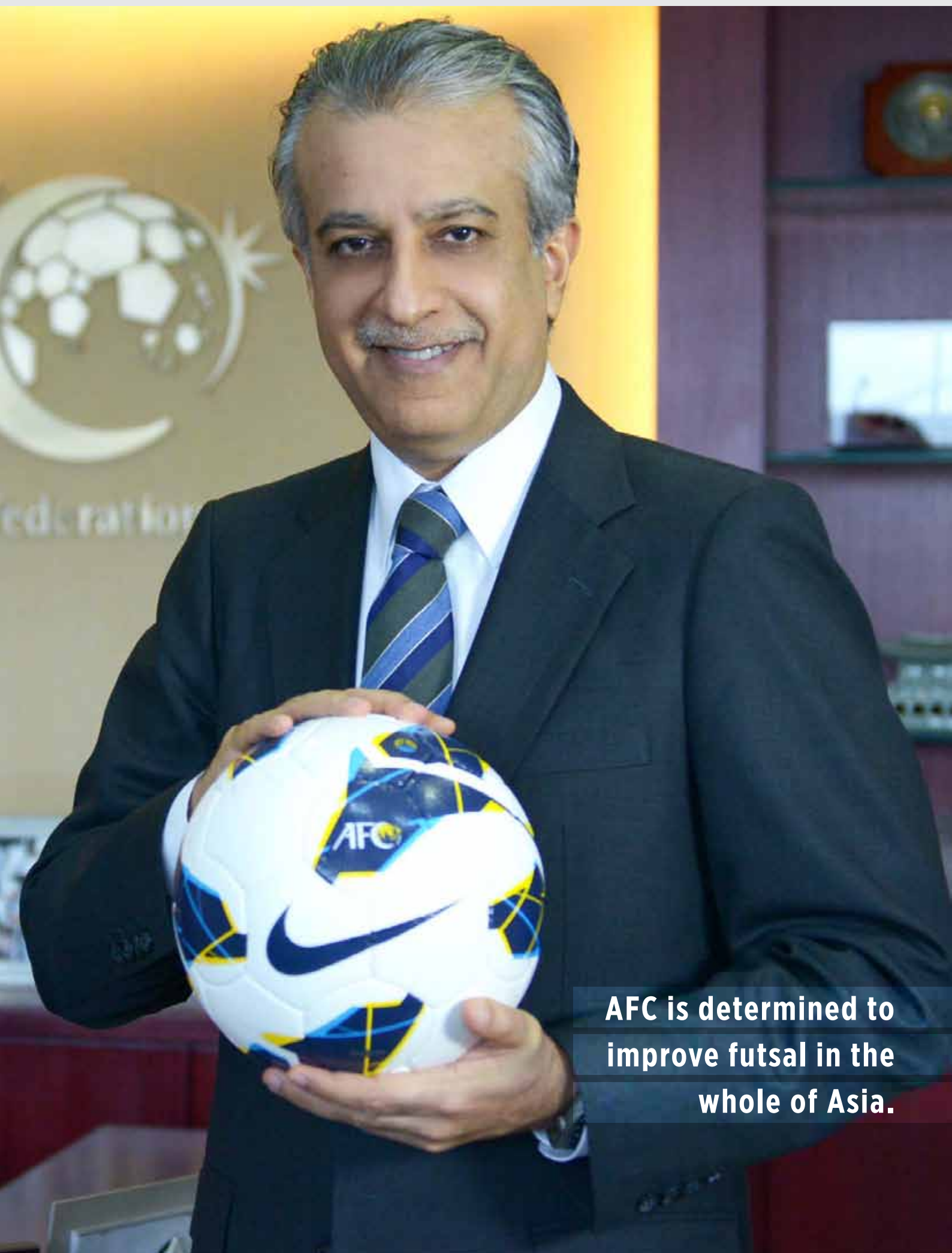

Tournament Overview

GENERAL • HOST CITY INFORMATION - CHENGDU, CHINA

Chengdu is the capital of Sichuan Province, which is known as the “Heavenly State” (Tian Fu Zhi Guo). The natural habitat of the giant panda, Chengdu is located in the west of Sichuan Basin and in the centre of Chengdu Plain. It covers a total area of 12.3 thousand square kilometres (4,749 square miles) with a population of over 11 million.

