The AFC Futsal Club Championship 2015 held between July 31 and August 7 in IR Iran showed once again, the excitement the sport can generate and provided a platform on which to demonstrate the AFC's continued commitment to futsal development.

The sixth edition of the AFC Futsal Club Championship, which involved 12 teams competing in Isfahan, IR Iran, showed that teams are rapidly improving. A total of 143 goals were scored in the 20 high tempo matches - an increase on the 127 goals scored in the previous edition. For the 2015 Championship, these figures translate to an average of 7.15 goals per match, reflecting the attacking style of the game.

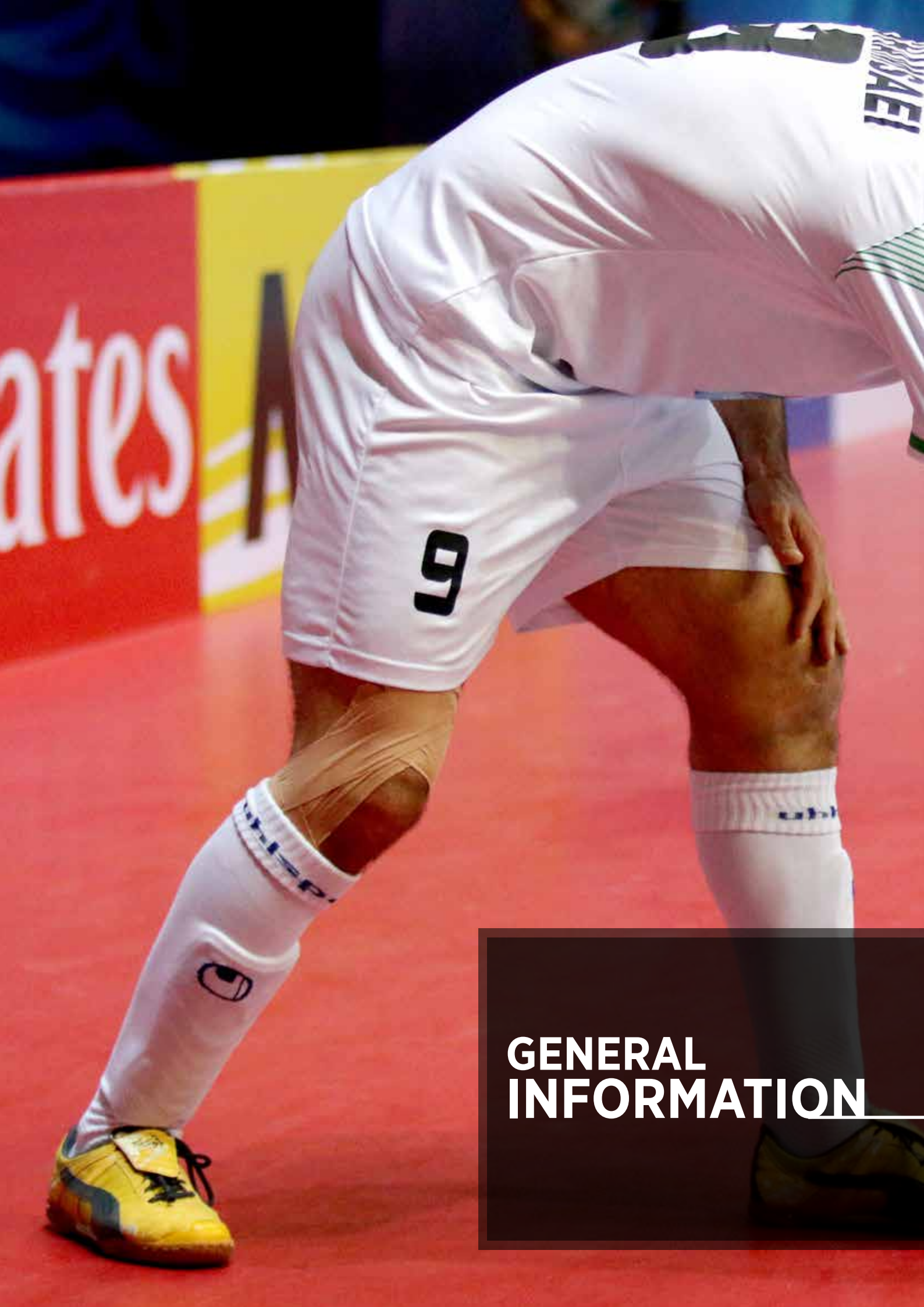

With the FIFA Futsal Championship, Colombia looming in 2016, let us lift our game and challenge the rest of the world.

