Asian Cup Qatar 2023™ access to a range of services and essential permits to enter and operate in Qatar.

Services offered include:

- Tournament Media Accreditation (subject to receiving Accreditation Authorisation Letter from AFC Media Channel)
- Mandatory Hayya entry permit for all media and broadcast representatives attending the AFC Asian Cup
- Mandatory filming and photography permits for all media and broadcast representatives attending the AFC Asian Cup™ and entering Qatar with cameras and photography equipment
- Facilitation of hand-carry equipment clearance procedures

Registration

All media and broadcast representatives are required to complete their application process on the HMP promptly upon receiving the Accreditation Authorisation Letter from the AFC Media Channel.



Once the Registration Form is completed and approvals granted, the applicant will receive an Entry Permit, a nationwide filming and photography permit, and AFC Media Accreditation at the same time.

Equipment holders

All media and broadcast (who plan to bring hand-carry equipment) representatives are required to apply for their accreditation via the HMP.

Media and broadcast representatives must choose their correct category and role, mirroring the selection made on the AFC Media Channel.

Successful media and broadcast applicants will receive their AFC Media Accreditation confirmation via email. The Accreditation Card should be printed upon arriving in Doha.

Accreditation Pick Up Points:

- Doha Exhibition Centre (DEC)
- Main Media Center (MMC) in Msheireb



Spectrum License and Application Process

Media who need to use radio equipment within AFC Asian Cup Qatar 2023™ venues must register the equipment through the spectrum portal and obtain the necessary permits and licenses from the Communication Regulatory Authority (CRA).

All licensed and license-exempt radio devices will require approval prior to use within AFC Asian Cup Qatar 2023™ venues. This applies to radio devices that are already licensed/ authorized to operate in Qatar (both licensed and license-exempt categories), including systems and devices already in use in the stadiums and other venues.

Radio Frequency (RF) assignment and coordination is necessary as it ensures interference- free operation, the safety and security of life and property, assures regulatory compliance, and optimizes the wireless delivery networks of the AFC Asian Cup Qatar 2023™.

Licensed Spectrum

Licensed spectrum refers to radio frequencies for which an individual license for use must be issued by the CRA. The license for use grants exclusive rights to the license holder to use the licensed spectrum (frequency) without the likelihood of interference from other users.

Licensed spectrum will be used at AFC Asian Cup Qatar 2023™ principally by broadcasters who require dedicated frequencies for use by wireless cameras, talkback systems and other broadcast-critical wireless systems which do not fall under license-exempt (mainly short-range devices) category.

The license granted by CRA authorizes a licensee to install or use radio equipment in a clearly defined way. A license consists of a license document, a set of general terms and conditions and a license schedule or schedules. Without a license, it is not possible to import or use equipment in the country. The use of radio equipment without a valid license is a criminal offence in the State of Oatar.

License-Exempt Spectrum

License-exempt spectrum can be used by wireless devices without a frequency license. Use of license-exempt spectrum must still comply with the national government's pre-defined technical parameters (e.g., transmission power levels).

For the AFC Asian Cup, Qatar 2023™ devices which utilize licenseexempt spectrum must still be registered with the CRA before being permitted for use at any official tournament sites.

License-exempt spectrum is used for a multitude of applications but the most notable uses at the AFC Asian Cup, Qatar 2023™ shall be:

- · Wireless microphones (Low Power)
- Wireless Local Area Networks (WLAN), commonly known as Wi-Fi.
- DECT-based cordless telephony and intercom systems, often used by broadcasters and referee communication systems, etc.

The use of license-exempt transmitting devices shall be minimized across all official AFC Asian Cup, Qatar 2023™ sites and shall be carefully coordinated to mitigate interferences issues. Only license-exempt transmitting devices with a legitimate operational purpose shall be permitted by the CRA.

Spectrum Application Process

Anyone wishing to use licensed or licenseexempt radio spectrum must submit an application via the CRA e-Spectrum Portal. Portal access must first be requested through the responsible AFC Asian Cup Qatar 2023™ contact. For registration, the CRA will send an invitation email with details of how to access the portal and create an account.

Once an application has been submitted, the CRA will check it for any potential errors and then complete processing. If any issues with the application are found, the CRA will contact the applicant to seek clarification.

