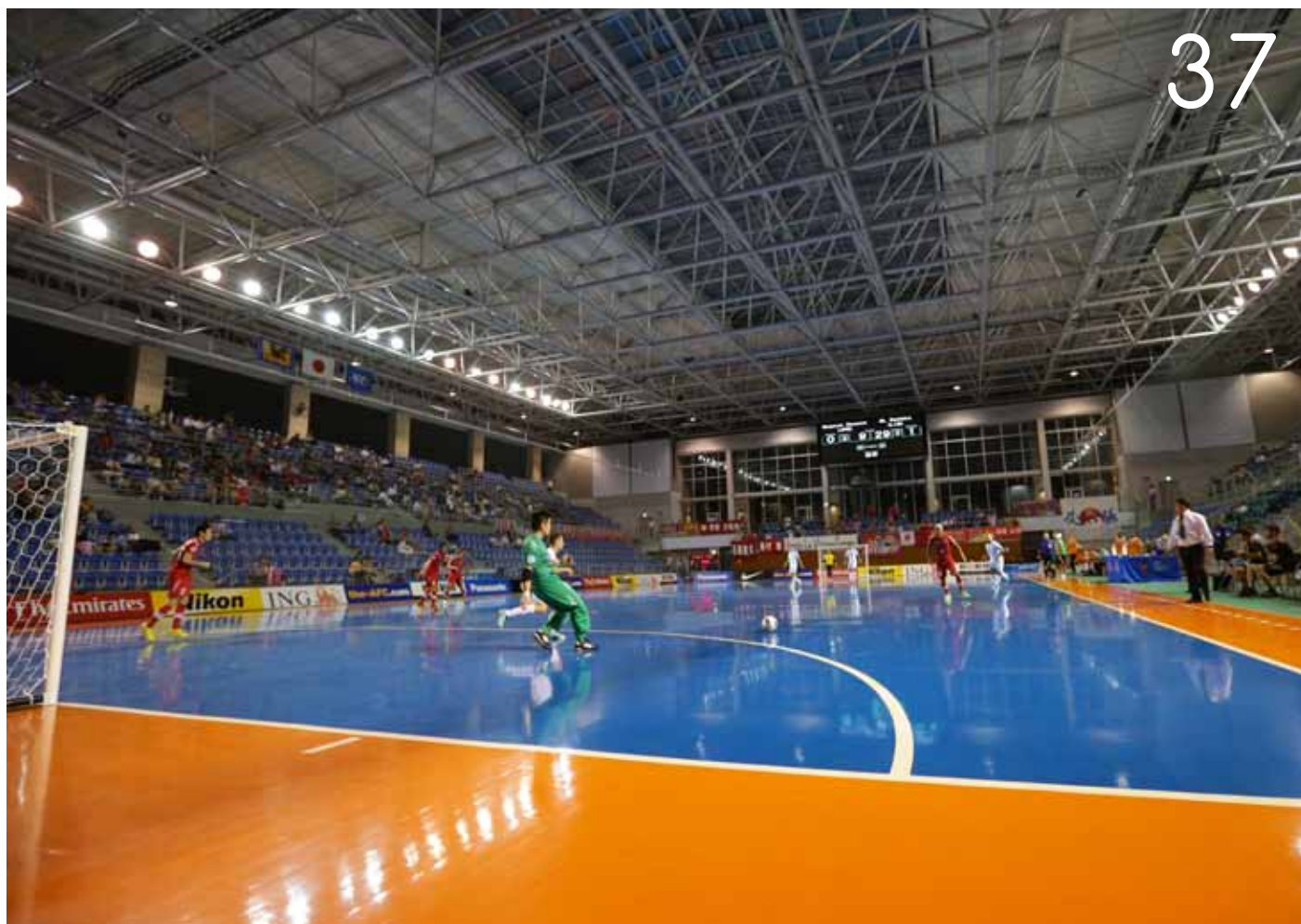

Futsal is evolving rapidly in Asia and Thailand outfit Chonburi Bluewave gave a perfect example of its rising standard by becoming the first side outside Iran or Japan to clinch the AFC Club Futsal Championship crown in Nagoya, Japan.

The Thai team's success also proves that the futsal powerhouses can no longer assure themselves of glory at the continental level. Thailand national team defeated Iran in the epic semi-final of the AFC Futsal Championship last year and Chonburi Bluewave went a step ahead to clinch the title.

We would like to congratulate Chonburi Bluewave on winning the title.

AFC Futsal Development Programme

The AFC Futsal Development Programme was created to improve the level of futsal across Asia by assisting Member Associations to help raise the standard of the game in their country.

The AFC Futsal Committee decided to conduct assessment visits to Member Associations to get a better understanding of the level of futsal throughout Asia, from the top nations that participate in the AFC Futsal Club Championship to those fledgling nations who are just starting to develop the game in their country.

These assessment visits not only allows the AFC's futsal development team to provide guidelines for MAs to systematically evaluate their futsal development status it also enables the AFC to gauge a Member Association's capability for participating in the AFC Futsal Club Championship.

Iran and Japan are seen as the two MAs that are setting the standard for futsal development in Asia thanks to their well-structured futsal pyramid and competitive, top-tier leagues, which has already seen teams from these nations win the AFC Futsal Club Championship.

And the significance of an MA having a strong domestic league was there for all to see here in Japan, where Chonburi Bluewave from Thailand joined Iranian sides Foolad Mahan and Sanaye Giti Pasand as well as Japan's Nagoya Oceans as teams to have claimed the AFC Futsal Club Championship trophy.

A major contributing factor to Chonburi's success was unquestionably that they take part in a strong Thai Futsal Premier League which proves that a healthy, competitive league can help lay the foundations for success.

In 2014 the AFC futsal team will continue its mission of assessment visits to those nations who are participating in the AFC Futsal Club Championship and potential MAs who have an established futsal structure.