Benefiting from the Dujiangyan Irrigation Project which was

constructed in 256 B.C., Sichuan Province is known as “Tian Fu Zhi Guo”, literally a place richly endowed with natural resources. Chengdu, as the capital, is extremely productive. The Min and Tuo Rivers, two branches of the Yangtze River connect to forty other rivers and supply an irrigation area of more than 700 square kilometres (270.27 square miles) with 150-180 million kilowatts of water. Containing abundant mineral resources, the land is extremely fertile.





GENERAL • TOURNAMENT OVERVIEW





The AFC Futsal Club Championship China 2014 was concluded successfully in the city of Chengdu from 25-30 August 2014 where a total of eight qualified clubs competed.

This is the fifth edition of the AFC Futsal Club Championship and the majority of the teams are improving extremely quickly, most of the matches were high in tempo, with plenty of high pressure. Nagoya Oceans of Japan won the title, beating Chonburi Bluewave of Thailand, who won the previous edition in 2013, in the final.

Third place went to Dabiri Tabriz of Iran and fourth place went to Shenzhen Nanling Tielang of China. During the entire tournament, a total of 16 matches were played and a total of 127 goals were scored. The overall top scorer was Kaoru Morioka from Nagoya Oceans who scored a total of five goals.

The Fair Play Award was awarded to Nagoya Oceans, being the team who collected the most Fair Play points in the competition. The Most Valuable Player of the competition was awarded to Kaoru Morika who had a major influence on the individual matches and the overall competition. Overall, it was an interesting and competitive tournament, with good sportsmanship and teamwork.

TOURNAMENT ANALYSIS • TECHNICAL ANALYSIS

The AFC Futsal Club Championship China 2014, held at the the Shuangliu Sports Center, was a truly successful event and it ended with Japan's Nagoya Oceans being crowned champions of the tournament – their second championship win and the first team to reach this feat in AFC Futsal Club Championship history.

Eight teams fought it out in Chengdu, China and it was a truly exciting tournament from start to finish. A total of 127 goals were scored from the 16 matches, at an average of 7.9 goals per match, compared to the 96 goals that were scored in the previous edition of the tournament. The number of goals reflects the aggressive nature of the game played by most clubs, signifying the declining influence of the cautious approach.

The clubs in this tournament often executed the “high pressure” defensive strategy, whilst displaying quick transitional play once in possession that was evident in each match. Majority of the matches were played in high tempo. The teams fight and press until the end of the match, which also resulted in plenty of goals being scored in the last few minutes.

There were lots of improvements in the players' technical ability with the fundamental futsal techniques in dribbling, controlling and shooting being all the more evident as the players were required to execute them at a high pace while under pressure during the matches.

Most of the teams carried out their tactics flexibly as they rarely stuck with only one attacking form/system, and instead kept

changing according to the situation and adapting to the different oppositions.

COACHES INFERENCE

More clubs applied the 4 players substitute 4 players strategy in order to keep their high pressure tactics & keep the match always in a higher tempo. On the other hand, some coaches executed two different tactics through 2 groups of players.

Time Out - will no longer just to give some information when the coach found that their team not performs well but rather applied this in the very late of a tight match to execute a set play.

Power play – Some coaches applied this to get result or to kill the time in pretty early of the 2nd half when they were leading. However, there were very few successful examples in this tournament.

RECOMMENDATION

- Clubs should have youth development programme in order to develop young players for the upcoming AFC Futsal tournaments.
- Clubs need to improve their physical condition in order to cope with the high pace and intensity of the matches as well as being mentally prepared before the tournament.