Interference Monitoring and Enforcement

The CRA will deploy spectrum monitoring teams at each stadium on match days, to actively monitor for any unauthorized radio transmissions, find the source of the transmission and resolve the issue. They will also conduct physical checks on equipment in operation in the venue to assess that devices are in compliance with the licenses they have been issued.

If any radio equipment is discovered to be operating in a venue without CRA license / authorization, then it will be shut down, until the user gets it approved from CRA.

Exclusions

The following devices are exempt from this process:

- 1. Mobile telephones (Note: Tethering of phones or using them as mobile hotspots is not permitted)
- 2. Personal Bluetooth devices such as headsets, keyboards, mice, wearable electronics, etc.
- 3. Personal tablet devices
- 4. PCs (Laptops / Desktops)
- 5. Car key fobs

Airport Customs Procedures

Upon arrival at the airport, accredited media first proceed through immigration (passport) control and then collect their luggage. A fast-track lane will be designated to all AFC accredited personnel. The fast-track lane can be identified by the AFC Asian Cup Qatar 2023™ logo, which will be shown on the screen above the immigration desk. The fast-track lane will be operational for the period of 2nd January 2024 – 10th February 2024.

Once the luggage is collected, passengers should proceed through the screening area and then follow one of the customs channels.



Media Entity Equipment Clearance

Media and Broadcasters traveling by air or by land can apply for Equipment Custom Clearance via the Hayya Media Portal (HMP) for the Broadcast & Photo equipment brought with them as hand carried or checked in luggage. Media and Broadcasters need to declare their equipment details through the form made available post the completion of the Registration Form.

The form is made available through a pop-up on HMP with a 'Declare Now' option.

HMP users who have been approved on the portal and received their Hayya Entry Permit will need to log in to the HMP portal, after which they will be redirected to the 'Logged In' User Page.

Hayya Media Portal Users who have selected "YES" to bring equipment, at the end of the main registration form, will receive email reminders to declare their equipment using the same process.



Important Notes

 Media and Broadcasters who intend to bring Hand Carry equipment must complete the Hand Carry Form at least 2 weeks ahead of arrival.

 In the event that equipment is not declared through the submission of the Hand Carry form, equipment may be stopped at the airport or the border.

 Any equipment requiring Radio or Wireless Frequencies allocation must be declared through the form on the Hayya Media Portal at least 2 weeks ahead of arrival.

 All the information provided in the form must be accurate, any incorrect information provided may lead to rejection of the application – the reason for rejection will be shared.

- In case of rejection, a new application must be submitted with correct information for further processing.
- Media and Broadcasters that have already received the CRA license via the CRA Spectrum portal must mention the Authorization Reference Number on the form.
- Media and Broadcasters must agree to the Terms & Conditions of equipment clearance before submitting the form.
- Personal Items are not to be included in the form such as mobile phones, iPads, headphones, make-up, keys and the like.

Approval Notification

Approval of equipment list will be sent by email with an attached document that contains details of all submitted equipment. This document needs to be presented in electronic or printed form at the Customs Counter at the airport or the border upon arrival.

In Case of Rejection

If the application is rejected, applicants will be notified by email and the reason for rejection will be provided. Applicants may resubmit a new application after rectifying the data as advised in the rejection note.

Applying for a New List of Equipment

To apply for clearance for a new list of equipment, applicants can submit a new equipment form with the details of the additional equipment.

Please note that each application will undergo the approval process separately & applicants will receive approvals separately for each submitted application.

Media Entity Freight Shipments

- Media that intend to ship equipment and material through Air or Sea Freight must follow standard Customs Procedures detailed in the Customs Clearance Policy.
- Shipping requires the identification of a recognised shipping company.

Photography / Filming Permits

Filming and photography across the State of Qatar are allowed during the tournament by the AFC accredited media registered and approved via the Hayya Media Portal (HMP).

All accredited media and broadcast representatives entering the country with camera and photography equipment are required to obtain the relevant permits required to operate during the tournament.

Filming Permits will be generated as part of the Hayya Accreditation / Entry Permit application submission.

The filming and photography permit does not allow filming with drones.

The permit for filming and photography in public spaces is mandated in the Terms & Conditions of the Hayya Media Portal.

The Filming Permit icon on the Accreditation enables Media to take photos and videos around Qatar at touristic locations and open spaces. Filming Permits do not permit the holder to film or take photos in restricted areas. These areas are marked with clear signs showing 'no film' and 'no photos', or if instructed by security personnel. These locations are also stated in the Application Terms & Conditions on the Qatar Media Portal.