Nagoya is the largest city in the Chūbu region of Japan. It is the third-largest incorporated city and the fourth most populous urban area in Japan. Located on the Pacific coast on central Honshu, it is the capital of Aichi Prefecture and is one of Japan's major ports along with those of Tokyo, Osaka, Kobe, Yokohama, Chiba, and Kitakyushu. It is also the center of Japan's third largest metropolitan region, known as the Chūkyō Metropolitan Area. As of 2000, Chūkyō Metropolitan Area has 8.74 million people, of which 2.27 million live in the city of Nagoya.

The Nagoya dialect is a dialect of the Japanese language spoken in the western half of Aichi Prefecture, centering on the city of Nagoya. It is also called Owari dialect since the area was

formerly part of Owari Province. Nagoya has humid subtropical climate with hot summers and cool winters. The summer is noticeably wetter than the winter, although appreciable precipitation falls throughout the year.

Nagoya is served by Chūbu Centrair International Airport (NGO) built on the artificial island off shore of Tokoname.

Nagoya Station, is the world's largest train station by floor area. The city is also serviced by the Nagoya Subway.

Nagoya Port is the largest port by international trade value in Japan.

The AFC Futsal Club Championship Japan 2013 was held in Nagoya from 28 August to 1 September. The venues for the tournament were Ocean Arena and Park Arena Komaki Indoor Stadium.

Eight teams took part in the fourth edition of the tournament with three clubs qualifying automatically by virtue of coming from those countries finishing in the top three at the 2012 AFC Futsal Club Championship.

Last year's finalists, champions Sanaye Giti Pasand from Iran and runners-up Ardus from Uzbekistan received direct entry along with third-place finishers Nagoya Oceans, who qualified automatically as the host country's participating club.

The other five teams booked their place in the finals via the preliminary round in April, with Chonburi Bluewave GH Bank (Thailand), Shenzhen Nanling Tielang (China) and Thai Son

Nam progressing from Zone 2 (ASEAN and East Asia) and Al Sadd (Qatar) and Al Sadaka (Lebanon) qualifying from Zone 1 (West and South/Central Asia).

Chonburi went on to lift the AFC Futsal Club Championship 2013 trophy after defeating defending champions Sanaye 4-1 on penalties following an epic final at the Ocean Arena, while hosts Nagoya finished third for the third time after the 2011 champions defeated Chinese side Shenzhen 6-4 in a highly entertaining third-place playoff earlier at the same venue.

Suphawut Thueanklang, who was at the heart of Choburi's attack throughout the competition, was named the tournament MVP while the eight goals of Kaoru Morioka saw the Nagoya star finish as the tournament's top scorer. Shenzhen won the Fair Play award.

HIGHER THAN EVER COMPETITION

Chonburi Bluewave's victory over defending champions Sanye Giti Pasand in the final of the AFC Futsal Club Championship 2013 ensured that a different team has won the trophy in each of the four editions of the tournament.

With little separating the team's this year, the level of the competition was higher than ever with quicker and more intense games. The teams often executed the 'high pressure defensive strategy while quick transitional play during changes in possession was evident in each match.

MENTAL SKILL

The teams' mentality, behaviour and approach to the match were not as passive as in previous tournaments. Players fought and pressed hard to the very end of the match and consequently a lot of goals were scored in the last few minutes.

TECHNIQUE

A marked improvement in the technical ability of players was noticeable throughout the tournament with the fundamental futsal techniques of passing, controlling and shooting having to be executed at a high pace while under pressure during the matches.

TACTICS

Most of the teams employed flexible tactics with coaches changing their attacking system or formations to adapt to the match situation or opponent.

Tactics at set-plays were not easy to execute as all teams at this level are aware of the moves and tricks although there were still a number of goals scored from corners and kick-ins during the tournament.

COACHES' INFLUENCE

Many coaches employed an aggressive substitution strategy with many teams often applying the 'four player substitute' tactic. The purpose of this was not just to save the energy of the players as it was also a way to introduce a different kind of system and playing philosophy during a game.

Teams continued to use the 'power play' at the end of the match in order to get a result but in an interesting development some coaches began utilising this tactic at the early stages of the game.

Five of the eight teams had foreign coaches who brought with them experience and knowledge gained from participating in higher levels of competition while foreign players were also given an important role in their respective teams because of their ability, leadership and playing experience.

RECOMMENDATIONS

In order to become more competitive in the tournament teams need to improve their physical condition in order to cope with the high pace and intensity of the matches.

They also have to focus more on the mental aspect of the game as it was noticeable that the form of some players dropped at times during the match when their confidence was

low. Players should be well-prepared mentally for the game and maintain a positive and confident approach at all times.

As the matches in tournament became more and more competitive there was a lot of physical contact between

players particularly in one-v-one situations. A briefing session, which could also clarify the rules relating to the sliding tackle, organised before the start of the tournament could be considered.



MATCH DAY 1



Ardus (UZB) 2-2 (0-1) Chonburi Bluewave GH Bank (THA)

Chonburi Bluewave coach Jose Maria Pazos Mendez had to settle for a share of the spoils against his former employers as last year's runners-up Ardus twice came from behind to draw 2-2 with the Thai side.

Mendez, who led Ardus to the final of the 2012 AFC Futsal Club Championship, saw Apiwat Chaemcharoen put Chonburi 1-0 up 16 minutes into the first half of a hard-fought Group A curtain-raiser only for Dilshod Rakhmatov to pull the Uzbeks level seven minutes into the second period.

Parity was short-lived, however, with Jirawat Sornwichian restoring Chonburi's lead just seconds later but Rakhmatov again came to his side's rescue, netting the equaliser in the 33rd minute to salvage a point for Ardus.

Sanaye Giti Pasand (IRN) 3-2 (2-1) Al Sadd (QAT)

Mahdi Javid's late winner saw reigning champions Sanaye Giti Pasand defeat a spirited Al Sadd 3-2 in the first match in the defence of their AFC Futsal Club Championship crown.

