## Accreditation Guidelines for Media



### Where to collect Accreditation Card?

Accreditations have to be collected in person producing the ID or passport (the same document that was used for the application).

Your contact place for all accreditation enquiries is the respective City Accreditation Centre at each Competition City.

Making your access easy and convenient, all Accreditation Centres will be situated outside the outer security perimeter of the stadium.

### What is an Accreditation?

An accreditation is a device that grants access to the AFC Asian Cup UAE 2019™ Competitions Venue. Within this Venue the accreditation will grant the bearer access to one or more zones.

An accreditation is for working staff only. This means that it will only be issued to people with a specific role on-site. The accreditation does not grant the bearer the right to a spectator seat in the Stadium and is not a sign of social status. Its purpose is to enable working staff to perform their jobs and to prevent interference from those without such a function.

In addition, the accreditation is a security tool that identifies all accredited persons. It is the accredited person's event ID and must be worn visibly at all times inside the Venue. It remains the property of AFC and can be withdrawn at any time.

Accredited parties should take special care not to lose or mislay their accreditation.

An accreditation is not a visa or immigration tool.

In order to be valid, an accreditation device combines personal data relating to the bearer with various other kinds of information, including Zoning Information (access inside the Venue).

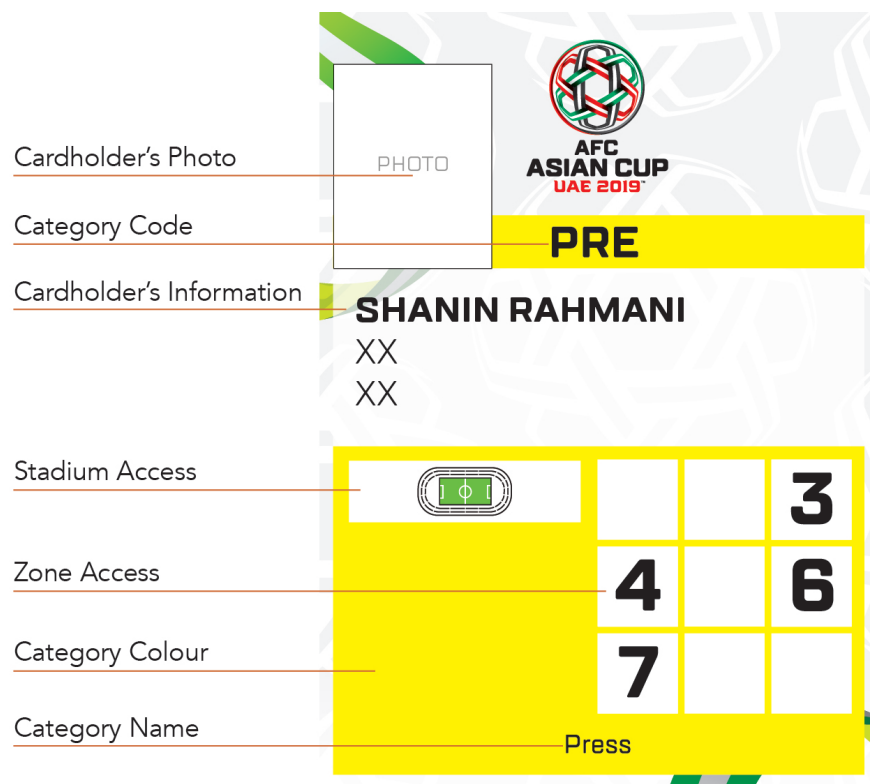
An accreditation card allows a specific person to access a specific area(s) in order to perform a specific and regular function. It is not for "what if" or "maybe" situations.

The Accreditation Card is not an external sign of a privileged status but is a necessary working tool to manage the large number of people participating during the Competition, facilitating their movements in a safe and flexible way. It is to ensure that only appropriately qualified and eligible people are entitled to participate in or perform official functions during the Competition.

The accreditation card (excluding Day Passes) is valid for the entire tournament, as long as the bearer has official event responsibilities. The accreditation card can be cancelled and removed from an accredited person at any time.

The accreditation card is used for access control at stadiums and training fields, it does not extend to any other event locations (unless specifically stated).

### Accreditation Categories

Due to the number of people involved, numerous accreditation categories have been devised for the AFC Asian Cup UAE 2019™. To make identification of these categories simpler, each category has been assigned a separate background colour. The following colours have been assigned for TV and Media Representatives:

### Access Rights

There are two main access rights which are reflected jointly and need to be combined in each Accreditation card:

- Access privileges by Stadiums
- Access privileges by Zones

All Media Representatives will be provided with all venue access and then there will be designated zones highlighted on the accreditation cards. Only the zones on the cards can be accessed.

### Access Zones

In order to grant an accredited person the right level of access rights, each stadium will be divided into nine zones, which will be activated on match days. Access to a zone will be granted to an accredited party in possession of a pass displaying the relevant zone numbers.

The following table provides an overview of these 9 access codes.

Zone	Zone Definition
1 Field of Play*	Pitch; Team benches; Fourth official's bench; Tunnel and access to field of play; Photographers' and cameramen positions.
2 Competitions Area*	Teams and Referees dressing rooms; Medical and Doping Control rooms; AFC and LOC offices; Corridors (with access to dressing rooms).
3 Public Areas	General Public entrance; Public toilet facilities; Public points of Sale; Concessions areas; First aid; Commercial displays and Spectator seats.
4 Operations Areas	All rooms not in Zone 2 (IT room, PA announcer booth, police/fire brigade rooms, electrical generator, medical facilities) & storage areas
5 VIP Area	VIP reception and lounge, VIP seats, VVIP area.
6 Media Area*	Media seats; Mixed Zone; Press Conference room; Radio and TV Commentary Positions and observers seats
7 Media Centre	Media working area; media catering area; media briefing area; Photographers' area and Media services
8 Broadcast Area	TV Compound, Radio and TV Studios, Camera Platforms,
9 Hospitality Area	Hospitality areas

\* Denotes that to access this zone a SAD (SAD Bib Ticket for Pitch level) is also required from 2 hours prior to kick-off.