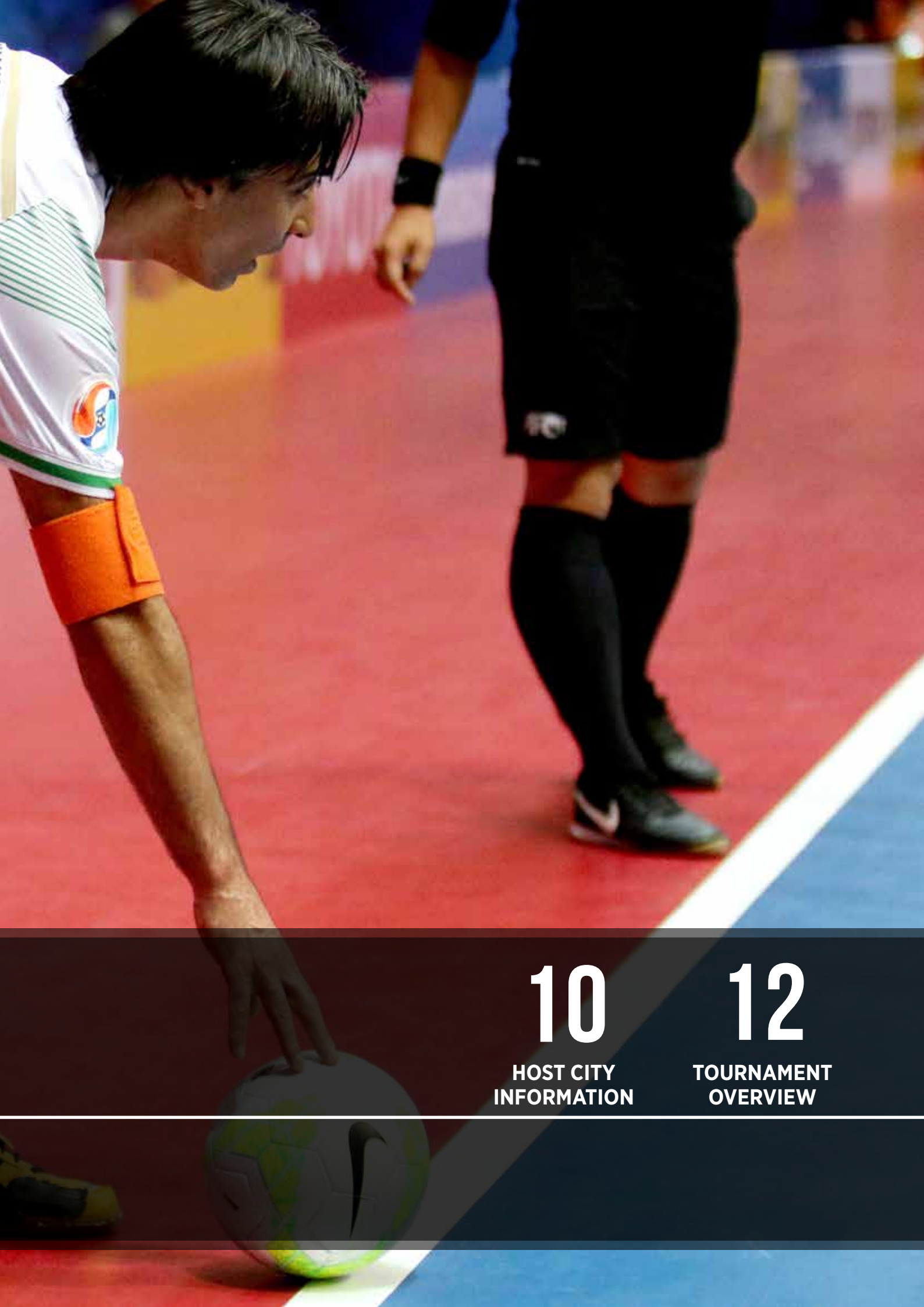

# ISFAHAN, IR. IRAN

Isfahan, historically also rendered in English as Ispahan, Sepahan, Esfahan or Hispahan, is the capital of Isfahan Province in Iran, located about 340 kilometres (211 miles) south of Tehran. It has a population of 1,755,382 and is Iran's third largest city after Tehran and Mashhad. The Greater Isfahan Region had a population of 3,793,101 in the 2011 Census, the third most populous metropolitan area in Iran after Tehran and Mashhad.

The cities of Zarrinshahr, Fooladshahr and Najafabad, Se-deh, Shahinshahr, Mobarakeh, Falavarjan and Charmahin all constitute the metropolitan city of Isfahan.

Isfahan is located on the main north–south and east–west routes crossing Iran, and was once one of the largest cities in the world. It flourished from 1050 to 1722, particularly in the 16th century under the Safavid dynasty, when it became the capital of Persia for the second time in its history. Even today, the city retains much of its past glory. It is famous for its Persian–Islamic architecture, with many beautiful boulevards, covered bridges, palaces, mosques, and minarets.

# AFC FUTSAL CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP IRAN 2015

**T**he AFC Futsal Club Championship IR Iran 2015 was successfully held in the city of Isfahan from July 31 until August 7, 2015.

A total of 12 clubs participated in the tournament which was eventually won by Tasisat Daryaei (Iran) when they successfully defeated Qadsia SC (Kuwait) in the final. Third place went to Thai Son Nam (Vietnam), with NAFTA Al Wasat Club (Iraq) grabbing the fourth spot.

This is the sixth edition of AFC Futsal Club Championship and the majority of the teams are improving extremely quickly, most of the matches were played at a high tempo with lots of high pressure.

During the entire tournament, a total of 20 matches were played and a total of 143 goals were scored by various teams. The overall top scorer was Vahid Shamsaee from Tasisat Daryaei (Iran) who scored a total of 10 goals.

The Most Valuable Player of the competition award was conferred to Vahid Shamsaee who had a major influence on his team's matches and the competition as a whole. For collecting the most Fair Play points in the competition, Thai Son Nam (Vietnam) were awarded the Fair Play Award.

Overall, it was an exciting and highly competitive tournament, with good sportsmanship and teamwork on display throughout.

# TOURNAMENT ANALYSIS • Technical Analysis



**T**he AFC Futsal Club Championship, year after year, underlines the good levels of futsal that the active Asian nations have achieved.

There is, however, some way to go until the goals set by the AFC are achieved, and a lot of work to be done with management and officials. There is also a need to change the mentality of our players in order to ensure the sport improves.

In regard to the 2015 Championship, the number of teams competing should be reviewed. It was far from ideal for some teams to travel long distances, play two games, not have a chance to win the third and, therefore, be unable to go through to the second stage.

We should also work to achieve stricter tournament regulations – for example, coaches who have the correct licenses, the inability to loan players from other clubs purely for this Championship - which must then be respected by all the clubs competing.

As one of Asia’s premier futsal powers, Iran must resolve some technical issues so as to ensure success at future competitions. Some of the other more advanced Asian sides such as Japan,



Uzbekistan, Thailand and China must also work on their club strategies and how they plan for events such as the AFC Futsal Club Championship.