TOURNAMENT ANALYSIS • STORY OF THE TOURNAMENT

MATCH DAY 1

25 August 2014

Group A: Nagoya Oceans (JPN) 3-1 Lokomotiv FC (UZB)

Chengdu: Former champions Nagoya Oceans got their 2014 AFC Futsal Club Championship campaign off to winning ways with a 3-1 victory over Lokomotiv Tashkent in the Group A opener at Shuangliu Sports Centre.

Hidekazu Shirakata was on target for the 2011 champions in the first half as he found space on the edge of the penalty area to powerfully lace the ball past Oleg Tukmakov into the top left-hand corner. The Oceans continued to dictate the play in the second half and a strike from team captain Tomoki Yoshikawa and an own goal from Konstantin Sviridov gave Nagoya a three-goal lead their play largely merited.

Farkhod Abdumavlyanov, though, pulled a goal back for Lokomotiv with three minutes of the tie remaining to give their more experienced opponents a nervous finale on their way to claiming all three points.

Group B: Dabiri Tabriz (IRN) 5-1 Bank of Beirut SC (LIB)

Chengdu: Iranian champions Dabiri Tabriz put on a five star showing in their AFC Futsal Club Championship opener with a 5-1 win over Bank of Beirut SC in the Group B tie at Shuangliu Sports Centre.

Bank of Beirut SC goalkeeper Hussein Hamadani had threatened to frustrate the Tabriz forwards with a series of spectacular saves until four minutes before the interval when Javad Asghari made the breakthrough.

Vahid Shafiei and Farid Namazi were then on target after the re-start but Bank of Beirut SC did a pull goal back, as a mix-up between Iranian goalkeeper Alireza Samimi and his defenders allowed Ali Tneich to prod home from close-range. But as the Lebanese club began to visibly tire, Farhad Fakhim and Nasrollah Momen took advantage by netting in the closing minutes of the game.

Group A: Shenzhen Nanling Tielang FC (CHN) 3-0 Vic Vipers (AUS)

Chengdu: Home side Shenzhen Nanling Tielang cruised through their AFC Futsal Club Championship opener with a comfortable 3-0 win over Vic Vipers of Australia at Shuangliu Sports Centre.

Hatakeyama and Rubinho dictated much of the play for the Shenzhen, causing the Australians to struggle to get a grip on the game, and the pair forced smart saves out of Vic Vipers goalkeeper Kieran Pates in the opening spell of the match.

Deng Tao opened the scoring for the 2013 semi-finalists halfway through the first period with a well-worked team move resulting in Deng stabbing the ball over the line from close range. Cong Lin then scored immediately after the half time break as he volleyed past Pates from a corner. Zeng Liang also scored from a corner for Shenzhen's third goal resulting in a scoreline that reflected the Chinese side's dominance of proceedings.

Group B: Chonburi Bluewave (THA) 4-4 Al Qadsia (KUW)

Chengdu: Defending champions Chonburi shared a rollercoaster 4-4 draw with tournament debutants Al Qadsia in their action-packed AFC Futsal Club Championship Group B opener at Shuangliu Sports Centre.

The Kuwaiti side took the lead in the first-half through Brazilian Rafinha but Chonburi hit back in the second-half with goals from Rudimar Venancio, Sarawut Jaipetch and Jirawat Sonrwichian before Al Qadsia saw their goalscorer sent off midway through the second-half following two yellow cards.

Abdulrahman Al Wadi and then Salem Al Mekaimi then brought the scores level before Al Qadsia captain Meshari Al Nakkas thought he'd capped an improbable comeback with a goal in the closing minutes. Unfortunately, Al Nakkas' day was to finish on a bittersweet note as his own goal in the final minute of play salvaged a point for Chonburi.





MATCH DAY 2

26 August 2014

Group A: Vic Vipers (AUS) 0-6 Nagoya Oceans (JPN)

Chengdu: Nagoya Oceans underlined their ambitions for a second AFC Futsal Club Championship title with a dominant 6-0 win over Vic Vipers in this Group A tie.

