AFC FUTSAL CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP 2010

ISFAHAN - IRAN

The first edition of AFC Futsal Club Championship was successfully held from March 4th-12th at the Pirouzi Stadium in Isfahan. The competition was originally planned for 10 teams to be divided into two groups of five and the top two in each group shall qualify for the semi-finals. Unfortunately, Nawrouz, the champion of the Iraqi Futsal Competitions could not participate due to FIFA's suspension of the Iraq Football Association. The first Championship was scheduled for 2009 but due to unforeseen circumstances in Iran, the Championship was postponed to 2010.

GENERAL ORGANIZATION



AFC's organization of this first edition of Futsal Club Championship has enabled the various teams to develop their competitive Futsal International characters.

The AFC Futsal Club Championship 2010 was held in the beautiful country of Iran. The Championship was very well supported by keen spectators who eagerly cheered on the the skilful players of all the teams and also the subsequent crowned champion, Foolad Sepahan Mahan (IR Iran).

The Organizing Committee of Isfahan demonstrated their capability in organizing the Futsal championship at an international level with ease.

The competition was held in the Pirouzi indoor hall of the City

of Isfahan. The indoor hall was extremely well equipped to accommodate Asia's best Futsal Clubs as well as spectators.

The Pirouzi venue was also equipped with several rooms for Medical, Doping control, Media, LOC and AFC. The training venues were located at Khorasgan and Salon Gole Narges, where all the training sessions took place. Offices were also provided for the Organizing Committee and AFC Delegation as well as designated areas for the Media and VIP stands.

The surface of the hall had been put up and renovated especially for this tournament to meet the AFC standards.

The LOC and the AFC Delegation worked closely together to ensure the success of AFC's first Futsal Club Championship

and also to increase the Futsal supporter base through the live broadcasting by the local TV stations.

The Futsal Club, Al-Saad of Qatar, made history by beating Nagoya Ocean of Japan in the semi final to qualify for the final match.

The AFC Futsal Club Championship 2010 also had exciting displays of skills with the mixture of Asian and foreign players from Brazil, Peru, Czech Republic and others. This was another step forward in the development of Futsal.

The excellent transportation, security, medical facilities and warmth extended to all participants contributed towards leaving a lasting and favourable experience for all parties involved in this

tournament.

In conclusion, the AFC Futsal Club Championship 2010 exhibited a high level of sporting fair play and excellent organization.

We look forward to seeing all Asian MAs create a Futsal domestic League format of competitions with home and away basis to promote Futsal and to increase the participation of more quality players in the hope of presenting historical displays in future championships

TECHNICAL AND TACTICAL ANALYSIS



The first edition of AFC Futsal Club Championship was well organized and this proved that Futsal in this continent is growing rapidly. However, more effort needs to be made by the Member Associations to increase the awareness of Futsal with home and away basis competition to accord players the opportunity to play in more matches to develop and improve upon their technical and tactical skills and awareness.

The Technical Study Group consisted of 8 local assistants who evaluated the various teams' tactics and technical aspects and it was noted that Foolad Mahan Sepahan with their young local coach who was supported by Hossein Shams as the Technical adviser, emerged as the top Futsal club in Asia after defeating Al-Saad. Not only did they become Champions but they also won the Fair Play Team Award. Nagoya Ocean defeated Port Authority 6-5 in penalty shoot-out after both team drew 6-6 after extra time to settle at third place.

Clubs were allowed to have foreign players and this helped to make the competition more competitive and exciting. It was also noted that some teams emphasized on counter attacks and

power play tactics. Clubs like Foolad Mahan, Nagoya Ocean and Port Authority substituted their players frequently but some teams rarely replaced their players for team safety and balance which resulted in the inability for their fatigue players to recover.

In general, mixed defending was common for all clubs and some clubs played with 3-1 system and at times switched to 1-3, and 2-2 formations. As for the weaker teams more work needs to be done by having more training sessions to overcome any tactical problems in defense and attack.

The general performance of goalkeepers was satisfactory. However, it would be ideal if they were to be more involved with the tactical movements of teammates with accurate ball deliveries. This should be inculcated in goalkeepers' training which would be beneficial to the improvement of their performance.

Physical Preparation

Most of the participating Clubs were well prepared for this competition. Group B had a tighter schedule with 5 teams while

Group A only had 4 teams. Players adapted well to the format of the competition but it was also evident that there was a decrease in endurance during the semi final and final round. Therefore, it is very important to factor in physical conditioning in preparation for competitions so as to maintain a strong bench that is able to give a consistent performance throughout the competition.