Iran international Ahmad Esmailpour gave the title holders a dream start by netting the opener inside the first sixty seconds before Mohammed Taheri doubled the lead just two minutes later.

Al Sadd hit back four minutes later through Samer Samih and the forward levelled the contest with his second in the 25th minute but the reigning champions were not to be denied as Javid struck with three minutes left on the clock to give Sanaye all three points.

Shenzhen Nanling Tielang FC (CHN) 2-2 (1-0) Thai Son Nam FC (VIE)

Vietnamese champions Thai Son Nam scored twice in the closing stages to overturn a two-goal deficit and draw 2-2 with their Chinese counterparts Shenzhen Nanling Tielang in their opening Group A fixture.

The two met had previously in the semi-finals of the Zone 2 qualifiers back in April, with regulation time of that match finishing 2-2 before Shenzhen went on to score twice in additional time to win 4-2 and it was the Chinese champions that controlled the fixture in Nagoya, with Iran international Masoud Daneshvar (17th) and Brazilian Danilo Moura (22nd) giving them a two-goal cushion.

Shenzhen held the lead until the 36th minute when Jesus Rodriguez Cruz reduced arrears before Thai Son Nam skipper Nguyen Bao Quan netted the equaliser with one minute left on the clock.

Nagoya Oceans (JPN) 4-2 (2-1) AL Sadaka (LIB)

Hosts Nagoya Oceans made a promising start to their campaign when they overcame an early setback to defeat Lebanese champions Al Sadaka 4-2 in their Group A curtain-raiser.

Karim Abou Zeid stunned the home fans at the Ocean Arena when he put AL Sadaka one up with just two minutes gone but the tide of the match soon turned in the Oceans' favour, with Rafael Sakai equalising in the 14th minute before Kaoru Morioka's 20th minute effort gave the Japanese side a 2-1 lead at the interval.

A Boris Cizar own goal five minutes into the second period made it 3-1 to Nagoya and after Tomoaki Watanabe scored number four a minute later Zeid completed the scoring with his and AL Sadaka's second four minutes from full time.

MATCH DAY 2



Al Sadd (QAT) 5-3(0-2) Ardus (UZB)

Al Sadd scored five second period goals to bounce back from a 2-0 half-time deficit and defeat last year's runners-up Ardus 5-3 in their second Group B match.

Goals from Farkhod Abdumavlyanov (5th) and Artur Yusanov (18th) put the Uzbeks firmly in the driving seat but a 23rd minute own goal from Jamoliddin Sharipov and a Mohamed Ismail effort barely 60 seconds later drew the Qatar champions level.

The momentum was with Al Sadd and after Samer Samih made it 3-2 with his third of the campaign (35th) team-mate Mohammed Ibrahim Rashid got his name on the scoresheet in the 38th minute before bagging his second and the Qatar champions' fifth two minutes later after Shuhrat Tojiboev had netted Ardus' third in the 39th minute.

Chonburi Bluewave GH Bank (THA) 4-3 (1-1) Sanaye Giti Pasand (IRN)

Chonburi scored three times in the final three minutes to come from 3-1 down and stun defending champions Sanaye Giti Pasand in a thrilling Group B encounter at the Ocean Arena.

Ahmad Esmaeilpour netted his second of the campaign in the 15th minute to cancel out Jirawat Sornwichian's seventh-minute opener as the two sides went into the break on level terms only for Hossein Tayebi (21st) and Mohammed Taheri (29th) to put Sanaye firmly in control on the contest.

But it was Chonburi that would ultimately take all three points with Nattavut Madyalan (37th and 40th) scoring either side of Rudimar Venancio's 39th minute leveller as the Thais completed a remarkable come-from-behind win.

AL Sadaka (LIB) 4-5 (1-2) Shenzhen Nanling Tielang FC (CHN)

Three goals in a blistering three-minute spell were not enough for AL Sadaka as He Yihui's last-gasp winner saw Shenzhen Nanling Tielang edge the Lebanese side 5-4 in a dramatic Group A match.

Shenzhen stormed to an early lead through a quickfire double from Masoud Daneshvar (1st and 3rd) before Danilo Moura quickly restored Shenzhen's two-goal advantage, scoring his second of the tournament two minutes after the restart after Kassem Kawsan had reduced the deficit with two minutes of the first period remaining.

He made it 4-1 in the 28th minute before sealing the last-minute win after goals from Karim Abou Zeid (36th and 37th) and Ali El Homsy (39th) had appeared to earn AL Sadaka a share of the spoils.

Thai Son Nam FC (VIE) 2-7 (1-5) Nagoya Oceans (JPN)

Kaoru Morioka scored four first-half goals as Nagoya Oceans booked their place in the semi-finals with a match to spare following an emphatic 7-2 win over Thai Son Nam.

The tournament hosts totally dominated the match with Morioka finding the net in the 14th minute before scoring a three-minute hat-trick (18th, 19th and 20th) after Thai Son Nam's Bruno Takashi had equalised just 60 seconds after Tomoki Yoshikawa's 11th minute opener as the Oceans took a commanding 5-1 lead at the break.

Yuki Murota and Brazilian Pedro Da Costa took the Oceans' tally to seven with goals in the 23rd and 33rd minutes respectively but it was the Vietnamese side that would round off the scoring with Nguyen Trong Thien grabbing a consolation with two minutes left on the clock.

MATCH DAY 3



Sanaye Giti Pasand (IRN) 2-1 (1-0) Ardus (UZB)

The AFC Futsal Club Championship 2012 finalists renewed acquaintances in a crucial Group B encounter that would decide who advanced to the semi-finals and as it transpired it was defending champions Sanaye Giti Pasand that booked their place in the final four with a 2-1 win over Ardus.

Mohammed Taheri opened the scoring just two minutes into the match at the Ocean Arena and Sanaye held their slender advantage until the 37th minute when Dilshod Rakhmatov levelled for Ardus.