The 2011 winners had taken the lead as Nagoya captain Yoshikawa adroitly stepped inside his marker and struck a swerving drive past the Vic Vipers goalkeeper. Ximbinha then scored two goals, the first after some intricate play with Wataru Kitahara and Tomoaki Watanbe, while the second was down to his superb individual skill which saw him teeing himself up for a stunning volley past a stationary Pates.

Morika then capped off a nightmare three minute spell for Vic Vipers with a fourth goal for the irrepressible white-clad side as the bleach-blond player bamboozled Adam Cooper before hammering the ball into the top right hand corner.

While the floodgates were closed for a time, Ximbinha did not have to wait long for his hat-trick as a passing combination with Yagi put him through on Pates goal and the Brazilian slotted confidently home to make the score 5-0 with five minutes of the half remaining.

Seven minutes after the interval, Nagoya Oceans scored a sixth as Yagi pounced on a loose ball in the Vic Vipers penalty area and fired into the unguarded net past an already committed Pates.

Group B: Al Qadsia (KUW) 2-7 Dabiri Tabriz (IRN)

Chengdu: Dabiri Tabriz qualified for the AFC Futsal Club Championships semi-finals after a comprehensive 7 -2 win over Al Qadsia in Group B.

Abdulrahman Al Tawail had given Al Qadsia the lead within the first five minutes of the game but goals from Morteza Ezzati and Nasrollah Momen put Tabriz in front at the stroke of half-time.

Dabiri Tabriz picked up where they left off in the second half, as Babak Akbari and Farid Namazi were both on target for the Iranian club after the re-start before Hamad Al Wadhi pulled one back for Al Qadsia to put the score at 4-2. But as the Kuwaiti club tired, Tabriz profited; Behroz Jafari, Javad Asghari and Vahid Shafiei all finding the net to put the gloss on an impressive second-half performance.

Group A: Lokomotiv FC (UZB) 2-6 Shenzhen Nanling Tielang FC (CHN)

Chengdu: Shenzhen Nanling Tielang and Nagoya Oceans qualified for the semi-finals of the AFC Futsal Club Championship from Group A after home side Shenzhen claimed a 6-2 win over Lokomotiv Tashkent at Shuangliu Sports Centre.

Lokomotiv had begun the tie on the front foot, but it was the home side who took the lead on six minutes as Cong Lin ghosted into the penalty area to prod in Lu Yue's free-kick. Two minutes later Shenzhen doubled the lead with Lu once again the provider, this time playing in Liang Shiming who slammed the ball past Oleg Tukmakov. They then went three up thanks to a goal from Rubinho. The first half proved to be a rout for the Shenzhen as Liang scored his brace and a further goal from Zeng Liang provided the Chinese team a 5-0 lead.

Oleg Khalmukhamedov scored one for Lokomotiv before the stroke of half time and Artur Yusunov scored their second right after half time. The comeback was halted however as Rubinho scored his second of the night from distance and sealed the three points for Shenzhen.

Group B: Bank of Beirut SC (LIB) 0-4 Chonburi Bluewave (THA)

Chengdu: Suphawut Thueanklang scored a brace as defending champions Chonburi Bluewave recorded a first win of the AFC Futsal Club Championship following a 4-0 victory over tournament newcomers Bank of Beirut SC at Shuangliu Sports Centre.

MVP at the 2013 edition, Suphawut scored the first-half's only goal on eight minutes to give the holders a 1-0 lead at the interval over the hard-working Lebanese side.

After the re-start, goals from Apiwat Chaemcharoen and then a solo effort from Nattavut Madyalan gave Chonburi some breathing room before Ali Tneich's deliberate handball resulted in his dismissal and spot-kick that Suphawut duly dispatched to cement the three points for the defending champions.

MATCH DAY 3

27 August 2014

Group A: Shenzhen Nanling Tielang FC (CHN) 6-6 Nagoya Oceans (JPN)

Chengdu: Former champions Nagoya Oceans secured top spot in Group A and a semi-final meeting with Dabiri Tabriz after a hugely entertaining 6-6 draw with home side Shenzhen Nanling Tielang in the final AFC Futsal Club Championship group stage game.