Was a big surprise to have most of the above countries out of the tournament from the 1st stage because of misunderstanding of the rules and Regulations (Like Thai Team) or because of the Extra self confidence the others had.





## TACTICS

A lot of coaches used Power Play not only as a means of attack, but also to defend - something which was witnessed on too many occasions during the tournament.

Time Outs were used not only when there was a close match, but also as an aid to organising a set play – on the whole, this was a very successful approach.

## RECOMMENDATION

- Teams need to be more flexible with their attacking formations - The better teams such as Japan and Thailand did not have one or two fixed attacking formations or systems. Instead, they kept changing according to the situation and opposition.
- An ability to keep pressing – The players' average physical condition must be improved in order for them to be able to continually pressurise opponents. This is one of the best ways to force opposing team to make mistakes.
- The anti-press ability - More and more teams applied a high pressure strategy in the majority

of the matches. This appears to be the trend in defending.

- Clubs should have Youth Development Programmes in order to develop young players for the upcoming AFC Futsal tournaments.
- Clubs need to improve their physical condition in order to cope with the high pace and intensity. They must also be well prepared mentally before the tournament.
- It is a major duty of all team managers to be well versed with the tournament regulations in order to give players the best chance for competitive excellence and to avoid any potential misunderstanding.

### Group D: Shenzhen Nanling Tielang 1-5 Thai Son Nam

A five-goal blitz in the second half earned Vietnam's Thai Son Nam FC a 5-1 win over Shenzhen Nanling Tieland FC as the Vietnamese side kicked off Group D of the AFC Futsal Club Championship in impressive style at Nagshe Jahan Stadium.

Saul Olomo Campo scored a hat-trick while Tran Long Vu and Le Quoc Nam also found the back of the net as Thai Son Nam over-ran the Chinese side, who had taken the lead in the 18th minute through Zeng Lang's top class curling effort.

Victory for Thai Son Nam against Bank of Beirut in their second Group D game will ensure the Vietnamese side advance to the quarter-finals at the top of the group while Shenzhen must beat the Lebanese team to have any chance of advancing.

Both teams hit the frame of the goal in the opening period before Zeng put Shenzhen in front in the 18th minute with a curling left-foot shot into the top corner from distance that goalkeeper Ngo Dinh Thuan could do little to stop.

But the Vietnamese battled back in the second half and Campo scored from the spot after Long Vu was brought down in the area in the 26th minute and, three minutes later, Long Vu netted from a tight angle after breaking down the right to give Thai Som Nam the win.

Quoc Nam doubled his side's advantage from close range with four minutes left on the clock and Campo

claimed two in the dying minutes – one on the break, the other from long range – as Shenzhen desperately pushed forward looking for a late reprieve that never came.

### Group C: Chonburi Bluewave 3-2 NAFT AI Wasat Club

Former champions Chonburi Bluewave started their 2015 AFC Futsal Club Championship campaign with a 3-2 win over NAFT AI Wasat, but the 2013 winners were made to fight all the way by the Iraqi side at Nagshe Jahan Stadium in their opening Group C encounter.

Jirawat Sorniwichian scored twice for Chonburi – who lost last year's final on penalties to Nagoya Oceans – and Sarawut Jaiepech also found the back of the net for the Thais while Waleed Khalid Fahem struck twice for NAFT AI Wasat.

The win means victory for Chonburi in their next game against Al Rayyan from Qatar will see Rakphol Sainetngam's side finish top of the group, while NAFT AI Wasat need to defeat the Qataris to remain in the competition.

Jirawat gave Chonburi the lead in the 16th minute as the Thai champions eventually found a way past goalkeeper Omar Sabti, and it took until the 28th minute for Chonburi to add to their tally when Sarawut steered Suttiroj Natthpon's shot over the line.

A second for Jirawat looked set to ease Chonburi into control of the game when he finished off a one-two with Lerthcai Issarasuwipakorn in emphatic fashion,

but Fahem struck for a second time in the 31st minute to keep the game in the balance.

With five minutes remaining, Mustafa Bachay charged down the right flank for NAFT AI Wasat before firing off a shot that beat Chonburi goalkeeper Katawut Hankampa only for the ball to rebound back into play via the post.

## Group B: Nagoya Oceans 5-2 Lokomotiv

Rafael Sakai struck twice as defending champions Nagoya Oceans kicked off the campaign in Group B of the 2015 AFC Futsal Club Championship with a comfortable 5-2 win over Uzbekistan's Lokomotiv at Nagshe Jahan Stadium.

Sakai's brace ensured Nagoya went into the half-time break leading despite Sarvar Shaakhmedov cancelling out the Nagoya player's fourth-minute opening strike.

However, second-half goals from Ryuta Hoshi, Matias Maedonchi and Pedro Costa sealed all three points before Shokirjon Khadiev claimed a consolation for Lokomotiv three minutes from time.

Nagoya made a flying start to the game with Sakai claiming his first after just three minutes, running across the face of goal before hitting his left foot shot into the corner of Akmaljon Kazratkulov's goal.

But in the 16th minute the Uzbeks levelled when Fakhod Mirakhmedov's shot following a well-worked free kick was turned over the line by Shaakhmedov standing at the post.

Two minutes later, however, Nagoya were back in front following a move that saw Kaoru Morioka slide the ball through to Tomoki Yoshikawa and his centre was converted by Sakai.

Nagoya then doubled their lead two minutes into the second half when Hoshi struck a low shot that beat Kazratkulov to his right, and in the 32nd minute Maedonchi put the result beyond doubt when he slipped the ball below the goalkeeper.

Costa then smashed his shot home from 10 metres out before Khadiev netted a late second for the Uzbeks.