Recommended Media Hotels

Centro Capital Doha

Centro Capital Doha Hotel is 9 minutes away by car to MMC. It is 650 m (9-minute

walk) away from Bin Mahmoud metro station, which is connected to Msheireb metro station. MMC is within walking distance, about 400 metres away from the Msheireb metro station.

For media to be able to book in **Centro Capital Hotel**, media must provide AFC Media Channel provisional approval and email abed.moubayed@rotana.com directly to book the preferred rate.

Four Points by Sheraton

Four Points by Sheraton is a 7-minute walk from Msheireb metro station and 10-minute walk from the MMC.



Transport Information



Media transportation will be provided for AFC accredited media from the MMC to stadiums on matchdays only, and from MMC to official training sites on Match Day -1 official training session only.

In case of any questions, media can address their queries to the information desk located at the MMC or the stadiums.

Main Media Centre (MMC) to Stadiums

A dedicated shuttle service will be provided from the MMC to stadiums on match days only. The media drop-off and pick-up point at the stadiums are in the vicinity of the media gates.

Shuttle services are planned with a frequency about every 30 minutes, between KO -4 hours till KO -1 hour (arrival at the stadium). Return from stadiums to main media centre start 30 minutes after the final whistle until FW +2.

No shuttle service will be offered between KO -1 hour until 30 minutes after the final whistle.

Media bus service for Stadiums

MMC ←→ Stadiums (Match-days only)

Dedicated shuttle service will be provided from MMC to Stadiums on Match-days.

- First bus will arrive at the stadiums at KO-4 hours.
- Shuttle service will operate at every 30 minutes between KO-4 hours until KO-1 hours.
- There will be no service from KO-1 to FW+30 minutes.

STADIUMS ←→ MMC

• Shuttle service will run from the stadiums to MMC from FW+30 until FW+2 hours at every 30 minutes.



Media bus service for training sites

MMC ← Team base camp training sites (MD-1 only)

- One round trip shuttle service will be provided for all official MD-1 training sessions.
- One bus service will arrive at TBCTS 45 minutes before training session start.
- Departure time from MMC will be published depending upon travel time to various TBCTS. You may also seek for further assistance at the Help Desk in the MMC.
- Return shuttle departs from TBCTS 60 minutes after start of training session.
- Due to limited spaces, this is a first come first serve service.



Media Parking and VAPPs

To use private or rented cars and access media parking at the stadiums, accredited media must present the relevant Vehicle Access and Parking Permits (VAPP) at traffic control points (TCPs) and vehicle permit checkpoints (VPCs).



Access to media parking at the MMC and training sites does not require a VAPP. MMC parking will require media to request parking tickets at the parking entrance barriers. Details regarding the parking tickets will be communicated via the MMC welcome desk on the ground floor. MMC parking tickets will be provided for free on a first come first served basis.

All VAPPs are provided free of charge, but requests are subject to approval based on the media parking capacity of each stadium.

Stadium VAPP

All media will have to apply for match specific VAPP through their respective AFC Media Channel accounts. The application window for each match will open 48 hours prior to the kickoff until 24 hours to the kickoff. The AFC will review the application against the number of parking spots available at each stadium and allocate the VAPPs based on priority procedure. The approved applicants will then receive an email with their approval. The match-day specific VAPP is non-transferable and can be collected by media representatives at the media welcome desk at the MMC.

Those who missed the VAPP application deadline (-48 to -24 hours to kickoff) may register their names on the waitlist at the MMC until end of the MD-1 operation hours. Waitlisted media will receive an email notification (only if they are approved), and the tickets shall be collected from the MMC on match day.

Each VAPP includes a QR code at the back which can be used to access the stadium map, check the location of Media Parking (P4) and show coordinates to reach the destination.

Each VAPP will be scanned by access control at the media car park entrance before access can be granted to the stadium car park.

Public Transport

Qatar has a modern public transport system that provides high level of accessibility and quality services within all areas across the country. Mowasalat-Karwa provides a frequent, reliable bus service throughout Doha and to all major communities in Qatar.

Mowasalat operates a total of 50 routes, starting from 04:00 with last buses timed to depart around 23:00.

Metro

Doha metro

Doha Metro is a rapid transit system, composed of a three-line network that covers all the significant parts of Doha.