The first-half at Shuangliu Sports Centre was a battle of the Brazilians as Danilo scored a hat-trick for Shenzhen and Nagoya's Ximbinha scored his fourth and fifth goals of the tournament as the sides went into the interval with the scores at 4-3 after Wataru Kitahara and He Yihui also found the net.

The second-half continued in at a furious rate of play as Tomoaki Watanabe and Deng Tao exchange goals before the lead switched back to Nagoya after Hidekazu Shirakata levelled and Kaoru Morioka put the Japanese side in front once more, before an own-goal from Morioka ended the goal-fest at six apiece.

Group B: Chonburi Bluewave (THA) 3-1 Dabiri Tabriz (IRN)

Chengdu: Defending champions Chonburi Bluewave secured a place in the AFC Futsal Club Championship semi-finals as Group B winners after they leap-frogged Dabiri Tabriz into top spot with a 3-1 win over the Iranian side.

Suphawut Thueanklang notched his third goal of the tournament from the penalty spot in the first half before Jirawat Sornwichian doubled the lead just after the midway point in the second period. A goal from Farid Namazi ratcheted up the tension with four minutes of the game remaining, but then he gave away a sixth foul in the final minute of the game for another penalty however this time Samimi came out on top as he blocked Suphawut's strike with his body.

With Tabriz fully committed up field, Mehr intercepted the ball and hurled it up the pitch, where it took a deflection off Namazi on its way into the net to confirm all three points and a semi-final place as Group B winners for Chonburi.

Group A: Lokomotiv FC (UZB) 7-3 Vic Vipers (AUS)

Chengdu: Miguel Barrigos started the scoring barely one minute into the match with a quick strike from the left flank but Farkhod Abdumavlyyanov equalized for Lokomotiv a mere two minutes later before Brazilian Fernando's netted an own goal to make the score 2-1 in favour of Yusupov's team. Vic Vipers were scored in the final minute of the first half, with Barrigos once again on the finishing end of a Fernando cross.

Vitaly Borisov slammed home a first time shot three minutes into the second half, giving Lokomotiv the lead 3-2, and Azizov's goal four minutes later led to the Uzbeks utilizing the power play, and the beginning of the end for the Vic Vipers.

The pressure of a fifth outfield player proved too much for the Australians, as Lokomotiv scored three more unanswered goals with Abdumavlyyanov and Borisov each completing their braces before the Uzbek's final goal came three minutes from the end from Khalmukhamedov to end the scoreline at 7-3.

Group B: Bank of Beirut SC (LIB) 7-10 Al Qadsia (KUW)

Chengdu: The scoring in the action-packed match began less than two minutes in, with Bank of Beirut SC taking the lead through Mohammad Iskandarani's right foot after an assist from Yasser Salman. The Lebanese club scored again just a minute later, after a Rafinha foul led to a free kick which Ahmad Kheireldine slammed home, making it 2-0 for Bank of Beirut SC.

The quick goals forced Al Qadsia to step up a gear and they pulled within one after an opportunistic header from Al Awadhi just past the five minute mark, and then goals from Rafinha and Abdulrahman Al Tawail put the Kuwaiti club ahead 3-2 at the interval.

Al Qadsia started the second half the stronger, scoring two quick goals via Rafinha and Salem Al Mekaimi before Bank of Beirut's Rudolpho Da Costa floated one in from long-range to reduce the deficit to two and make the score 5-3. Al Awadhi squeezed his second past the goal keeper to put Al Qadsia a further goal up before a flurry of action in which Samer Al Deen and Hamad Al Awadhi both completed their hat-tricks to take the Al Qadsia total to double digits while Salman and Da Costa replied for the Lebanese to put the score at 10-5.

Beirut SC managed to hit the target twice more in the final minute of the match as Ali El Homsy netted and Kheireldine completed his brace.