## Group A: Tasisat Daryaei 8-1 Al Khaleej SC

Hosts Tasisat Daryaei made a statement of their intent at the 2015 AFC Futsal Club Championship as Vahid Shamsaee led his team to an 8-1 win in Group A over an outclassed Al Khaleej from the United Arab Emirates at Nagshe Jahan Stadium.

The game was over as a contest long before half-time as the home team led 6-1 at the interval, with all six goals for the Iranian side coming from different scorers.

Veteran superstar Shamsaee scored a goal in each half, claiming his side's third after Ghasem Orouji opened the scoring just two minutes into the game while Rashid Obaid put through his own net six minutes later.

Shamsaee scored a minute later before Mohammed Keshavaraz, Ghodrat Bahadori and Saeid Ahmad Abbasi all netted to give Tasisat an unassailable lead.

Yousif Mohamed scored on the stroke of halftime for Al Khaleej but further goals from Asghar Hassanzadeh and Shamsaee in the second half confirmed Tasisat's superiority.

Orouji put Tasisat in front with just two minutes on the clock, thrashing home from wide on the right to give Talal Khaled in the Al Khaleej goal no chance, while six minutes later Obeid turned Abbasi's cross into his own goal.

Shamsaee lashed his attempt home from distance in the ninth minute before Keshavaraz made it 4-0 with a header and Bahadori claimed the fifth from the tightest of angles on the left.

Abbasi scored the sixth with the simplest of finishes to complete a flowing move one minute before the break, and with only seconds left on the clock Mohamed hit Tasisat on the break to open Al Khaleej's account.

Hassanzadeh's left foot strike a minute after the restart restored Tasisat's six-goal advantage and Shamsaee made it 8-1 with another goal from distance, beating Khaled low and to his right.



## Group D: Bank of Beirut 3-3 Thai Son Nam

Thai Son Nam booked their place in the quarter-finals of the 2015 AFC Futsal Club despite being held to a 3-3 draw by Bank of Beirut in their Group D meeting in Nagshe Jahan Stadium.

The draw, coupled with their win over Shenzhen Nanling Tielang means the Vietnamese club cannot finish outside the top two places in their group and they will advance to Tuesday's last eight.

Rudolpho Costa scored twice for Bank of Beirut in their opening game of the competition while Ahmad Kheir El Dine also found the back of the net as Tran Van Vu, Ngo Ngoc Son and an own goal from El Dine registered for Thai Son Nam.

Da Costa gave Bank of Beirut the perfect start when he slammed his effort into the top corner after just 19 seconds, but Van Vu levelled for the Vietnamese, scoring at the second attempt after goalkeeper Hussain Hamadani blocked his initial effort.

On the stroke of half time, Thai Son Nam took the lead when Van Vu's effort was deflected into his own goal by El Dine but, two minutes after the restart the scores were level again when Da Costa scored with another effort from outside the area in the 25th minute.

A rapid-fire break less than a minute later saw Ngoc Son race down the left before centring to Duong Anh Tung before coming back inside to finish off a fantastic move.

Bank of Beirut responded five minutes later when El

Dine made amends for his own goal by netting the equaliser that ensures the Lebanese side goes into their meeting with Shenzhen needing only a draw to progress.

## Group C: Al Rayyan SC 2-3 NAFT Al Wasat Club

NAFT Al Wasat kept their hopes of a place in the quarter-finals of the AFC Futsal Club Championship alive with a 3-2 win over Al Rayyan from Qatar at the Nagshe Jahan Stadium.

The win moves the Iraqis level with Chonburi Bluewave at the top of Group C, with the Thai side due to face Al Rayyan knowing a draw will be enough to advance to the last eight while the Qataris must win to have any hope of remaining in the competition. NAFT picked up their first win of the tournament thanks to two goals from Mahammed Naser and the opener from Firas Mohammed while an impressive showing from goal-keeper Omar Sabti was also key to the victory.

Goals from Rashid Yousuef and Lucas Oliveira stirred a late comeback from Al Rayyan, but the Iraqis managed to hold on to collect the points.

NAFT took the lead after 14 minutes when, after a storming run down the left, Naser whipped a vicious ball into the area and Firas converted from close range.

Three minutes later, Al Rayyan should have scored only for Diego Nunes to miss the target from close range. Three minutes later, the Brazilian hit the frame of the goal.

Six minutes into the second half, Naser made it 2-0 to NAFT with a fiercely struck free kick that beat Sepehr Mohammadi low and to his right, while at the other end Sabti's reflex save saw him push Ali Al Sabah's shot onto the crossbar in the 30th minute.

Seconds later, the Al Sabah hit the frame of the goal as Al Rayyan's frustrations continued and, as the Qataris pushed forward looking for a way back into the game, Naser claimed his second on the break, rolling the ball into the empty net.

Rashid Yousef responded immediately with a shot from wide on the left while, with just over three minutes remaining, Lucas scored from close range to put the result in doubt once again, only for NAFT to close out the result thanks to further heroics in goal from Sabti.

## Group B: MFC Emgek 8-3 Lokomotiv

Kyrgyzstan's MFC Emgek secured a place in the quarter-finals of the AFC Futsal Club Championship with a 8-3 win over Lokomotiv at Naghse Jahal Stadium while the side from Uzbekistan became the first team to exit the 2015 edition of the continental competition.

Lokomotiv lost their opener to reigning champions Nagoya Oceans and not even a brace from Sarvar Shaakhmedov could save Akhadjon Yusupov's men from elimination.

Ruslan Ermekov claimed a hat-trick and Ilias Chotbaev scored twice while Salamat Mambetaliev, Akparaly Danibaev and Ruslan Gafurov also found the back of the net for the Kyrgyz side, who will go into the quarter-finals no matter the result in Sunday's meeting with Nagoya.

Chotbaev put MFC Emgek in front after just two minutes with a well-struck effort from wide on the right, but three minutes later Shaakhmedov had levelled when he swept the ball past goalkeeper Kirill Ermolov.