The following zoning will be provided to TV and Media Representatives Depending on the type of Accreditation they receive:

### Zone Control

Actual zone-control starts match kick-off -2 hours and ends (generally speaking) when all the teams and match officials have left the stadium (although certain areas such as Mixed Zone may require extended controls).

During zone-control, all persons need the correct zone(s) on the accreditation and/or the proper SAD (see below). People found within an area without the proper access privileges will be asked to leave the area.

For groups like TV technical personnel who do not otherwise receive SADs, zone-control ends for Zone 1 (Field of Play) when the Teams have left the pitch.

For all groups, Zone 2 (Dressing Rooms) stays active until the teams and match officials have left the stadium.

### Supplementary Access Devices (SADs)

Supplementary Access Devices (SADs) are non-personalised accreditation devices to be worn in conjunction with the Accreditation Card, as they are not valid by themselves. SADs will be utilized at all five stadiums on Match Days. SADs will be required in certain zones to discern access to Accreditation Card bearers. SADs will not be required in training fields and on non-match days.

SADs will be valid for a single match only.

Media will require and use following SADs:

SADs do not overrule accreditation or vice-versa, but rather work in complimentary fashion. Both are needed at certain times to access relevant areas. The SAD only works in combination with the corresponding zone on the accreditation card.

SADs cannot be collected at the Accreditation Centre. Please visit Stadium Media Centre for all SAD matters.

#### Mixed Zone SAD

- For access, must be worn with Zone 6



#### Press Conference Room SAD

- For access, must be worn with Zone 6



#### Commentary Position SAD

- For access, must be worn with Zone 6



#### TV Studio SAD

- For access, must be worn with Zone 8



The coordination and the distribution of SADs for the media is managed by the AFC Media Officers of the respective venue.

### Samples of Bibs

The following bibs will be used by Media representatives to access the field area:

- TV bibs
- Photographer bibs

Bibs bearing numbers will be supplied to photographers, cameramen and their assistants. The AFC Media Officer is responsible for their distribution and to ensure they are used correctly.

### Access to Training Venues

Access by Accreditation to the Training Venues will be implemented at all training sessions. During training sessions deemed by teams to be 'open to the public' only the public are not required to wear an Accreditation Card. All others, including media representatives, PRE required to wear their Accreditation Card.

All valid accreditation cards for any venue can access any training field.

### Revocation / Cancellation of Accreditation Card

There are three primary reasons an Accreditation Card may be cancelled during the AFC Asian Cup UAE 2019™:

1. Selected Cancellation

The bearer has failed to comply with the Terms & Conditions of receiving an AFC Asian Cup UAE 2019™ Accreditation Card. Hence AFC wishes to revoke the bearers Accreditation Card.

2. Enforced Cancellation

The bearer's personal Accreditation Card has been lost, stolen or damaged. Consequently for security reasons it is necessary to cancel this Accreditation Card.

3. Operationally Enforced Cancellation

The AFC Asian Cup UAE 2019™ Accreditation Card created for the bearer is displaying incorrect personal data and/or access privileges.

In ALL the above mentioned circumstances, the Accreditation Cards revocation or cancellation is subject to the authority of the AFC.

4. Appeal

The AFC reserves the right to revoke the accreditation of any media person found violating the media guidelines, rules and regulations. As a part of the process, the AFC has set up an internal appeals committee who will hear the appeals lodged against the decision to revoke media accreditation cards. Any appeal following the removal of accreditation can be lodged by mailing [media@the-afc.com](mailto:media@the-afc.com).

**What to do when... Accreditation Card is stolen**

The loss of Accreditation Card represents a potential security risk. The AFC takes this issue very seriously and expects all Accredited Media Representatives to do the same.

In case of lost or stolen Accreditation Card, please proceed as following:

1. Visit respective City Accreditation Centre or inform the Accreditation team via e-mail to [accreditations@the-afc.com](mailto:accreditations@the-afc.com) within 24 hours of detecting the loss
2. Each request will be treated separately and the decision to reprint or not shall be taken after consultation between the AFC Media Department and the AFC Accreditation Centre Manager.
3. City Accreditation Centre will inform relevant Media representative on decision and next steps to follow.

In ALL the above mentioned circumstances, the Accreditation Cards revocation or cancellation is subject to the authority of the AFC.

**What to do when... Changing Data**

In case of any need to change cardholder's information (such as different spelling of the bearer's name) the following procedures shall apply:

1. Visit respective City Accreditation Centre or inform the Accreditation team via e-mail to [accreditations@the-afc.com](mailto:accreditations@the-afc.com)
2. City Accreditation Centre will verify the necessity of requested change and reissue new Accreditation Card in exchange to previous Accreditation Card.
3. Changes are subject to a minimum processing time of 24 hours.

**What to do when... Replacing Accreditation Card**

In case of any need to replace damaged Accreditation Card, the following procedures shall apply:

1. Visit respective City Accreditation Centre or inform the Accreditation team via e-mail to [accreditations@the-afc.com](mailto:accreditations@the-afc.com)
2. City Accreditation Centre will verify the necessity of requested change and reissue new Accreditation Card in exchange to previous Accreditation Card.
3. Replacements are subject to a minimum processing time of 24 hours.

\*City Seasons Al Hamara (Abu Dhabi), Media Rotana (Dubai) and Ayla Grand Hotel (Al Ain) are the city media hotels from where the shuttle service will run.