But parity was short-lived and with a little over a minute left on the clock Mahdi Javid struck the winner that saw Sanaye advance as Group B runners-up Chonburi Bluewave, who took top spot after defeating Al Sadd 3-2 in the other match which kicked-off simultaneously at the Park Arena Komaki.

Chonburi Bluewave GH Bank (THA) 3-2 (2-2) Al Sadd (QAT)

Thailand international Suphawat Thueanklang struck the decisive goal three minutes from time as Chonburi Bluewave edged Al Sadd 3-2 to progress to the semi-finals as Group B winners.

Chonburi twice held the lead at the Park Arena Komaki only for Samer Samih to twice cancel out the Thai side's advantage from the penalty mark, with the Al Sadd star making it 1-1 four minutes after Suphawat's first-minute opener before restoring levelling the match in the 17th minute after Kritsada Wongkaeo had regained Chonburi's advantage three minutes earlier.

The deadlock remained until the 37th minute when Suphawat sealed the win that saw Chonburi finish top of Group B ahead of defending champions Sanaye Giti Pasand, who finished second in the standings after defeating 2012 runners-up Ardus 2-1 in the other match which kicked-off simultaneously at the Ocean Arena.

Nagoya Oceans (JPN) 4-1 (3-0) Shenzhen Nanling Tielang FC (CHN)

Nagoya rounded off their group stage campaign with a 100% record courtesy of a comfortable 4-1 win over Shenzhen Nanling Tielang at the Ocean Arena.

The tournament hosts dominated the first period, with Rafael Sakai bagging a brace with his goals (2nd and 14th) coming either side of Tomoaki Watanabe's 9th minute strike.

The Oceans extended their lead one minute after the interval through Korea Republic international Shin Jong-hoon before Brazilian Esteves netted a 34th minute consolation for Shenzhen, who despite the defeat were still able to claim second place in the Group A standings after Thai Son Nam missed their chance of claiming a semi-final spot after going down 6-1 to AL Sadaka in the other group game which took place at the same time at the Park Arena Komaki.

Thai Son Nam FC (VIE) 1-6 (1-2) AL Sadaka (LIB)

Vietnamese champions Thai Son Nam missed the chance of a place in the semi-finals after going down 6-1 to an AL Sadaka side that had nothing but pride to play for.

Karim Abou Zeid and Ali El Homsy gave AL Sadaka the perfect start at the Park Arena Komaki with goals in the fourth and ninth minutes respectively and although Bruno Takashi reduced the deficit in the 14th minute second-half strikes from Boris Cizmar (22nd), Zeid (32nd), Marwan Gorges (36th) and Sleimen Akil (39th) ensured an emphatic win for the Lebanese outfit.

Thai Son Nam's defeat enabled Shenzhen Nanling Tielang to finish second in Group A and advance to the semi-finals despite losing their final match 4-1 to table-topping Nagoya Oceans in the other group game, which took place at the same time at the Park Arena Komaki.

SEMI FINALS

Nagoya Oceans (JPN) 2-3 (1-2) Sanaye Giti Pasand (IRN)

Hossein Tayebi netted the last-minute winner as defending champions Sanaye Giti Pasand booked their place in the final with a 3-2 victory over Nagoya Oceans.

Nagoya went into the match at the Ocean Arena boasting a 100% record and they were on course to maintaining their unbeaten run as the tournament hosts went one up in the ninth minute through Wataru Kitahara.

Afshin Kazemi (16th) and Taha Mortazavi (18th) turned the tide in Sanaye's favour and while Nagoya levelled the match in the 32nd minute through skipper Tomoki Yoshikawa it was the title holders that would have the final say with Tayebi scoring the decisive goal with barely 60 seconds of regulation time left to play.

Chonburi Bluewave GH Bank (THA) 5-2 (5-1) Shenzhen Nanling Tielang FC (CHN)

Chonburi Bluewave scored five first-half goals to lay the foundations of a 5-2 victory over Shenzhen Nanling to set up a final showdown with defending champions Sanaye Giti Pasand, who defeated Nagoya Oceans in the earlier semi-final at the Ocean Arena.

Rudimar Venancio gave Chonburi a third minute lead and after Zhuang Jianfa had drawn Shenzhen level four minutes later the Thai side stamped their authority on the match and raced to a 5-1 half-time lead courtesy of braces from Suphawut Thueangklang (8th and 15th) and Tanakorn Santanaprasit, who scored both his goals in the 16th minute.

Chonburi took their foot of the gas in the second period but all Shenzhen could muster was a 40th minute consolation from Masoud Daneshvar as the Thais defeated their Chinese counterparts for the third time following their two victories in the qualifiers.



3rd/4th PLACING

Nagoya Oceans (JPN) 6-4 (3-3) Shenzhen Nanling Tielang FC (CHN)

Nagoya Oceans finished third for the third time in four AFC Futsal Club Championships after coming from 2-0 down to defeat Shenzhen Nanling Tielang 6-4 in an entertaining third-place decider.

Led by former Nagoya coach Jose Adil Amarante, who guided the Oceans to the 2011 title as well as third-place finishes in 2010 and 2012, Shenzhen found themselves 2-0 up courtesy of He Yuhui's double (8th and 15th) but the half would end all square with Kaoru Morioka (16th), Pedro Da Costa (18th) and goalkeeper Ryuma Shinoda (18th) on target for Nagoya and Masoud Daneshvar (19th) scoring Shenzhen's third.

Nagoya took the initiative after the restart with Hidekazu Shirakata making it 4-3 one minute into the second period before Morioka extended the advantage in the 26th minute and although Daneshvar would reduce the deficit (28th) the Oceans were not to be denied with Morioka completing his hat-trick and sealing the win in the 36th minute.



FINAL

Sanaye Giti Pasand (IRN) 1-1 a.e.t. (1-1, 1-0) 1-4 PSO Chonburi Bluewave GH Bank (THA)

Chonburi Bluewave were crowned AFC Futsal Club Championship 2013 champions after beating title holders Sanaye Giti Pasand 4-1 on penalties to deny the Iranians back-to-back triumphs and become the first team from Thailand to lift the trophy.