Mambetaliev put MFC back in front from the penalty spot in the 12th minute before Shaakhmedov equalised again for Lokomotiv when his shot from the edge of the area went under Ermolov.

Just a minute after the restart MFC regained the

lead when Ermekov scored with a free kick and three minutes later the club from Kyrgyzstan extended their advantage as Danibaev clipped the ball under goalkeeper Khazratkulov.

Tokhir Abdurazzakov scored for Lokomotiv from close range in the 25th minute to keep the outcome in the balance but, as the Uzbeks pushed forward looking for the goal required to level the game, Ermekov claimed two more while Chotbaev and Gafurov also netted.

## Group A: Qadsia 9-1 Al Khaleej SC

Qadsia cruised through to the quarter-finals of the AFC Futsal Club Championship with a comprehensive 9-1 thrashing of Al Khaleej that saw the side from the United Arab Emirates exit Group A of the 2015 tournament.

Abdulrahman Altawail scored a hat-trick, Dario and Mohammad Taheri scored twice each while Hamad Hayat and Abdulrahman Al Wadi were also on target as Qadsia recorded a win that also ensured hosts Tasisat Daryaei advance to the last eight.

Yousif Mohamed scored in the eighth minute for Al Khaleej to cancel out Alwadi's opener, but it turned out to be little more than a consolation for the Emiratis, who lost their opening game 8-1 against Tasisat.

Altawail gave Qadsia the perfect start in the sixth minute when his low shot beat goalkeeper Talal Khaled but only two minutes later the scores were level when Mohamed slid in at the far post to redirect Rashid Obaid's cross over the line.

The game remained competitive until the end of the first half, by which time Qadsia had opened up a two-goal cushion with Dario shooting over the goalkeeper in the 14th minute before Hayat netted on the stroke of the interval.

Dario scored his second from close range two minutes after the restart and, three minutes later, Taheri struck on the turn from just outside the area. Altawail scored his team's sixth in the 27th minute with a finish at the far post and Taheri thumped home a right-footed effort to further extend his team's lead. Al Wadi added the eighth in the final five minutes and three minutes later Altawail completed his hat-trick from close range.



# MATCH DAY 3

## Group D: Shenzhen Nanling Tielang 3-5 Bank of Beirut

Last year's semi-finalists Shenzhen Nanling Tielang crashed out of the 2015 AFC Futsal Club Championship after slipping to a 5-3 defeat at the hands of Bank of Beirut at Nagshe Jahan Stadium.

Rudolpho Da Costa scored twice and Mohamad Kobeissy also netted to give Bank of Beirut a 3-1 lead at half-time, with Lu Yue finding the back of the net for Shenzhen in the Group D meeting the Chinese side had to win to remain in the competition.

Goals from Eder and Ahmad Esmaeilpour saw Shenzhen fight back early in the second period but despite increased pressure they were unable to find the goal needed to advance and late efforts from Mehdi Javid and goalkeeper Hussain Hamadani sealed their fate.

Bank of Beirut took the lead after 10 minutes when Brazilian Da Costa scored on the turn and, just a minute later, he added to the advantage when he tapped in from close range following Javid's rapid break.

Lu Yue pulled one back for Shenzhen in the 13th minute when he slid in to meet Esmaeilpour's ball across the court, but within seconds the Lebanese side were two goals ahead once again when Kobeissy flicked the ball past goalkeeper Wei Zheng.

Shenzhen needed to win to progress and threw everything forward in the second half to reduce the deficit. Eder scored from inside the area two minutes after the restart while a minute later Esmaeilpour equalised with a right-foot finish.

But for all their pressure – which saw Eder and Lu hit the frame of the goal – Shenzhen could not find the winner they needed and, with the Chinese side pushing forward on a power play, Javid intercepted the ball and ran into the empty net before Hamadani sealed the result with a goal from inside his own area.

## Group C: Chonburi Bluewave 1-2 Al Rayyan SC

Thailand's Chonburi Bluewave were handed a 2-1 defeat by Al Rayyan from Qatar in their final Group C game of the 2015 AFC Futsal Club Championship as the former champions exited the tournament.

The result left all three teams level on three points after two games but Iraq's NAFT Al Wasat won Group C having scored more goals than either Al Rayyan or Chonburi, while the Qataris took second place due to their victory over the 2013 champions.

Al Rayyan needed to win to have any hope of advancing to the last eight and took the lead through Diego Costa before Kritsada Wongkeo struck with a free kick that pulled the 2013 tournament winners level.

But a goal five minutes from time by Flavio secured the points for Al Rayyan and ensured both the Qataris and NAFT Al Wasat from Iraq advanced at the expense of the Thais, who finished as runners-up last year.

The first half finished goalless with Al Rayyan grateful to Iranian goalkeeper Sepehr Mohammadi for a superb performance between the posts that thwarted the Thais, keeping out efforts from Keattiyot Chalaemkhet and Jirwat Sornwichian.

Seven minutes into the second half, the Qataris built on their defensive solidity to take the lead as Diego Costa was played in on goal by skipper Saad Al Shahwani and the Brazilian made no mistake with his finish.

Less than a minute later though Chonburi were level as Kristada struck with a vicious free kick that Mohammadi could do little to stop.

But, with just five minutes remaining and Chonburi looking increasingly capable of picking up the draw they needed, Al Rayyan went back in front when Flavio hit an unstoppable shot from 15 metres out.

## Group B: Nagoya Oceans 2-2 MFC Emgek

Ruslan Gafurov's last-gasp goal earned MFC Emgek a surprise 2-2 draw with defending champions Nagoya Oceans and a place in the quarter-finals of the 2015 AFC Futsal Club Championship as winners of Group B.