## Media Procedures

Access to the different media areas is restricted to accredited journalists holding a valid match specific SAD – Supplementary Access Device – such as a seat ticket for the media tribune or an SAD for the press conference or mixed zone.

### On Match Day

#### Media Tribune

Each accredited journalist will have to apply for match tickets via the AFC Media Channel and he or she will receive an email upon confirmation of the request. The match tickets (written press) will be distributed in the Stadium Media Centre (SMC) from 1600 hrs the day before the game and on match day until 90 minutes before kick-off.

Tickets will only be distributed for each individual match and not for the entire tournament.

Non-collected tickets will be distributed to the media registered on the waiting list. The waiting list will be compiled in the match stadium only (not online), starting at the same time as ticket distribution. The waiting list will be handled on a priority and not a first-come-first-served basis. The distribution of the tickets for a possible waiting list will begin 60 minutes before kick-off.

The allocation of the tickets for a game is determined by different criteria:

- news agencies
- media of the two playing teams
- media of the host country
- media of the other teams in the group
- media of the other participating teams
- rest of the media

For each country there is a priority order as follows:

- major national news agencies
- national daily newspapers
- football magazines
- national weekly newspapers
- football websites
- football specialist freelancers
- sports websites
- general websites
- multi-sports magazines
- general interest magazines

The media tribune will be equipped with TV monitors, power and free internet access.

Please note that the ticketing system for the rights-holding broadcasters (RTV) is different from the written press and the procedure above is not applicable.

### Capacity

- From 200 to 300 seats with desk and without desk depending on the stadium
- 150 pitch photographer positions
- Commentary positions and observers seats for the rights-holding broadcasters

### Press Conferences

A press conference will be held after each match at the AFC Asian Cup UAE 2019™. The head coaches and Man of the Match are required to attend this conference.

Members of the media will only be granted access to the press conference room if they are in possession of an accreditation and a valid SAD. The allocation of SADs are made on a match-by-match basis by the AFC Media Officers and distributed in the SMC (same schedule as for the match tickets).

The press conference (approximately 15 minutes after the final whistle) will be translated into English and Arabic.

Photographers are not allowed in the press conference room.

### Mixed Zone

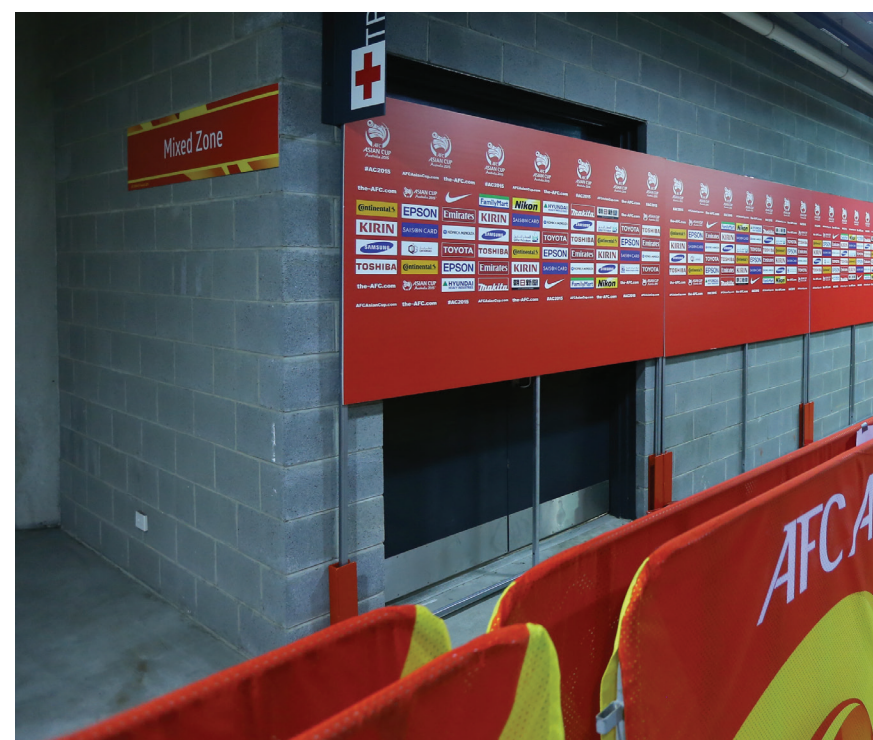
The mixed zone provides media representatives with the opportunity to conduct brief interviews with individual players the team as the teams leave the stadium after the match.

The first part of this area will be reserved for host broadcasters and rights-holding broadcasters while print and radio journalists will be accommodated in the second part.

The non-rights holding broadcasters will be accommodated in the second part if the space is available.

Access to the mixed zone will only be granted on presentation of a valid SAD (same distribution as for the match ticket).

Photographers are not permitted in the mixed zone.



## Photographers

The photographers will be given their bib at the Stadium Media Centres. They must wear their bib once they enter the stadium.

Photographers working on the pitch will require a bib ticket for each match with a seat number to be inserted in the specific pocket of the bib. Only the bib together with the bib ticket and accreditation card will provide photographers with access to the dedicated pitch area.

Each photographer will have a numbered seat which needs to be kept at all times. Each photographer will have to select the match(es) he/she intends to cover in the AFC Media Channel. Upon approval of the request, he/she will be informed of the time when he/she can login again and select his/her seat online. Once the seat is confirmed, each photographer will receive an email with their confirmed seat number, which needs to be shown at the Photographer Ticket Distribution Desk for collection of the ticket.

Photographers, like written press, will be divided into different priority groups and have the opportunity to choose position according to this priority.

A waiting list for photographers will be compiled from MD-1 for those matches which are over-subscribed. Photographers from this waiting list will be issued tickets from 60 minutes before kick-off on a first-come-first-served basis.