Hossein Tayebi's fifth-minute strike looked enough to have seen Sanaye successfully retain their title only for Suphawut Thueangklang to equalise in the last minute to send a tense and evenly-fought final at the Ocean Arena into extra-time.

With neither side able to broke the deadlock the match went to penalties and it was Chonburi who held their nerve the best, with Suphawut, Kritsada Wongkaeo, Jirawat Sornwichian and Nattavut Madyalan all converting their spot-kicks while only Sanaye's first penalty taker, Mohammed Taheri, was able to put the ball past Chonburi's Iranian goalkeeper Esmaeil Abbasian Mehr.

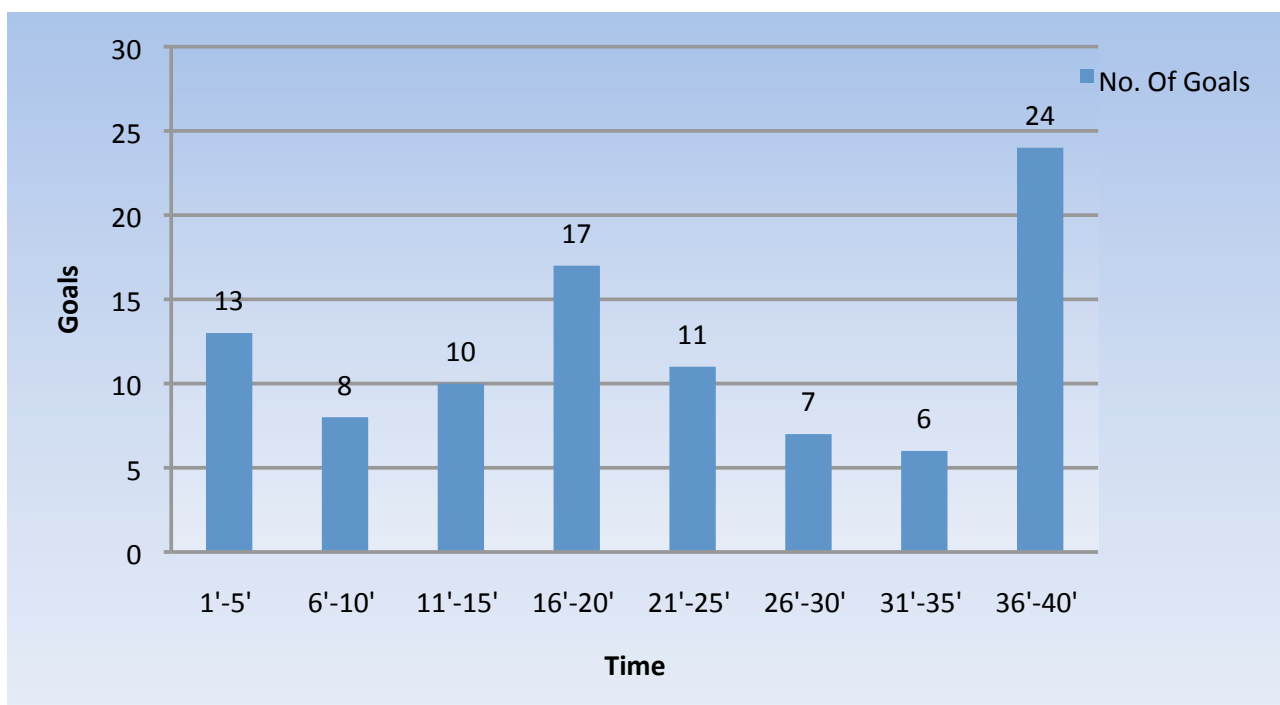

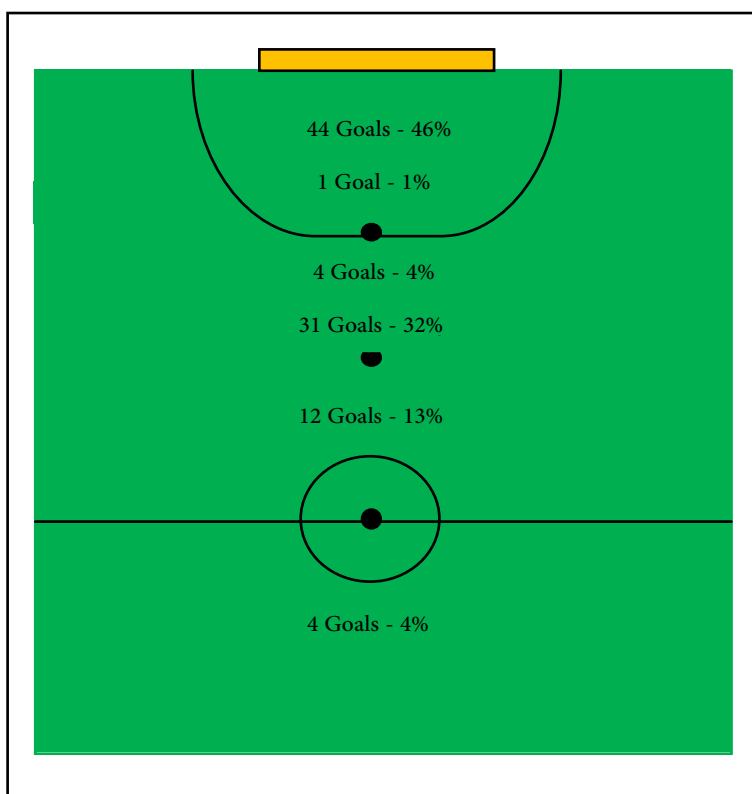

Parallel with the rapid and progressive technical development of the game of futsal as well as the increase in number of participation in the championship, the AFC endeavours with paramount importance that no stone is left unturned in the protection of players' health and to ensure fair play.