The Japanese side looked to have secured the points thanks to Kaoru Morioka's penalty four minutes from time but Gafurov's emphatic effort on the stroke of full-time ensured the club from Kyrgyzstan topped the group ahead of Nagoya by virtue of a better goal difference.

Nagoya had been forced to come from behind after Rustam Ermekov had given MFC Emgek the lead only for Serginho to level for the Japanese club. MFC Emgek coach Kanimet Aralbaev was sent from the bench after a sixth foul was awarded against his team, giving Morioka the opportunity to put Nagoya in front for the first time in the game.

But Gafurov's successful penalty – also awarded for a sixth team foul with just five seconds remaining – led to wild celebrations on the Kyrgyz club's bench. MFC Emgek took a surprise lead in the 10th minute when Ermekov steered the ball between the legs of goalkeeper Ryuma Shinoda and the Kyrgyz club refused to be overawed by the reigning champions.

Serginho levelled the scores in the 14th minute with a low drive from distance but as time ticked by the game looked destined to end in a draw thanks to an inspired performance from goalkeeper Kirill Ermolov and a determined effort by the Emgek defence.

However, a sixth team foul for MFC Emgek saw Nagoya awarded an attempt at goal from the second penalty mark and Morioka thumped the ball low,

only for his effort to be cancelled out with seconds remaining when Gafurov struck emphatically from the spot at the other end.

## Group A: Tasisat Daryaei 9-2 Qadsia

Hosts Tasisat Daryaei will take on defending champions Nagoya Oceans in the quarter-finals of the 2015 AFC Futsal Club Championship as Vahid Shamsaee led the hosts to an emphatic 9-2 victory over Kuwait's Qadsia SC on Sunday.

Shamsaee scored four times to ensure Tasisat took top spot in Group A to set up the meeting with the Japanese side, who finished in second place in Group B after they were surprisingly held to a draw by tournament newcomers MFC Emgek earlier in the day.

All four of Shamsaee's goals came in the second half following a tight opening period that ended with the Iranians leading by a solitary goal.

Reza Sangsefidi put Tasisat in front after just four minutes with a right-foot finish after good work down the left by Ashgar Hassanzadeh, but Adulrahman Al Wadi levelled the scores three minutes later when he finished off a flowing Qadsia move.

However, Mohammad Zarei restored the home side's advantage two minutes later when he smashed in a right-footed effort, and from there Tasisat never looked back.

Shamsaee claimed his first of the evening in the 24th minute when he held off the defence before turning to fire past second-choice goalkeeper Khaled Abdullah as the 39-year-old kicked off a seven-minute scoring spree.

His second followed just two minutes later when his effort from long range slipped under Abdullah and by the 28th minute he had completed his hat-trick when he scored from the left side.

There was more to come from the veteran superstar when, in the 31st minute he manoeuvred himself into the middle before thumping another right-footed effort beyond the hapless Abdullah.

Tasisat continued their relentless second-half run with Iran national team captain Hassanzadeh netting in the 32nd and 33rd minutes before Rafael scored a consolation for Qadsia, only for Ali Ebrahimi to restore the seven-goal cushion seconds later.



# QUARTER FINALS

## Thai Son Nam FC 2-1 Al Rayyan SC

Vietnam's Thai Son Nam booked their place in Wednesday's semi-finals of the AFC Futsal Club Championship with a 2-1 win over Al Rayyan from Qatar at Nagshe Jahan Stadium.

Bruno Garcia's side became the first team from their country to reach the last four of the competition thanks to goals from Saul Olmo Campana and Tran Long Vu in the opening four minutes of the game.

An own goal by Thai Son Nam goalkeeper Ngo Dinh Thuan brought Al Rayyan back into the game, but Enrique Martinez's team were unable to break through the Vietnamese side's defence for a second time.

Thai Son Nam will now face either MFC Emgek of Kyrgyzstan or Qadsia SC from Kuwait for a place in the final with none of the three teams having ever reached the last four of the continental club championship.

Thai Son Nam signalled their intent right from the start, with Phung Trong Luan hitting the post after just 20 seconds as the Vietnamese piled forward. Within the first minute, they had taken the lead when Campana's shot from outside the area beat goalkeeper Sepehr Mohammadi to his right.

Still the Vietnamese side pushed forward, with Campana shooting across goal in the third minute and in the fourth minute they doubled their lead when

Pham Duc Hoa saw his shot saved by Mohammadi, only for Long Vu to score on the rebound.

Five minutes later, Thai Son Nam should have made it 3-0 when a one-two between Ngo Ngoc Son and Artur Yusunov set up Ngoc Son for an easy finish into an empty net but somehow he managed to send the ball high over the bar.

Al Rayyan finally gained a foothold in the game in the 12th minute when Ngo Dinh Thuan bundled the ball over his own goal line as the Qataris put the Vietnamese defence under pressure, but Thai Son Nam went up to the other end, only for Duc Hoa to hit the post.

Four minutes after the restart Diego Nunes put himself in position to level the scores for Al Rayyan, but the Brazilian pulled his shot harmlessly across the face of goal.

The Qataris were then forced to defend in numbers as Thai Son Nam sought to extend their advantage and in the end the Vietnamese side did enough to ensure their progress to the next round.

## NAFT Al Wasat 4-4 Bank of Beirut (3-2 pens)

Mohammad Naser Safari was the hero as NAFT Al Wasat advanced to the semi-finals of the AFC Futsal Club Championship, defeating Bank of Beirut 3-2 in a penalty shootout after extra-time failed to separate the two teams following a 4-4 draw.



NAFT will face either defending champions Nagoya Oceans or tournament hosts Tasisat Daryaei in the semi-finals as they seek to become the first club from Iraq to win the continental club title.