The pitchside will be accessible two (2) hours before kick-off right after the photographers' briefing which will take place -2.15 hours.

Photographers will have to enter the pitch through a specific entrance which is clearly marked. For team pictures before the start of the match they have to follow the instructions of the AFC Media Officers and the LOC Media Officers and have to take their seat immediately after the coin toss.

Photographers on the pitch level will have access to internet. It is strictly forbidden to walk on the field of play.

## Training Sessions and MD-1 Activities

The training sessions on MD-1 are considered as official training sessions. These training sessions will be held at the match stadium.

The regular team training sessions are under the responsibility of the Team Media Officer. The sessions at the match stadium will be under the responsibility of AFC and LOC Media Officers. All training sessions (date, place, time) will be announced and updated regularly on the AFC Media Channel.

All training sessions, official or regular team training sessions, will be open at least for the first 15 minutes (which could be extended if the team wishes to do so). In case of cancellation or change of venue or time, the same will apply and will be announced on the AFC Media Channel. All these training sessions are open to all accredited media.

The official pre-match press conference will be held either before or after each of the official training sessions. This press conference will be attended by head coach and one player from the team's starting XI. Some training sessions could be followed by a mixed zone activity but this depends on the respective teams.

For the training sessions the following guidelines will be applied for photographers (with bib), NRH (with bib) and rights-holding broadcasters (with bib) will work as on match day behind the goal lines and on the opposite side of the touch line, except AFC's official photographers.

Interviews are not permitted and no media can stay on the bench side or at the team entrance. All press, radio and TV reporters will have to work from the Media Tribune (no exceptions) and will have to vacate their places if the training session is closed after the first 15 minutes.

## Parking

Limited parking slots have been made available for media at each stadium. Accredited media can contact the Welcome Desk at the respective Stadium Media Centres and collect their parking sticker a day before each match.

## Finals

### Finals (Group Stage)

- a) 24 Participating Teams shall be drawn into 6 groups of 4 teams each.
- b) Each Member Association shall play against the other Member Associations within its group once in accordance with the Match Schedule.
- c) The duration of Matches shall be played in accordance with the Manual.
- d) At the conclusion of the Group Stage:
  - the first-placed and second-placed Participating Team in each group, as well as the 4 best third-placed Participating Teams among all groups, shall qualify for the Knockout Stage.
  - all other Participating Teams shall be eliminated from the Competition.

### Finals (Knockout Stage)

- e) The Knockout Stage shall consist of the Round of 16, Quarter-Finals, Semi-Finals and Final, each round conducted as single-leg knockout Matches.
- f) Each round of the Knockout Stage shall be conducted in accordance with the Match Schedule.
- g) The duration of Matches, including Extra Time and Penalty Kicks (if required), shall be played in accordance with Article 12.

- h) The 16 Participating Teams shall play the Round of 16 as follows:

R16 - 1:	2A vs 2C
R16 - 2:	1D vs 3rd from B, E, or F
R16 - 3:	1B vs 3rd from A, C, or D
R16 - 4:	1F vs 2E
R16 - 5:	1C vs 3rd from A, B, or F
R16 - 6:	1E vs 2D
R16 - 7:	1A vs 3rd from C, D, or E
R16 - 8:	2B vs 2F

- i) The following table indicates the pairings in the Round of 16 for the qualified first-placed and third-placed Participating Teams. (For example, if the Participating Teams finishing third in groups A, B, C and D qualify, the pairings shall be 1A vs 3C, 1B vs 3D, 1C vs 3A and 1D vs 3B).

j) The eight (8) winners in the Round of 16 shall play the Quarter-Finals as follows:

QF1: Winner R16-1 vs Winner R16-2

QF2: Winner R16-3 vs Winner R16-4

QF3: Winner R16-5 vs Winner R16-6

QF4: Winner R16-7 vs Winner R16-8

k) The four (4) winners in the Quarter-Finals shall play the Semi-Finals as follows:

SF1: Winner Quarter Final 1 vs Winner Quarter Final 2

SF2: Winner Quarter Final 3 vs Winner Quarter Final 4

l) The two (2) winners in the Semi-Finals shall play the Final as follows:

Final: Winner Semi Final 1 vs Winner Semi Final 2

### Extra Time and Penalty Kicks

- a) If no winner is determined at the end of normal playing time, Extra Time comprising two (2) fifteen(15) minute periods shall be played:
  - i) at the end of normal playing time of the second leg of any tie in the Qualifiers (Playoff Round); or
  - ii) at the end of normal playing time during the Finals (Knockout Stage).
- b) The Away Goals Rule shall not apply during or at the conclusion of Extra Time of any Match.
- c) If no winner is determined at the end of Extra Time, Penalty Kicks shall be taken in accordance with the Laws of the Game and the Manual

### Cancellation of Matches

- a) For any Match which is cancelled as a result of Force Majeure, the AFC Organising Committee shall decide on the matter at its sole discretion and take whatever action is deemed necessary.
  - i) Decisions made pursuant to Article 13.1 are final and binding and not appealable.
- b) Any Match which is cancelled, except in cases of Force Majeure recognised by the AFC Organising Committee, may lead to the imposition of sanctions by the AFC Disciplinary Committee against the relevant party that has caused the cancellation in accordance with the AFC Disciplinary and Ethics Code.

### Abandonment of Matches

- a) For any Match which is abandoned as a result of Force Majeure, the AFC Organising Committee shall decide on the matter at its sole discretion and take whatever action is deemed necessary.
  - i) Decisions made pursuant to Article 14.1 are final and binding and not appealable.
- b) Any Match which is abandoned, except in cases of Force Majeure recognised by the AFC Organising Committee, may lead to the imposition of sanctions by the AFC Disciplinary and Ethics Committee against the relevant party that has caused the abandonment in accordance with the AFC Disciplinary and Ethics Code.