Taxi

Taxi services are widely used in Qatar. Karwa is the official taxi service in Qatar, and can be found at most locations or can be booked through the app. There are other ride-sharing apps available such as Uber, Taxi F and Ryde. Taxi pick up and drop off at the stadiums are usually near the spectators' entrance and may require walking to the media entrance. Karwa also provides wheelchair accessible taxis.

How To Connect

Please ensure your devices are compatible with the 5 GHz network as 2.4 GHz will not be broadcast. Relevant information can be found in the technical characteristics of your devices.

To ensure better internet services for all participants, the usage of unmanaged switches, routers, and access points (Mi-Fi) is not permitted as well as tethering of phones or using them as mobile hotspots. Spectrum management will monitor the



Main Media Centre, stadiums and training sites where the Event Network is available to avoid interference with the organiser's Wi-Fi network.

Internet Connectivity

All media areas in the stadiums, MMC, and training sites will be equipped with dedicated Wi-fi for media. We recommend using wired connections in the respective media areas.

It is recommended that media representatives check their devices for on-board Ethernet ports and bring the necessary personal RJ45 adaptors.

Power

Qatar operates on a supply voltage of 240 volts and 50Hz on UK Type G plugs.

Photographers (PHO) Guidelines


The following guidelines will help you maximize your coverage whilst safeguarding the commercial interests of the AFC and AFC's commercial partners.

Access Areas

The AFC will grant Photographers (PHOs) access to the following:

- 1. Main Media Centre (MMC) / Stadium Media Centre (SMC)
- Subject to space availability. The SMCs will be closed on nonmatchdays. MMC operation hours will be available on the AFC Media Channel
- 2. Official training sessions at the official training sites
- Open for at least the first 15 minutes and subject to space availability
- Only operate in area designated by the AFC and/or Host Organisation
- · Wearing of appropriate bib and clearly displaying Accreditation Card
- Official Training schedule will be available on the AFC Media Channel
- 3. Pre-Match Press Conference
- Subject to space availability
- PHO position at the rear of press conference room (preferably on camera platform if space permits)
- Photographers will be allowed only until the head coach and player complete their opening remarks before being requested to exit the room
- Press conference schedule will be available on the AFC Media Channel
- 4. Pitch side PHO Position
- Subject to space availability on matchday
- Wearing of appropriate bib and clearly displaying Accreditation Card and match-specific bib ticket
- Always seated, movement allowed under the direct supervision of AFC and/or LOC Venue Media Manager, only before match, during half-time and after match.

- 5. Mixed Zone
- · Photographers are NOT allowed in the Mixed Zone



Matchday Operation

1. PHO pitch side position is made up of six sectors behind the perimeter boards as shown below:

(Sectors PP_3L and PP_3R are non-equipped positions)

- 2. Access to PHO pitch side position starts from two (2) hours before kick-off (or KO-120 minutes).
- 3. At around KO-15 minutes, PHO will be escorted to the center line behind rope barriers managed by the Photo Marshalls to take photos of the pre-match ceremony, e.g., teams walk-in, the national anthems, team group photo and picture of the team captains with match officials.

Immediately after the coin toss, photographers escorted back to their

allocated seats behind the perimeter boards as quickly as possible.

- 4. Access to PHO pitch side position closed immediately after kick-off.
- 5. PHO may change sides only during half-time.

Equipment

- 1. Monopods can be used to support the camera. Tripods are prohibited.
- 2. Remote cameras can be set up in the designated area behind the goals provided the remote camera rig does not exceed a total height of 25 cm and can be set up until KO-10minutes. Remote cameras can only be serviced during half time. Approval of remote camera set up is at the sole discretion of the AFC Media Officer and/or LOC Venue Media Manager.
- 3. Flash photography during the game is prohibited.

AFC Non-Rights Holder (NRH) Guidelines

The following guidelines will help you maximise your coverage whilst safeguarding the commercial interests of the AFC and AFC's commercial partners.

Definition - Non-Rights Holder (NRH)

A broadcaster which does not have a media rights agreement with the AFC, either directly or through AFC's Commercial Partner, Asia Football Group (AFG), to use and/or exploit the broadcasting rights to the Competition.

Non-rights holders (NRH) are allowed to bring in television cameras into the stadiums and Main Media Centre (MMC). However, radio transmitters are not permitted into stadiums and MMC.