The 24-year-old Iran international scored the winning penalty and had earlier claimed a hat-trick as NAFT fought back from a 3-1 deficit at half-time to take the lead after Rudolpho Da Costa, Ahmad Kheir El Dine and Karim Abou Zeid had put Bank of Beirut in front. But Abou Zeid scored his second of the game four minutes from time to take the game into an extra-time period that finished without a winner, sending the clash into the penalty shootout from which NAFT eventually prevailed.

Da Costa put the Lebanese side in front after just five minutes, the Brazilian scoring with a left foot shot that beat goalkeeper from outside the area after the ball had been worked wide.

Mustafa Bachay twice went close to levelling for NAFT in the eighth minute before the Iraqi club equalised in the 14th minute when Safari slotted home from outside the area with a right foot shot.

Bank of Beirut rallied, though, and would go into the halftime break with a two-goal lead after an impressive conclusion to the opening period.

Kheir El Dine's shot beat goalkeeper Omar Sabti to his right in the 15th minute and, two minutes later, Abou Zeid curled his right-footed free kick into the top corner, giving Sabti no chance.

Despite trailing by two goals, NAFT came out in determined mood at the start of the second half and within a minute of the restart Amjad Kareem and Naser had both narrowly failed to reduce the deficit. In the 25th minute, however, they claimed the goal their dominance of the half deserved.

NAFT's Iranian duo Behzad Fereidoon and Safari linked up for the Iraqi club's second when Fereidoon sent his corner from the left into space for Nasser to fire a perfectly-executed right foot volley into the bottom corner of the Bank of Beirut goal.

Three minutes later the scores were level when Waleed Khalid tapped the ball over the line from close range as NAFT completed their comeback.

And with eight minutes to go they finally took the lead when Safari thumped the ball home from wide on the left as NAFT hit on the break again, only for Abou Zeid's second of the game in the 36th minute from long range to tie the scores up once again.

That took the game into extra-time, in which Da Costa saw his effort late in the first period headed off the line by Bachay while Mehdi Javid hit the post early in the second period.

Both teams converted their opening two penalties but when Sabti saved Hassan Hammoud's spot kick, he set up Safari to deliver the win for NAFT.

## MFC Emgek 1-4 Qadsia

Qadsia will face Vietnam's Thai Son Nam in the semi-finals of the 2015 AFC Futsal Club Championship after the Kuwaiti side handed Kyrgyzstan's MFC Emgek a 4-1 defeat in their quarter-final meeting at Nagshe Jahan Stadium.

Rafael scored twice and there were solitary goals for Mohammad Taheri and Abdulrahman Altawail before Rustam Ermekov scored a late consolation for MFC Emgek as Fabio Cortez's team moved into the last four for the first time in the club's history, and their progress ensures there will be at least one debutant in the final of this year's competition.

MFC Emgek qualified for the quarter-finals on their first appearance at the tournament, notching up a surprise 2-2 draw with defending champions Nagoya Oceans that saw them finish top of Group B but Qadsia made sure not to underestimate the club from Bishkek as they sought to bounce back from a demoralising 9-2 hammering at the hands of tournament hosts Tasisat Daryaei.

Within 13 minutes, memories of that defeat were being banished when Rafael put the Kuwaiti side in front and three minutes later Qadsia had doubled their lead when Taheri scored with a beautifully taken right foot effort that found the top corner of Kirill Ermolov's goal.

Seven minutes after the restart, Qadsia were further in front when Altawail rolled the ball over the line from close range.

The Kuwaitis went close to adding to the scoreline when Rafael hit the frame of the goal twice in the space of a minute but, as MFC Emgek grew increasingly desperate to score, there were plenty of opportunities for Cortez's team to capitalise.

With MFC Emgek fielding an additional outfield player on a power play, Rafael finally added a fourth to his team's tally in the 37th minute when he intercepted the ball before rolling it home from inside his own half. The Kyrgyz side continued to push for a consolation goal as their participation in the tournament drew to a close, and with seconds remaining Rustam Ermekov finally struck but it was too little too late as Qadsia booked their place in the last four.

## Tasisat Daryaei 4-3 Nagoya Oceans

Vahid Shamsaee was at his majestic best once again as Tasisat Daryaei defeated Nagoya Oceans 4-3 in the quarter-finals of the 2015 AFC Futsal Club Championship, knocking out the defending champions to set up a semi-final meeting with NAFT Al Wasat from Iraq.

Shamsaee scored twice and set up a third for Reza Sangsefidi while Mohammad Zareei also found the back of the net as the hosts progressed to the semi-finals after a pulsating clash with the two-time winners.

Rafael Sakai had given Nagoya the lead and Kaoru Morioka was also on target for Victor Acosta's team, but it was not enough to deny a home side backed by a boisterous crowd inside the Nagshe Jahan Stadium. Morioka added his team's third seconds before the final whistle.

Shamsaee fired off the first shot of the game after just 22 seconds, with the Iranian trying his luck from long range only for Nagoya goalkeeper Ruma Shinoda to comfortably collect.

By the second minute, though, the defending champions had taken the lead. The ball was played forward to Sakai and the Japan international fired off a powerful shot that beat Mostafa Nazari to his right. Sakai was denied the opportunity to add to his team's tally a minute later when Nazari proved equal to his

effort while Tomoki Yoshikawa pulled his attempt across the face of goal in the fifth minute.

Nagoya were looking the more threatening in the opening exchanges but, in the seventh minute, Shamsaee levelled for Tasisat, the veteran bursting through the middle to pick up the ball before stroking his right-foot effort into the bottom corner.

Reza Sangsefidi then sent his attempt just wide after being set up by Shamsaee while goalkeeper Shinoda did well to deny Asghar Hassanzadeh.

Sakai's deflected shot, meanwhile, almost found the back of the net in the 13th minute, only for the ball to loop up and just over the bar.