MEDICAL INFRASTRUCTURE

With the excellent support and co-operation of the LOC Medical Committee led by Prof. Dr. Toru Fukubayashi, Chairman of Japan Football Association Medical Committee, and Mr. Hiratsuka Susumi, the medical services and infrastructure were in place for the championship as per international standard. The AFC appointed Dr. Paisal Chantarapitak and Dr. Halim Bin Mokhtar, members of the Elite Panel of Medical Officers, to oversee the medical aspects and doping control implementation for the tournament. The AFC Medical Officers were satisfied with the infrastructure and services provided to the teams and officials on and off the field.

DOPING CONTROL

In line with the AFC's continuous fight against doping and to ensure fair play, doping control was carried out in 10 matches, with one player per team in each of the 10 matches randomly drawn for testing. All of the 20 players tested proved to be negative. The co-operation of the team

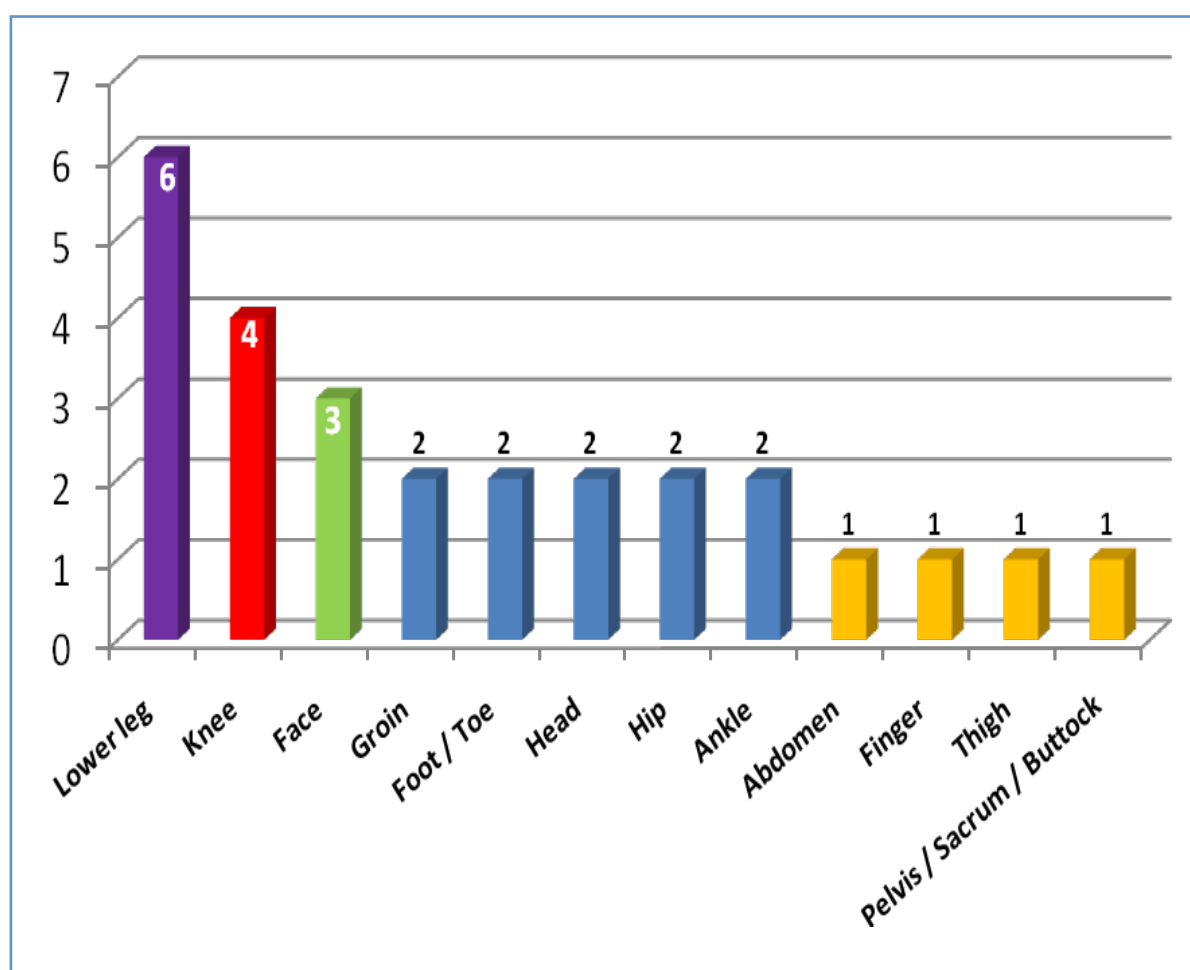
doctors and physiotherapists while conducting the doping control was admirable.