SEMI FINALS

29 August 2014

Nagoya Oceans (JPN) 6-2 Dabiri Tabriz (IRN)

Chengdu: It was Nagoya who took the lead after two minutes as Alireza Samimi palmed away Shirakata's shot only as far as Tomoaki Watanabe who bravely slid in to roof the ball past the custodian. On the sixth minute Nagoya double their lead after Morioka's shot was blocked on the goal line, and the loose ball fell only as far as an alert Tomoki Yoshikawa who prodded home.

Tabriz, though, had soon reduced the deficit to one as Mohammad Koohestani's long-range effort took a wicked deflection off Sakai that left Shinoda wrong-footed. And with seven minutes played the scores were tied, as Asghari rolled a freekick short for Farhad Fakhim to fire home past Nagoya's defensive wall for his second goal of the tournament.

Nagoya regained the lead in the second half with Morioka's shot-cum-cross from right to left that met a grateful Kitahara at the far post to bundle home. Kitahara then scored again minutes later to make it 4-2. With Tabriz using the power-play in desperation to pull goals back, they were caught out at the back by custodian Shinoda who took advantage of Tabriz's five outfield players to drop-kick a long range effort into an empty net.

And with just a minute remaining, Morioka got the goal he deserved by easily rounding stand-in goalkeeper Fakhim isolated on the half-way line, and side-footing home into an unguarded net to secure a historic victory for Nagoya.

Chonburi Bluewave (THA) 6-3 Shenzhen Nanling Tielang FC (CHN)

Chengdu: Having beaten Shenzhen in last year's semi-final on their way to their historic victory in Nagoya, Jose Maria Pazos would have been hoping for a carbon copy campaign in Chengdu and after just six minutes Rudimar Venancio gave them a lead.

And the defending champions' lead doubled less than a minute later as Venancio turned provider, steering a pass towards the back post that Jirawat Sornwichan slid onto to force home. Just before the midway point of the half, though, Shenzhen had reduced the deficit as He Yihui held off Chonburi goalkeeper Esmaeil Mehr and unleashed a low shot on the turn that zipped into the bottom right-hand corner.

Keattiyot Chalaemkhet and Tanakorn Santanaprasit then scored two goals thanks to assists from Thai target man Sarawut Jaipech. But on the cusp of half-time their advantage was cut to two with Lu Yue squaring for Deng to slot home for his third goal of the tournament to put the scores at 4-2 at the interval.

In the second period, though, it was all one-way traffic as Suphawut Thueanklang struck and Jirawat completed his brace. Although he scored a final consolation goal at the death for Shenzhen, it was too little and too late to prevent Chonburi securing a meeting with Nagoya in the final.

3rd/4th PLACING

30 August 2014

Dabiri Tabriz (IRN) 5 - 5 (7 - 6 PSO) Shenzhen Nanling Tielang FC (CHN)

Chengdu: Both sides showed attacking intent from the kick-off and it took a little over a minute before the game had its first goal. Babak Akbari drilled a pass down to Vahid Shafiei deep on the Shenzhen right-flank and the cushioned return found the onrushing Akbari who finished smartly past Wei Zheng.

Three minutes later, though, Rubinho had the leveler with a belting drive from the left-side that rocketed into the top-corner. Rubinho turned provider for Shenzhen's second as his ball into the penalty area was slid home by an alert Takashi Hatakeyama to put the home side in front on six minutes.

Farid Namazi soon had his fourth of the tournament after he cleverly back-heeled Mortteza Ezzati's through ball past an out-foxed Wei to equalize for Tabriz. A pair of stunning strikes from Shenzhen's Brazilian Rubinho and a goal from Takashi Hatakeyama was answered by efforts from Babak Akbari, Farid Namazi and Mohammad Ghasemi of Tabriz to put the scores level at 3-3 at half-time.