Technical Statistic Facts

Generally, the technical skills of the players were quite advanced. To improve further, it would be necessary for them to develop high skills of ball possession and knowledge of set plays and power play.

Mental Preparation

Team unity is vital and a positive mental approach to the game needs to be improved especially during instances when goals are conceded and the team falls behind. This will prove to be an invaluable asset in the recovery of the team during crisis.

List of Recommendations for Future Development

1. MAs to promote Futsal League format Competition on a "Home and Away Basis" to ensure that Futsal players are involved in a sufficient number of matches annually to increase exposure.
2. Futsal Coach Education is required.
3. Coaches to encourage Fair Play.
4. Clubs should prepare for AFC Futsal Club Championship by adopting the same format for local competitions.
5. A complete set of officials comprising of a Manager, Head Coach, Assistant Coach, GK Coach and Conditioning Coach for a more professional approach

REGIONAL ANALYSIS



South and Central Asia

(Foolad Sepahan, AUB, Zarafshan)

From the very close results in this Championship in Isfahan, it is clear that Futsal is making great progress at the MA level. The performances of the South and Central club's champions were strong but the other 2 clubs' performances were not up to par, Foolad Sepahan Mahan, which was from this region, emerged as Champion of the AFC Futsal Club Championship 2010.

West Asia

(Al-Saad, Nowrozi, Pro's Cafe)

The organization of leagues will develop better Futsal players and will help West Asian Member Associations compete in future Futsal competitions. As a matter of fact, West Asia introduced a new and strong representative from Qatar. Al-Saad had a very classic and good performance with foreign players. They reached the finals but this region still need a stronger performance and they also have to garner more experience to compete at a higher level.

East Asia

(Nagoya Ocean, Wuhan)

Nagoya Ocean and Wuhan displayed acceptable performances and the level of the clubs in this region were completely different from each other. Nagoya Ocean, with their Spanish coach, obtained the third position in the Championship. The noted characteristics of the team were its skillful players and the fast pace movements which are synonymous of the Japanese style of play.

Wuhan, on the other hand, did not qualify for the semi final round. Wuhan team comprises of mostly national players who played with good set pieces and tactics but there is still a need to increase their Futsal knowledge.

South East Asia

(Port Authority, NSW)

Futsal is very popular in South East Asian countries and the next AFC Futsal World Championship will be hosted in this region by Thailand. Most of the countries in this region do not have a national league format competition.

Technically, Port Authority had young players that put up good performances with their power play and maturity. NSW were physically superior but they need to balance this with sound technical and tactical aspects of the game. They had team discipline and were well organized but require more exposure at international level to make the difference. They should also focus on the development of domestic competitions and the development of specialized Futsal coaches.

VENUES & STADIUMS



Pirouzi Stadium

The inaugural AFC Futsal Club Championship was held in the Pirouzi indoor Stadium of Isfahan. The Pirouzi venue was equipped with several rooms for Medical, Doping control, Media and LOC and AFC and etc. The surface of the hall was put up especially for the tournament and had been completely renovated. The plastic surface was of the AFC standard.



Teams Training Stadiums

The team training venues were at Khorasgan and Salon Gole Narges, where all the training sessions took place. Offices were provided for the Organizing Committee and AFC Delegation and areas for the media and VIP stands.



Isfahan

Isfahan, the host of Inaugural AFC Futsal Club Championship lies at the heart of Iran is located at the 414 km south of Tehran, in the lush Zayandeh-Rood plain, at the foothill of Zagros mountain range. The city enjoys temperate climate and four equal seasons. No obstacles exist as far as 90 km north of Isfahan and cool northern winds blow in this direction. It stands at an average elevation of 1500 meters above sea level and its neighboring mountains run northwest to southeast.

Isfahan province has a population of around 4 million; of which 1.6 million live in the city of Isfahan. This city has many historical places some of them belong to after Islam, mostly to the Safavid era which was strategically located on the Silk Road.

Isfahan's glory was the capital of Iran and later moved to Shiraz and then later to Tehran. Still much remains city's attraction to make the city a must-see for present-day visitors to Iran.

There are a lot of attractive historical places such as Jameh Mosque, the largest in Iran, contains architecture from over 800 years of Persian history, and **Bazar-e Bozorg** is a huge market several kilometers long, dating from the 16th century. The next historic bridge is the almost 300m, 33-arch Si-o-Seh, which also serves as a dam for irrigation purposes. Furthermore **Chehel Sotun Palace, Ali Qapu Palace, Hasht Behesht Palace** and etc. that made Isfahan as per Iranian quote "Half of the world".