# MEDIA GUIDELINES

## Photographer Guidelines



Each photographer accredited for the AFC ASIAN CUP UAE 2019™ will be issued with a PHO accreditation card and an orange photographer's bib, both of which are valid for the entire tournament. The bib must be worn, visibly, at all times (even at training sessions on any site).

1. At each match, photographers can select to work on either the field. In some matches, the number of requests could exceed the number of places available, and some requests must be rejected. Thus to work at any particular match, a photographer requires three items: accreditation card, bib and ticket.
2. Each photographer will have a numbered seat which needs to be kept at all times. Each photographer will have to select the match(es) he/she intends to cover in the AFC Media Channel. Upon approval of the request, he/she will be informed of the time when he/she can login again and select his/her seat online. Once the seat is confirmed, each photographer will receive an email with their confirmed seat number, which needs to be shown at the Photographer Ticket Distribution Desk for collection of the ticket.
3. Photographers may only work in the zones reserved for them behind the goal lines (and not in the zones reserved for television cameras), unless expressly permitted by officials.
4. In all stadiums except as instructed, photographers may also work on the touch line facing the main TV camera (opposite the team benches).
5. Photographers will not be allowed to work from the touch line on the side of the team benches, apart from the AFC official photographers (wearing green bibs).
6. Photographers may never work in front of the advertising boards and must not obstruct these boards in any way at any time.
7. Photographers must allow players sufficient room to take corner kicks, as directed by the referee or other AFC officials.
8. Once the match has begun, photographers should not move from their dedicated seat.
9. Photographers may move to the other end of the pitch for penalty shoot-outs, as instructed by officials.
10. Flash photography during the game is not permitted.
11. Monopods are permitted, but not tripods.

12. Photographers may set up remote cameras in a designated area between the goal-net and the advertising boards, but in such a way as not to interfere with either. An area will be marked for these cameras behind each goal. Equipment may not exceed the total height of 25 cm. The final decision on the placement of any remote control cameras shall be with the referee. Remote control cameras may not be serviced during the match, but only at half-time.
13. Approximately 15 minutes before each match and as instructed by officials, field photographers may come to the centre of the touch line where the teams will line up for the national anthems and team group pictures. The teams and referees will stand at a distance of approximately ten metres from the touch line. After the national anthems, the teams will shake hands and pose for team group pictures at the same distance. This is followed by the coin toss and picture of captains with the match officials.
14. Immediately after the coin toss, photographers shall disperse to their respective working positions and not stop to take pictures of the team officials or players on the benches.
15. At the end of each half, photographers shall remain behind their respective goal line until all players have exited from the field.
16. A certain number of seats have been allocated for photographers in the media tribune at selected venues. Photographers selected to work in this area will each receive a ticket with a seat number, which they are to occupy. They may go to their allocated seats at any time they choose. They shall remain seated throughout the match.
17. Accredited photographers are only permitted to provide still photos. Not respecting this breaks the AFC ASIAN CUP UAE 2019™ Terms & Conditions signed by each accredited media and may lead to sanctions.
18. At no time – whether before, during or after any match – may photographers enter the field of play for any reason. Neither may they enter the dressing rooms at any time, even if invited to do so by players or team officials. Failure to respect this rule may lead to withdrawal of the photographer's accreditation for the remainder of the competition.
19. In the event that a photographer's bib is lost or stolen, it will only be replaced upon production of a police report and a USD 200 fee.
20. Photographers should always be seated on their respective seats/chairs provided by the organisers and not on their own lens box/stool or on the ground.

### Non Rights Holders (NRH) Guidelines



1. A broadcaster and/or its representatives (e.g. producer, cameraman) that has no contractual agreement with the AFC is not allowed access to the stadium for recording of any AFC matches or events. These broadcasters are classed as NRH (Non Rights Holders).
2. The AFC may at its discretion allow access to NRH for certain match activities including MD-1 training, MD-1 press conference, post-match press conference and mixed zones. The HB and RTV broadcasters shall be given priority of access and positioning over any NRH.
3. No broadcaster and/or news agency from the Middle East and North African region (MENA) shall be granted accreditation or allowed access to any match or related activity in the said region.
4. For purposes of clarity, MENA shall mean Algeria, Bahrain, Chad, Djibouti, Egypt, Iran, Iraq, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Libya, Mauritania, Morocco, Oman, Palestine including the Gaza strip, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Somalia, Sudan, Syria, Tunisia, United Arab Emirates and Yemen.

5. NRH's from non-Middle East based broadcasters and International news agencies, whose principle place of business is outside of the MENA region may, subject to approval of the AFC, have access to pre-match press conference, post-match press conference and mixed zone only, where capacity allows provided that any broadcast by such parties shall be in a language other than Arabic.
6. No Broadcasters are allowed to apply for PRESS/PHOTO category accreditations. They can only apply for RTV or NRH category, whichever is appropriate for them. (Note: HB is an appointed RTV).
7. Each eligible NRH broadcaster can apply for a maximum of 3 NRH category accreditations. These applications should be accompanied by an appointment letter signed by the management of the NRH broadcaster.
8. If a crew member needs to be replaced, the replacement request should be raised by the same person or a person of the same position or higher and the accreditation being replaced must be returned. If there is more than one appointment letter from persons of the same management level, accreditation will be awarded to the first 3 applicants under a first-come-first serve principal.
9. On arrival at the Stadium, all NRH accreditation bearers shall sign in at the Media Centre and hand in all audio-visual equipment at the storage facilities provided. The stored equipment cannot be retrieved before the Final Whistle or before the respective owner leaves the Stadium.
10. Based on the principal that RTV has priorities in coverage, NRH bearers are only allowed to be at the Observers Seats, Mixed Zone and Press Conference area when space is available.
11. NRH bearers are not allowed to bring in or conduct any audio-visual recording during the entire match period.