INJURY STUDY GATHERS VALUABLE DATA

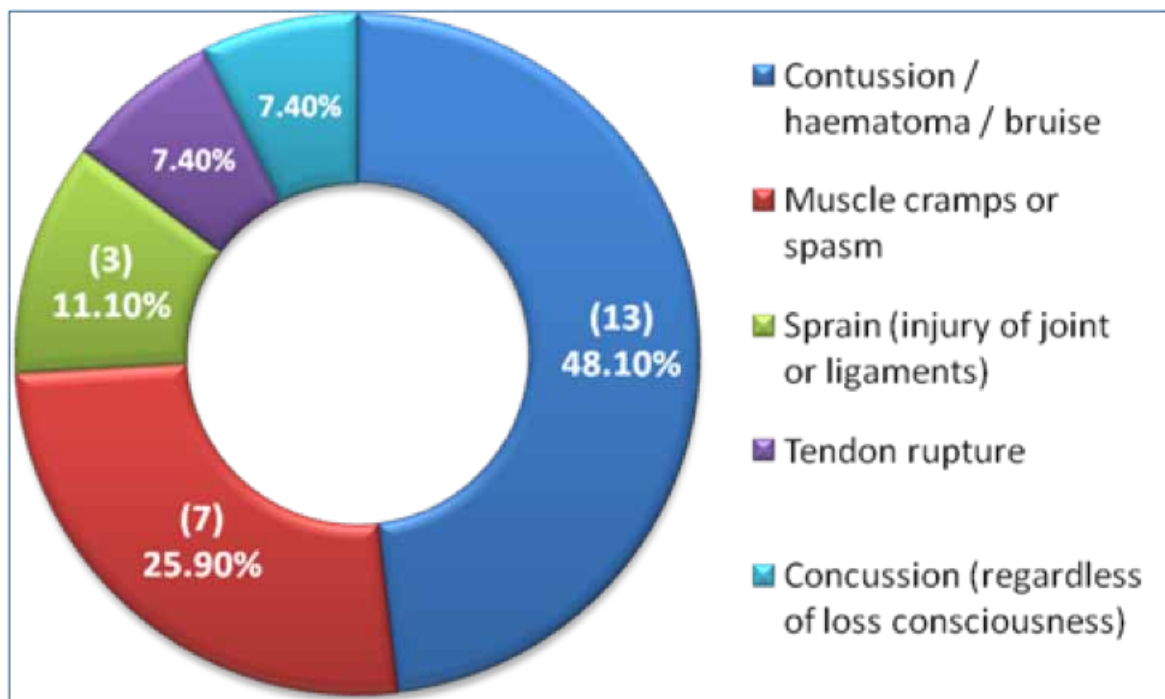
As part of the on-going collaboration with F-MARC in conducting injury studies at AFC tournaments the team physicians and physiotherapists were asked to report all injuries sustained by the players during training and matches as well as the illnesses suffered by the players during the tournament. The importance of the role of the team physician in recording the injuries and illnesses was explained during the pre-competition medical co-ordination meeting held on 26 August. The significance of accurate recording was emphasized as data gathered is compiled as scientific evidence to support the development of programs in injury prevention. The level of co-operation was commendable as 100% compliance was achieved.

For this edition of the Futsal Club Championship, twenty seven 27 injuries in the 16 matches were reported. The injury ratio is 1.69 (27/16) and severity of 0.41 whereby team physicians reported a combined 11 days absence of players due to injuries.

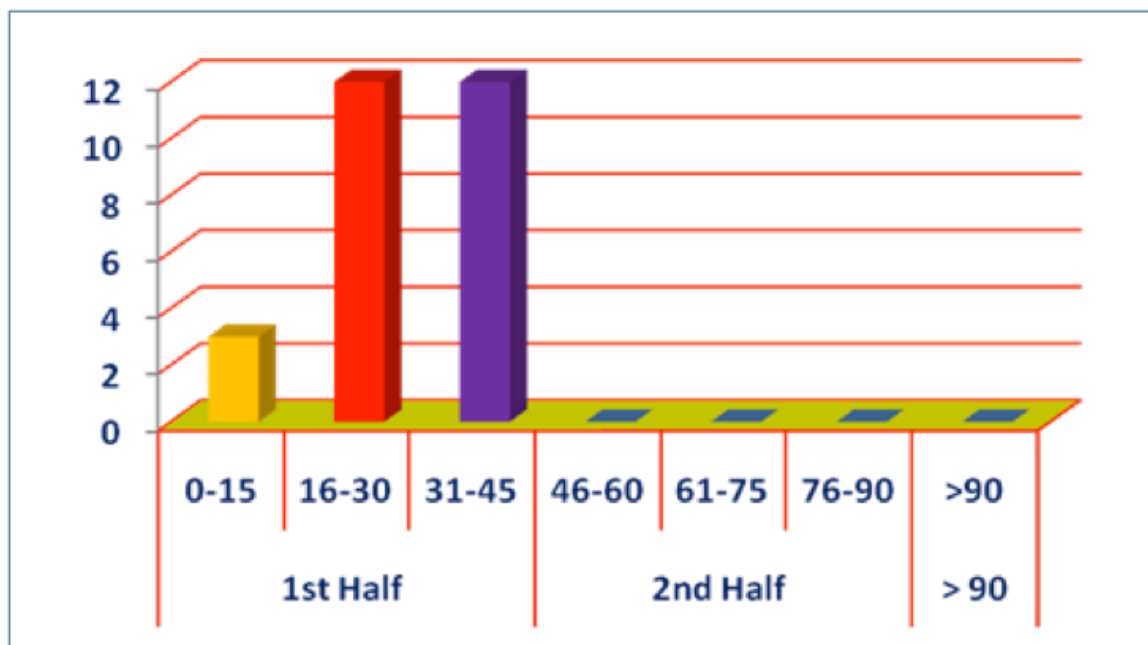
The location of the 27 injuries were: lower leg (22.2%), knee (14.8%), face (11.8%) and two cases on the groin, ankle, foot, hip and the head. The most frequent diagnoses were contusion, sprain, and spasm.

COMPARISON WITH FOOTBALL

Correlating the injuries in futsal with football based on the statistics, there were less numbers of injuries in futsal than football but the severity of the injuries in futsal was high. The reason for this is that while the playing field is smaller than outdoor football, players cover shorter distance and require fast movement and sudden maneuvers.

TEAM DOCTORS' MEETING: ENHANCING KNOWLEDGE

The pre-competition medical co-ordination meeting, which was held on 26 August, enabled the AFC Medical Department to provide updates on the current regulations and development in doping control and football medicine. It was also a good opportunity for the LOC Medical Committee to explain the local medical services prepared for the teams.

The AFC Medical Officer gave presentations on doping control procedure, therapeutic use exemption updates, and the WADA prohibited list. The team doctors and physiotherapists were extremely pleased with the new knowledge and updates.

ARRIVAL & COORDINATION MEETING

All the Futsal Referees and Referees Instructors reported on 24 August 2013.

FITNESS TEST

The fitness test for referees was conducted on 25 August at Aichi Gakuin University from 0700 to 0900. All referees passed the required time for the fitness test. The fitness test was conducted by two assessors/instructors who were assisted by two helpers from the LOC (local organising committee). The medical team and ambulance were present to assist.