Access Areas

The AFC will grant Non-Rights Holders (NRHs) access to the following:

- Main Media Centre (MMC) / Stadium Media Centre (SMC), subject to space availability. SMCs are closed on non-matchdays. MMC operational hours will be available on the AFC Media Channel
- 2. Official training sessions at the official training sites
- Open for at least the first 15 minutes and subject to space availability
- Only operate in area designated by the AFC and/or Host Organisation



3. Pre-Match Press Conference

- Subject to space availability
- Broadcast camera with tripod allowed on camera platform (one per organisation)
- Press conference schedule will be available on the AFC Media Channel

4. Media Tribune

- · Subject to space availability on matchday
- Any recording equipment shall be deposited upon arrival at the stadium
- No video/audio recording or live stream on broadcast mobile device(s) allowed for the duration of the match

5. Post-Match Press Conference

- Subject to space availability
- Broadcast camera with tripod allowed on camera platform (one per organisation)

6. Mixed Zone

- Subject to space availability
- Set up camera and tripod allowed in designated area behind barricade

Footage Usage

Any footage recorded during official training sessions, in the mixed zone or during press conferences shall only be used for editorial purposes in regularly scheduled current affairs news and/or sports news programming.

The Khalifa International Stadium was inaugurated in 1976. As one of Qatar's oldest stadiums, it stands as a legend in the nation's sporting history. The stadium received an overhaul in preparations for the FIFA World Cup 2022™. It reopened its gates in May 2017 to host the finals of the Amir Cup.

Dual arches lend the stadium its distinctive personality. A new tier with 12,000 seats was added as part of the stadium's expansion. The façade was also modernised and illuminated with digital lighting, and now shines as a beacon of sportsmanship.

Al Bayt Stadium is easily one of the most recognisable stadiums with its magnificent tent-like structure. The stadium was inaugurated on 30 November 2021 to mark the opening of the FIFA Arab Cup 2021™. It also hosted the opening match of the FIFA World Cup 2022™, reaching full capacity.

Bayt translates to 'home' and rightly so, the Al Bayt Stadium warmly welcomes fans into the heart of tradition – the home of its vibrant past. The tent-like structure is inspired by the bayt al sha'ar or tents of Qatar's nomadic people, complete with the black-and-white stripes on the outside and sadu patterns on the inside – allowing visitors to step back in time.

Al Bayt Stadium will host a total of 4 matches; 2 in the group stage, one in Round of 16 and one Quarter-final.



Ahmad bin Ali Stadium will host a total of 7 matches; 4 in the group stage, one in Round of 16, one Quarter-final and one Semi-final.





Al Janoub Stadium lies in the southern city of Al Wakrah – one of Qatar's oldest inhabited areas with a rich fishing and pearl diving past. The stadium was inaugurated on 16 May 2019 during the Amir Cup final and has since then hosted a number of football matches, including seven during the FIFA World Cup 2022™.

Al Janoub Stadium will host a total of 6 matches; 4 in the group stage, one in Round of 16 and one Quarter-final.



Jassim Bin Hamad Stadium is home of the Qatar Stars League side Al Sadd SC. The stadium was opened in 1975 and is one of Qatar's oldest football arenas. While the stadium did not host any of the FIFA World Cup 2022™ matches, it was used as a training base for France. It has hosted other notable tournament such as the Asian Games Doha 2006 and the FIFA Club World Cup 2019™.

The multi-purpose stadium has been renovated twice - in 2004 and in 2010. It stands as an integral part of Qatar's football history, greeting local fans who regularly flock to watch local teams compete in prestigious domestic matches.

Jassim bin Hamad Stadium will host a total of 7 matches; 6 in the group stage and one in Round of 16.



The Education City Stadium is nestled within its namesake location – Qatar's Education City that is home to some of the world's most prestigious universities. The stadium was inaugurated on 3 September 2020, hosting its first match for the Qatar Stars League season. It has also hosted the quarterfinals of the FIFA World Cup 2022™.

The stadium has earned a nickname 'Diamond of the Desert' from its glistening façade that features a mosaic of diamond-shaped geometrical patterns that sparkle as the sun moves across the sky. A stunning light show preserves the illumination at night, ushering in a sporting spectacle that waits inside.

Education City Stadium will host a total of 6 matches; 4 in the group stage, one in Round of 16 and one Quarter-final.



Al Thumama Stadium is located near Qatar's Hamad International Airport. Its much-anticipated inauguration took place on 22 October 2021 to mark the Amir Cup Final. The stadium has also hosted matches during the FIFA Arab Cup 2021™ and the FIFA World Cup 2022™.