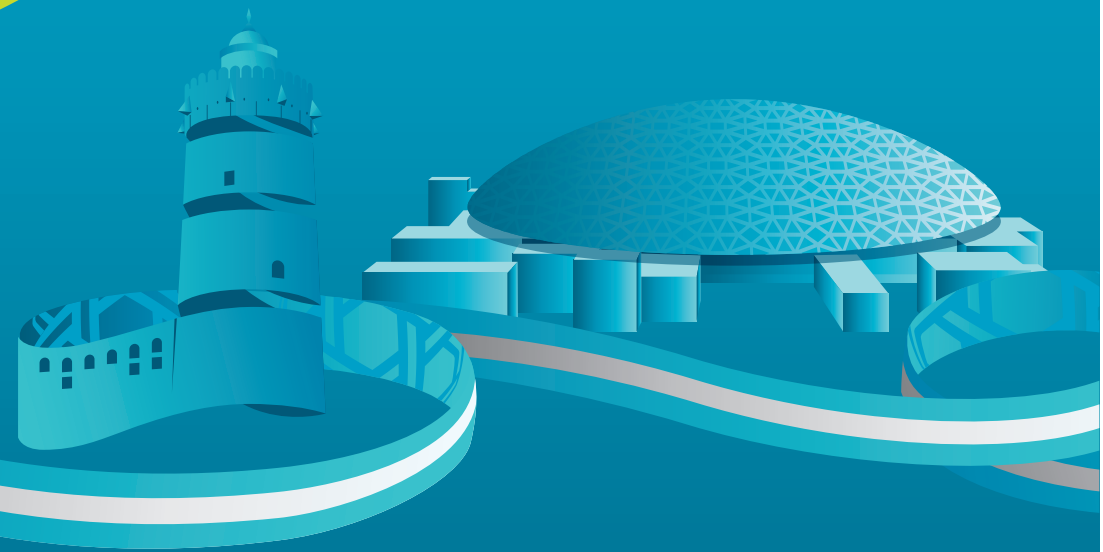
Any person in contravention of these rules will have their accreditation revoked immediately, with the incident being reported to the AFC, which may preclude access to any future AFC matches and/or events. The AFC reserves the right at its sole discretion to decide on all matters relating to the issuance and/or revocation of accreditation to all RTV and NRH broadcasters.

## Zayed Sports City Stadium



### Background

With both a history that goes back over 37 years and a recent renovation, the Zayed Sports City Stadium combines heritage with modernity.

The venue, inaugurated in 1980, was granted its biggest tournament to date when the UAE hosted the 1996 AFC Asian Cup for the first time with Zayed Sports City Stadium the venue for the showpiece finale.

Since then, this stadium hosted the FIFA Youth World Cup in 2003 when it was called the FIFA Youth Championship and FIFA Club World Cups before it underwent a major renovation in 2009. A traditional, open-air stadium that is defined on its exterior by iconic arches, Zayed Sports City Stadium is the perfect setting for the 2019 final curtain closer.

## Mohammed bin Zayed Stadium



### Background

Mohammed bin Zayed Stadium is home to UAE Pro League side Al Jazira. Built in 1979, the capital's oldest football stadium saw a complete overhaul that lasted three years between 2006 and 2009, upon its reopening, the stadium's capacity was increased from 15,000 to 42,000 fans.

Centrally located in Abu Dhabi's Al Muroor district, the premises at Al Jazira Club include a hospital, a boutique style hotel and an Olympic size swimming pool.

Over the past ten years, Mohammed bin Zayed Stadium has hosted the FIFA Club World Cup on three occasions, in 2009, 2010 and 2017. The stadium was also the home of the UAE national team in their 2018 FIFA World Cup qualifiers campaign.

### Background

Abu Dhabi's newest stadium offers a unique setting against a backdrop of high rise buildings from its location at the heart of Abu Dhabi's downtown. It is directly connected to the modern Al Wahda Mall and sits opposite the city's main bus terminal.

Japan fans will find a special connection with the stadium which was opened in 1995 by Crown Prince Naruhito of Japan alongside current UAE President Sheikh Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan.

The permanent residents of Al Nahyan Stadium are four times UAE Pro League champions Al Wahda who will see their stadium upgraded from 11,400 to 15,000 fans in preparation for the 2019 AFC Asian Cup.

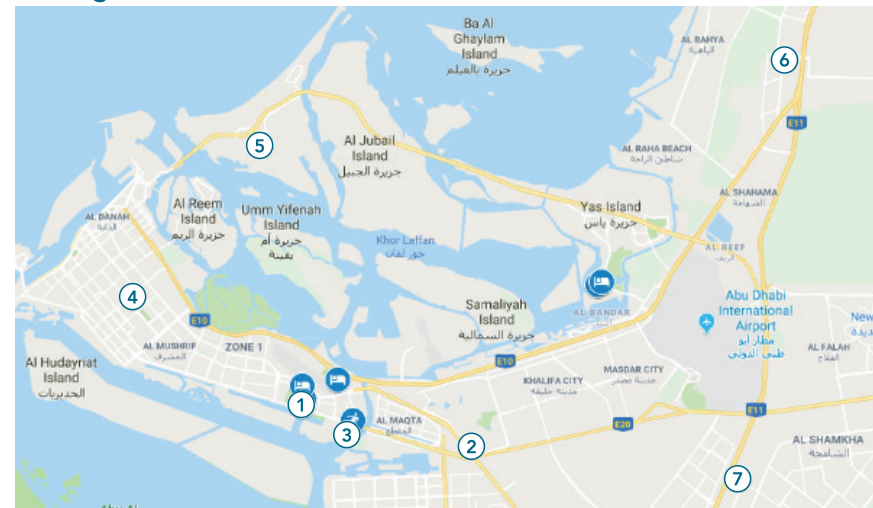

## Hazza bin Zayed Stadium



### Background

The award-winning Hazza Bin Zayed Stadium is a multi-purpose 25,000 capacity venue in Al Ain. The stadium covers an area of 45,000 square metres and is 50 metres high, making it one of the tallest buildings in Al Ain City.

