The Resources Developer's responsibilities include but not limited to the following:

- Edit and compile match video clips for the AFC Referees Department's catalogue and further applications.
- Design, schedule and monitor activities on the various AFC Referees Department's online learning platforms.
- Archive and categorise content on the various AFC Referees Department's online learning platforms.
- Develop online and e-learning – as and when necessary.
- Produce audiovisual content, including providing script, filming and editing.
- Produce other relevant content such as graphic elements, product tutorials, presentations – as and when necessary.
- Provide audiovisual support at development and operations events in various forms.