Team Managers Meeting

The team managers meeting was held on 3rd of March 2010, the day before the inaugural AFC Futsal Club Championship started and representatives of participating countries were presented in this very important coordination meeting.

ARRIVAL & COORDINATION MEETING

All the Futsal Referees and Referees Instructors reported on 1 March 2010. A Coordination meeting was conducted with the Match Officials on the 2 March 2010 at Abassi Hotel.

FITNESS TEST

The Elite Futsal Referees have attended the AFC Elite Seminar 2010 on Futsal Refereeing matters and a full fitness test was conducted during the course in February 2010. As all Referees had attended the course and passed the fitness test and the certificate was valid for 6 weeks, no test was conducted at the Championship.

PRACTICAL SESSION

The practical session was held on 3 March 2010 at Salon Gole Narges from 1400 hrs 1500 hrs. The Youth team from Esfahan assisted in the practical session.

APPOINTMENT OF REFEREES

The appointments of referees for first 2 match days were discussed and agreed by Appointment Committee comprising the Head of Delegation, Head of Administration, Match Commissioners and the Referee Assessors. The appointments of the referees were during the daily debriefing.

Subsequent appointments were discussed again with the Committee before distributing to the Futsal referees. All appointments of Futsal Referees were based on the referees' performance during the match days.

During the semi finals, the Committee agreed to send back 4 Futsal referees mainly due to the teams qualified from the same country as the referees as the performance of the referees were equal.

TRAINING PROGRAMME (DAILY DE-BRIEFING)



The Training Programme consists of daily debriefing conducted by the Instructors every morning from 0830 to 0915 hrs except on 7 March 2010. As there were 4 matches played in 1 stadium per day, the practical training were not possible.

The referees performance and decisions made by them were discussed with the assistance of match recordings from AFC AV Unit.

The referees have benefitted from the video recording of the matches with the guidance from the Instructors.

DAILY DEPARTURE OF REFEREES

As the first match commences at 1130 hrs, the first group of the match officials will leave the hotel at 0930 hrs. It took about 20 minutes from the hotel to reach the stadium.

TECHNICAL ABILITIES

As the objective of the daily debriefings was to improve the referees' performance, they were able to distinguish between good/legitimate challenges and fouls and make correct decisions. Signals and movement of referees were standardized and consistent.

With more exposures on high level of Competitions, the referees would be able have to reach the level of maturity and be parallel with the playing teams' level. The referees performed well on the whole but with more exposures, they will perform excellently.

MANAGEMENT OF PLAYERS AND TEAMS IN THE FIELD

Overall, the referees were able to manage the players well. As there was a constrain of space between the playing areas, the technical areas and warming up areas, it was quite a challenge for the 3rd Referee and the Time Keeper to monitor the warming up area and the area for flying substitution for two teams as it was always crowded with players and teams officials. They were however diligent and able to manage both areas smoothly.

On the field, there were a few incidents of players and official showing of displeasure on both the 1st and 2nd Referees' decisions in many numbers of occasions but the referees were able

to manage it calmly and in a professional manner. There was no incident of players or team officials misbehaving in an excessive manner, thus there was no serious cases forwarded to the Disciplinary Committee.

FITNESS /CONCENTRATION

The fitness level of the Referees was good and due to very limited time training time, they maintained their fitness level by going to the swimming pool. It was also noted that their level of concentration during matches was very good as there was no major discrepancy or conflict of decisions amongst the referees

STRENGTH



The referees' team spirit was very good. Their support to each other was commendable. Each referee knows their responsibility well and organization of administration, arrival, training, debriefing etc were well coordinated. On the field, their interpretation on the Laws of the Game was very good, with the exception of follow up sanctions.

POINTS FOR IMPROVEMENT

A small numbers of referees need more match exposures, locally or internationally for them to be able to have better match experience. With more exposures and experiences, they have the potential to excel further.

ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT FOR TIME KEEPERS

This Championship has set a good standard on minimum equipment required to complement this Championship. Countries that have the intention to host such Championship should provide this system for a successful Championship.

DISCIPLINE OF MATCH OFFICIALS

Although the matches were played every day from 1100 to 2100 hrs, except during rest days, the discipline of the referees were very high. They listened and abided with the instructions given from the instructors and the staff.