The design of the outer facade is based on the trunk of the palm tree, an integral part of the UAE's heritage and legacy, while a sinuous and gravity-bending parasol roof shades the pitch and the spectators during matches.

This striking landmark hosted the UAE's FIFA World Cup 2018 Russia qualifiers and the 2016 AFC Champions League Final and will be a key venue at the AFC Asian Cup UAE 2019™.

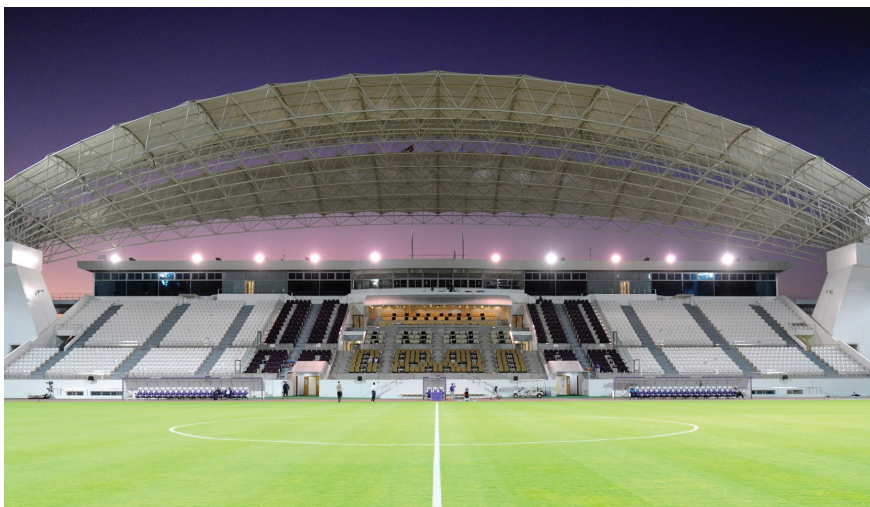

## Khalifa bin Zayed Stadium



### Background

Named after the current president of the UAE, Khalifa bin Zayed Stadium is one of the oldest football stadiums in the country, built in 1971 and refurbished in 2002. The ground played host to Al Ain's home fixtures prior to the opening of Hazza bin Zayed Stadium in 2014. It is now the club's main training ground and home to its football academy.

One of two host venues in Al Ain, the 12,000-capacity stadium is located less than 5-km from the UAE-Oman border and within walking distance of Al Ain Oasis, the UAE's first UNESCO World Heritage site.

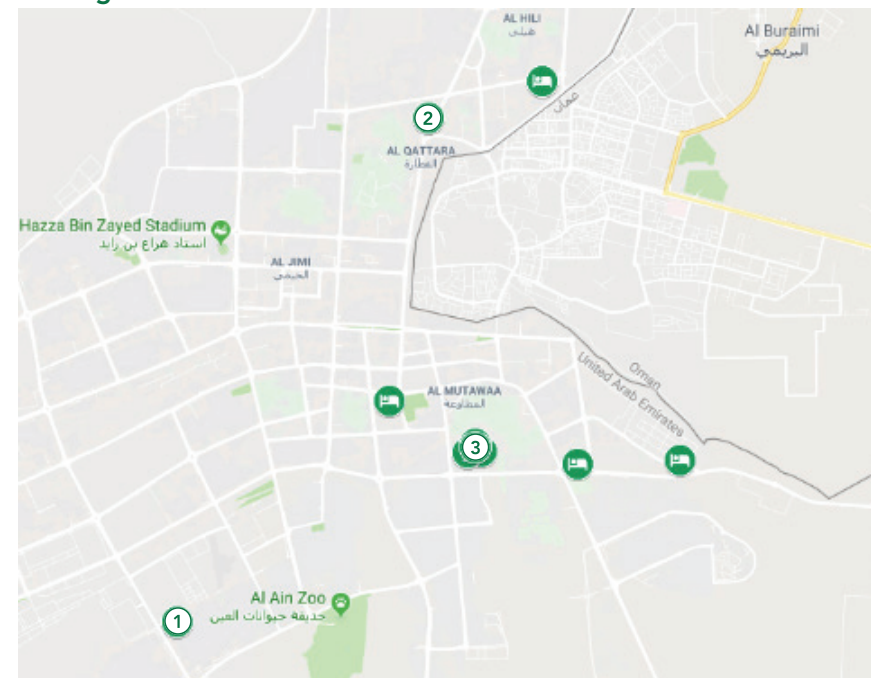

## Al Maktoum Stadium



### Background

Notable for its distinct blue colour, Al Maktoum Stadium has undergone a complete renovation for the AFC Asian Cup, seeing its capacity upgraded from 10,750 to 12,000. The Stadium hosted games in the 2003 FIFA Youth Championship and is the perennial venue for the UAE League Cup final, having hosted the high-profile fixture in the past two seasons.

The Stadium is home to Al Nasr, the oldest football club in the country, founded in 1945. The historic ground hosted the first ever Dubai derby between Al Nasr and arch-rivals Al Wasl.