Rubinho then completed his hat-trick in the second period, but Namazi's second and a Farhad Fakhim strike had looked to put Tabriz in the driving seat until Zeng Liang's equaliser four minutes from time. But after Tabriz goalkeeper Alireza Samimi saved from Zeng having earlier also denied Kuang Xuanpu in a tense shootout, Koohestani held his nerve to claim victory for the Iranian side.





FINAL

30 August 2014

Nagoya Oceans (JPN) 5-4 Chonburi Bluewave (THA)

Chengdu: Wataru Kitahara's dramatic winner in the last minute of extra-time saw Nagoya Oceans become the first ever two-time winners of the AFC Futsal Club Championship after a 5-4 win over defending champions Chonburi Bluewave in the final following a 4-4 deadlock in regulation time at Shuangliu Sports Centre.

Having memorably won the 2011 edition, Nagoya emphatically crowned their return to the tournament's finale after consecutive third-place finishes in 2012 and 2013. But the Japanese team were made to earn the right to Asia's premiere futsal title in a rollercoaster tie that saw the lead change hands on multiple occasions.

Goals from Jirawat Sornwichian and Rudimar Venancio sandwiched Kitahara's first of the night as the Thai side went into the interval 2-1 up. But after Hidekazu Shirakata and Kaoru Morioko had flipped the score around Sarawut Jaipetch twice pulled the Thai side level after Morioko netted a brace to see the sides tied at 4-4.

It seemed as if neither team would make use of the additional ten minutes of time, until a minute from the end Morioko found Watanabe and his ball from left to right was turned in by Kitahara at the back post to give Nagoya a historic victory deep into extra time.

For this year’s edition of the AFC Futsal Club Championship, AFC medical support covered various areas to ensure that medical care was readily and efficiently carried out when needed; to update the knowledge of the persons responsible for the health welfare of the players; to provide support in the fight against age-cheating; to conduct doping tests with interactive education sessions with the players and officials; and to gather data on incidences of injury.

To achieve the objectives, the AFC appointed AFC Medical Officers Dr. Roy Arya from India and Dr. Nguyen Van Phu from Vietnam to oversee the medical support during the competition.

DOPING CONTROL DURING THE TOURNAMENT

In-competition dope tests were conducted during the tournament involving twenty (20) players. One player per team in each of the 16 matches was randomly drawn for doping. All doping tests proved to be negative.

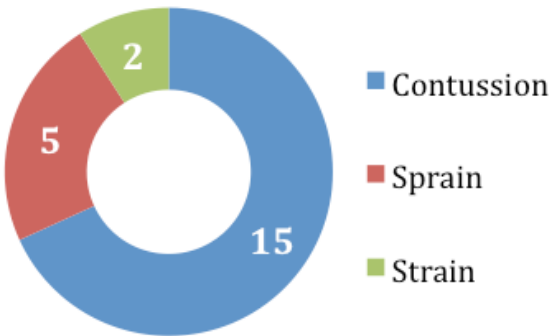
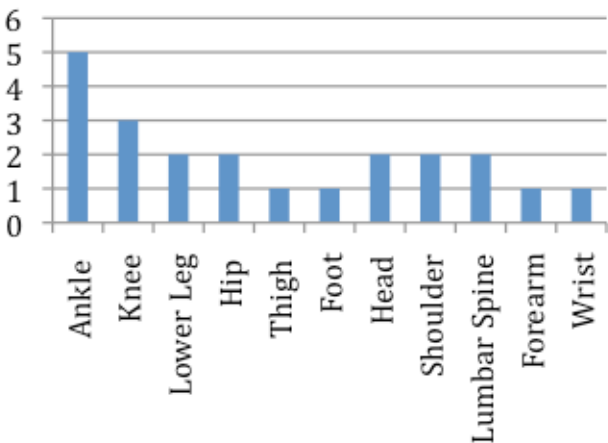
COORDINATION MEETING

Coordination meetings with the teams’ physicians and teams’ physiotherapists were organised on 20 August prior to the start of the competition with 100 percent attendance.

The coordination meeting focused on the role of the teams’ physicians and teams’ physiotherapists as per the competition regulations which includes medical procedures, doping control tests and injury surveillance.