PRACTICAL SESSIONS

The practical sessions during the Preparatory Course were held at Park Arena Komaki on 25 June and Ocean Arena Hall on 26 June from 1430 to 1630.



APPOINTMENT OF REFEREES

The appointment of referees was decided for the first two match days and distributed to the referees. The list of appointments was given to the Head of Delegation, Head of Administration and Match Commissioners. Subsequent appointments were distributed to the relevant officials after discussion with the Instructors for each match day. Appointments were based on the referees' performance during the tournament. After the group stage, four futsal referees were released from the competition.



DAILY BRIEFING AND DEBRIEFING

Briefing and debriefing sessions were held in the referees' meeting room the Hilton Nagoya hotel from 0800 to 0900. The debriefing sessions began with the referee team giving their own assessment of the match and their performance in the previous day's match. After this, appropriate incidents from the DVD were discussed for the referees to improve further. Team tactics from that game were also discussed as was the referees' considerations for the next games involving these teams. A flip board was used to clearly explain incidents.



HOSPITALITY BY LOC

On the refereeing side, the LOC has did exceptionally well. The LOC and the hotel staff were very accommodating and provided good assistance and support to the referees and the instructors. The transport during training and on match days was very well co-ordinated. The referees were given free internet access, gym and swimming pool facilities for them to have recovery after each match day.

OVERALL PERFORMANCE OF REFEREES

All matches were generally played in the spirit of fair play and the players respected the decisions of the referees. There were no major errors committed by the match officials which affected the result of the game. The teamwork, co-operation and communication among the referees was encouraging. The overall performance of the referees was very good.

DISCIPLINE OF MATCH OFFICIALS

Although the matches were played every day from 1200 to 1930, except during rest days, the discipline of the referees was very high. They listened and abided with the instructions given from the instructors and the staff. The camaraderie between the referees was very good and they supported one another after each match, with words of encouragement and motivation during the daily debriefing session.

The referees and the instructors convey their appreciation to the AFC and the LOC for good organization and hospitality.

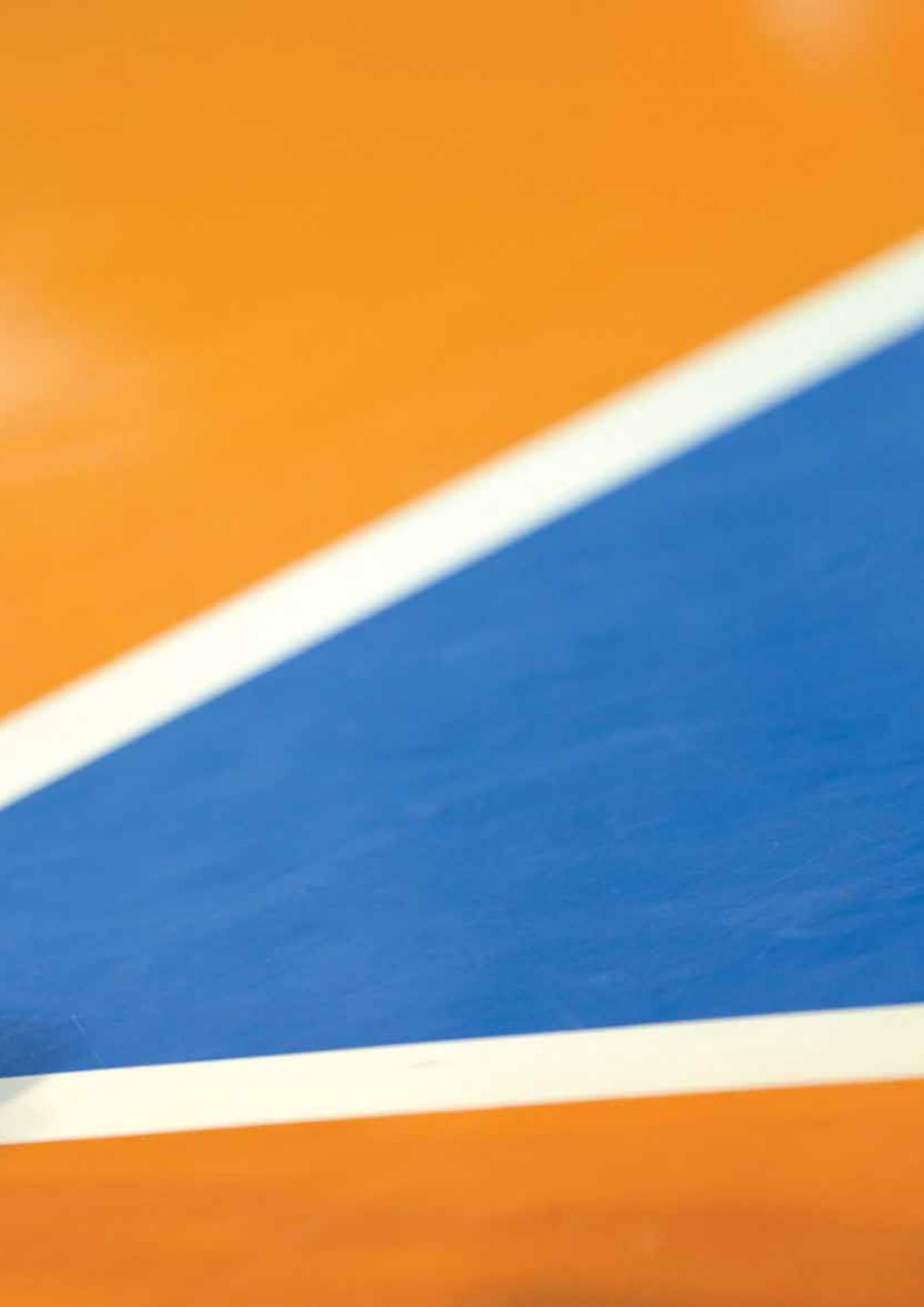