Designed as an ode to the traditions of this region, the stadium is a much-celebrated venue amongst locals. The stadium's iconic circular form reflects the gahfiya – the traditional woven cap adorned by men and boys all across the Arab world. The gahfiya symbolises the coming of age for youth, akin to the venue marking a new era in stadium design. The stadium is designed by Qatari architect Ibrahim Al Jaidah.

Al Thumamah stadium will host a total of 6 matches; 4 in the group stage, one in Round of 16 and one Semi-final.





Main Media Centre (MMC)

The Main Media Centre (MMC) is the main working hub for AFC accredited media, located in Msheireb Downtown. It offers high-level services such as press conference halls, and workspaces, in addition to the technical support, to ensure seamless media coverage for the AFC Asian Cup Qatar 2023.

All media will have access to all official press conferences on MD-1. Key event items such as bibs and parking passes, will be distributed from the MMC.

The MMC will also work as the main media transport hub, providing media transfer to stadiums (matchdays only), and the official training sites (MD-1 official training sessions only).



How to reach the MMC underground parking:

- 1. Take the Wadi Musheireb road and turn right onto Abdul Aziz bin Ahmed Street
- 2. Enter through the Galleria West basement parking (which will be located on the right-hand side) to access the media parking (https://maps.app.goo.gl/21cwgJTtdHvNm8Fm9)
- 3. Park your vehicle at level B3 near elevator number 14;
- 4. Use elevator 14 to reach Level G;
- 5. Go out of the building and turn to the right. Walk about 50 meters and then turn to the right, following the left side of tram lines until the MMC Entrance.





Training Sites

All team training sessions will take place at dedicated training sites. Media representatives will be allowed to attend both regular and official training sessions for at least 15 minutes. The actual duration of the open slot is at the discretion of the national teams. The open slot starts at the scheduled session time or the actual start time if it is later than scheduled. After the end of the open slot, all media representatives without exception must leave the pitch.


All regular (non-official) training sessions will be managed by team media officers.

Media centres will be located in each training cluster, and will be shared by media attending all training sessions within this cluster. Accredited media can access the training sites media center one hour before the beginning of the open slot, and they can go pitch side 30 minutes before the open slot for official training sessions.

All official press conferences before or after the official training sessions will be held at the Main Media Centre (MMC) in Msheireb at MD-1.

Each training site has a media parking area operating on a first come, first served basis. No vehicle access and parking permit (VAPP) is required.

The media can also arrive by media shuttle from the MMC on official training sessions (MD-1).

AFC Asian Cup™ Trophy

Designed and made by world renowned silversmiths Thomas Lyte of London, the trophy eloquently communicates the powerful spirit of one of the world's oldest continental football competitions.

Updated after six decades and unveiled in May 2018, the production process encompassed a total of 450 hours of craftsmanship, including 230 hours of hammering sheets of steel into the final, unique shape.

The end result is a 78-centimetre-tall, 42-centimetre-wide masterpiece depicting the Asian Football Confederation's five regions and celebrating the proud history of the AFC Asian Cup™ as the continent's foremost men's football competition by labelling its previous winners on the trophy's plinth.

AFC Asian Cup™ Awards

Fair Play Award

The AFC Fair Play Award will be presented to the Participating Team who have collected the most Fair Play points. The applicable rules and Fair Play Criteria are stated in the Competition Operations Manual.

The AFC Fair Play awards shall only take into account the performance during the Final Competition.

Top Goalscorer Award

The Top Goalscorer Award will be presented to the Participating Player who has scored the highest number of goals. In the event of a tie, the number of assists as determined by the AFC Technical Study Group will be taken into account to identify the winner. If there is still a tie, the total minutes played will be taken into account with the Participating Player with the lower number of minutes played ranked first.

The Top Goalscorer Award shall only take into account the performance during the Final Competition.



Most Valuable Player Award

The Most Valuable Player of the Competition is awarded to the Participating Player who has a major influence in each of the Matches and the Competition overall as selected by the AFC Technical Study Group.

The Most Valuable Player Award shall only take into account the performance during the Final Competition.

Best Goalkeeper Award

The Best Goalkeeper is awarded to the most outstanding goalkeeper based on his performance during the competition as selected by the AFC Technical Study Group.

The Best Goalkeeper Award shall only take into account the performance during the Final Competition.