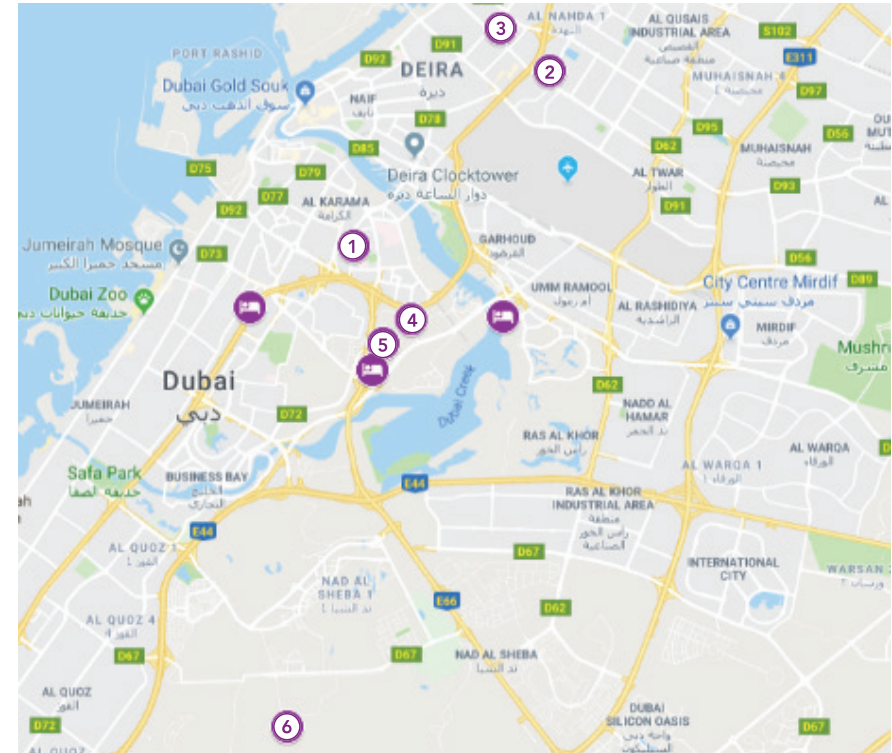

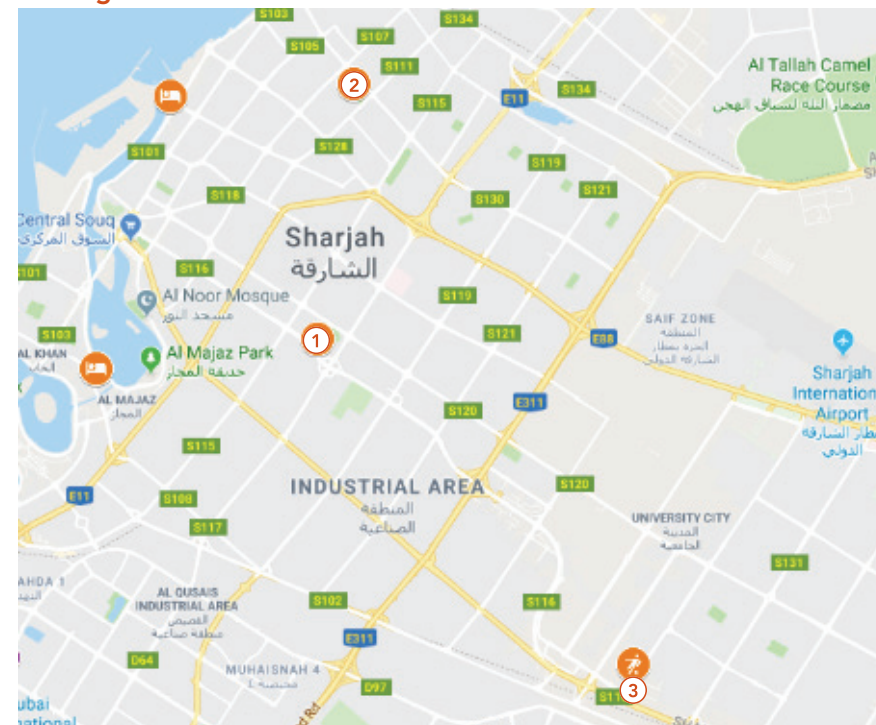

## AFC Asian Cup Trophy

The dazzling new trophy, the first update of the competition's silverware in six decades, was unveiled at the official draw for the AFC Asian Cup UAE 2019 in May last year.

Produced by the esteemed silversmith from London, the production process encompassed a total of 450 hours of craftsmanship, including 230 hours of hammering sheets of steel into the final, unique shape.

The end result is a 78-centimetre-tall, 42-centimetre-wide masterpiece depicting the Asian Football Confederation's five regions, and celebrating the AFC Asian Cup's proud history as the continent's foremost football competition by labelling its previous winners on the trophy's plinth.

## Asian Cup Awards

### Fair Play Award

The AFC Fair Play Award will be presented to the Participating Team who has collected the most Fair Play points. The applicable rules and Fair Play Criteria are stated in the Competition Operations Manual.

The AFC Fair Play awards shall only take into account performance during the Final Competition.

### Top Goalscorer Award

The Top Goalscorer Award will be presented to the Participating Player who has scored the highest number of goals. In the event of a tie, the number of assists as determined by the AFC Technical Study Group will be taken into account to identify the winner. If there is still a tie, the total minutes played will be taken into account with the Participating Player with the lower number of minutes played ranked first.

The Top Goalscorer Award shall only take into account performance during the Final Competition.

### Most Valuable Player Award

The Most Valuable Player of the Competition is awarded to the Participating Player who has a major influence in each of their Matches and the Competition overall.

The Most Valuable Player Award shall only take into account performance during the Final Competition.

### Best Goalkeeper Award

The Best Goalkeeper is awarded to the most outstanding goalkeeper based on his performance during the competition as selected by the AFC Technical Study Group.

The Best Goalkeeper Award shall only take into account performance during the Final Competition.