INJURY SURVEILLANCE

Injury surveillance is a routine activity at all AFC tournaments, and the teams’ physicians were asked for their cooperation in recording and submitting the daily medical reports on injuries and illnesses occurring during matches and non-match days. The importance of the injury recording was emphasised to the team doctors and team physiotherapists during the coordination meeting.



A combined total of 22 injuries from the 16 matches were reported. The top three locations of injuries were the knee (5), ankle (3) & lower leg (1).

The most frequent diagnoses were contusion (68.2%), sprain (22.7%) and muscle strains (9%). On average, severity is 1.3 (total of 25 days absence of players in training and matches due to injuries).

INTRODUCTION

This is fifth AFC Futsal Club Championship. All of the 12 AFC Match officials and two standby referees from AFC Futsal Referees 2014 were appointed. All the appointed referees were given the opportunity to be assessed, guided and supported during this tournament and they have performed very well. Referees Fitness Instructor was also appointed for this championship.

ARRIVAL & COORDINATION MEETING

All the Futsal Referees and Referees Instructors and a Referees Fitness Instructor reported on 22 August 2014.

PREPARATORY COURSE

The aim of the Preparatory Course is to ensure the referees ready physical and mental to officiate the Competition. Three main elements conducted during the course are:

- 1) **Fitness-Test**
- 2) **Theoretical Session**
- 3) **Practical Session**

FITNESS TEST

The fitness test for Referees was conducted on 23 August 2014 at Shuangliu Sports Centre, Chengdu at 1730 to 1830 hrs. The Referee Fitness Instructor conducted the test with support from Futsal Referees Instructors. All Referees and Standby Referees passed the required time for the fitness test. The medical team and ambulance were present to assist.



THEORETICAL SESSION

Presentations by the Instructors added a lot to referees' knowledge. Two sessions of Preparatory Course were conducted on 23 & 24 August 2014. Referees were urged to be committed, courageous and be consistent when they perform on the pitch. The key points covered and delivered were as follows:

- 1) **Consistency/Uniformity on Foul Regnasation/Degree of Foul**
- 2) **Protecting the Players**
- 3) **Let Game Flow**
- 4) **Substitution Bench Control**
- 5) **Other related topics**

PRACTICAL SESSION

Two practical sessions during Preparatory Course was plan in two different stadiums (main and second stadium), however due to the second stadium not being ready, the referees only had practical training at the main venue. Futsal Referee Instructors conducted the simulation training.

APPOINTMENT OF REFEREES

The appointment of referees, for the first match days, was decided one day before the match (after the debriefing session) and distributed to the referees. The lists of appointments were given to the Head of Delegation, Head of Administration and Match Commissioners. Subsequent appointments were distributed to the relevant officials after discussion with the Instructors for each match day. Appointments were based on the neutrality, referees' performance etc.

After the group stage and semi-finals matches, four referees were released from the competition: Referees from China (1), UAE (1) and Vietnam (1)





DAILY BRIEFING AND DE-BRIEFING

Briefing and de-briefing sessions were held in the Jinjiang Hotel, at 1100 – 1230. The debriefing session is to recap the referees' performance and correct or explain the referees' decisions from the previous day's matches and to assist further improvement. Appointed RA conducted the session and they used the appropriate incidents clips from the match DVD. Team tactics from that game were also discussed for the referees to consider for the next games involving these teams.

HOSPITALITY BY LOC

On the refereeing side, LOC has done exceptionally well. The LOC and the hotel staff were very accommodating and provided good assistance and support to the referees and the instructors. The transport during training and on match days, were very well coordinated. The referees were given free internet access as well as gym and swimming pool facilities to help them recover after each match day.

OVERALL PERFORMANCE OF REFEREES

All matches were generally played in the spirit of fair play and the players respected the decisions of the referees. There were no major errors committed by the match officials which affected the result of the match. The teamwork, cooperation and communication among the referees was encouraging. The overall performance of the referees was very good.