Tasisat took the lead for the first time just a minute after the restart when Shamsaee's quickly taken corner was slotted home from the tightest of angles and over the line via the post, but in the 34th minute the Japanese pulled level when Morioka capitalised on a mistake by Nazari to score from wide on the right.

The game looked set to go to extra-time but, with two minutes remaining, Shamsaee showed his class when he held off the defence before turning to fire a shot from outside the area low to Shinoda's left. With barely a minute remaining Zarei scored what turned out to be the winner with the Japanese on a power play, meaning Morioka's late strike was not enough to deny the Iranians.





## SEMI FINALS

### Thai Son Nam FC 3-3 Qadsia (1-2 pens)

Qadsia became the first club from Kuwait to reach the final of the AFC Futsal Club Championship when goalkeeper Sayyedhassan Ebraheem saved two penalties to earn his side a 2-1 shoot-out win over Thai Son Nam after their semi-final at Nagshe Jahan Stadium ended in a 3-3 draw.

Qadsia will face either tournament hosts Tasisat Daryaei or Iraq's NAFT Al Wasat in Friday's final as they aim to become the first Kuwaiti club to win the tournament since its inception in 2010.

Ebraheem saved penalties from Artur Yunusov and Tran Van Vu to deny the Vietnamese club, who took an early lead before being forced to come back late in the game to take proceedings into extra-time.

Abdulrahman Alwadi netted twice and Iranian international Mohammad Taheri was also on the score sheet as Qadsia bounced back from going behind to Van Vu's early goal, but strikes from Phung Trong Luan and Yunusov in the second half ensured the game went into extra-time.

Thai Son Nam took the lead with little more than a minute on the clock when Van Vu blasted his free kick through the defensive wall with such power that Ebraheem was unable to hold on, fumbling the ball over the line.

Three minutes later, though, Qadsia were back on level terms. Alwadi skipped past the challenge of Pham Duc Hoa before hammering his right-foot shot into the top corner.

Barely another minute had passed when Qadsia took the lead. It was Alwadi who was on target again, this time scoring with a spectacular flying volley that ranks amongst the best goals of the tournament so far.

With four minutes remaining in the half, Qadsia extended their advantage further when Iran's Taheri took aim from just outside the area, comfortably beating Ngo Dinh Thuan in the Thai Son Nam goal.

Qadsia were worthy leaders at the break, but barely a minute had passed in the second half when Thai Son Nam had reduced the deficit to a solitary goal as Trong Luan's shot went past Ebraheem.

And with four minutes remaining in the game, Van Vu charged down the left flank before cutting the ball across goal for Yunusov to tap over the line and send the game into extra-time.

Ten minutes of added time could not separate the teams, however, and the outcome was decided from the penalty spot, with Ebraheem mobbed by his team mates after his heroics took Qadsia into the final.

## NAFT AI Wasat 3-7 Tasisat Daryaei

Tournament hosts Tasisat Daryaei booked their place in the final of the 2015 AFC Futsal Club Championship with a 7-3 win over Iraq's NAFT AI Wasat at the Nagshe Jahan Stadium.

Majid Raeisi scored a hat-trick while Ghodrat Bahadori, Mohamad Keshavarz, Reza Sangsefidi and Vahid Shamsaee (pictured) also netted for the Iranian side, who will meet Qadsia from Kuwait in the final.

Tasisat, however, will go into the final without the services of goalkeeper Mostafa Nazari who was sent off by Australian referee Chris Colley in the 14th minute for handling the ball outside his area.

But the hosts will be confident of success against a Qadsia side they defeated 9-2 during the group stages of a competition in which they have now scored 28 times.

Bahadori gave Tasisat the perfect start when he found the back of the net after just two minutes, although Mohammad Naser Safari levelled the scores just two minutes later when he struck on the break.

Tasisat put themselves back in front in the 12th minute when Vahid Shamsaee's corner was directed

over the goal line as Raeisi claimed his first and, two minutes later, the 34-year-old had his second of the night when he linked up with Shamsaee once again to score from close range.

Seconds later, though, goalkeeper Nazari saw red for claiming the ball with his hands outside the area and a minute later NAFT made their advantage count when Rafid Hameed poked the ball home.

By the 17th minute Tasisat restored the two-goal cushion when Keshavarz swept his classy left-foot strike into the top corner, allowing the Iranians to breath easy going into the half-time break.

The result was effectively put beyond doubt less than a minute into the second half as Sangsefidi charged down the left before smashing his left-foot shot home for his side's fifth of the game.

Raeisi then completed his hat-trick with nine minutes to go when he scored from long range and, although Ali Abdulelah scored in the 36th minute for NAFT on a power play, Tasisat maintained control to stay on course to become the first Iranian winner of the title since 2012 with Shamsaee scoring in the dying seconds to put the icing on the cake.





## THIRD PLACE PLAY-OFF

### Thai Son Nam 7-3 NAFT Al Wasat

Thai Son Nam secured third place at the 2015 AFC Futsal Club Championship as Bruno Garcia's side handed Iraq's NAFT Al Wasat a 7-3 defeat at the Naghse Jahan Stadium.

Nguyen Minh Tri and Tran Van Vu both scored twice for the South East Asian club with Tran Long Vu and Le Quoc Nam also registering while NAFT's Mohammad Naser Safari found the back of the net at both ends. Waleed Khaled and Ali Abdulelah also scored for NAFT.

The third-place finish is the best result recorded by Thai Son Nam in their third participation in the tournament after a group stage exit in 2013 and a quarter-final slot last year.

Thai Son Nam took the lead with barely five seconds on the clock when Long Vu stole the ball from the Iraqi side straight from the kick-off before slipping the ball under goalkeeper Mohammed Noor to score.

Safari, however, levelled for NAFT in the seventh minute when he stormed clear before scoring from the edge of the area but, five minutes later, the Vietnamese were back in front with Minh Tri scoring when he was fed by Artur Yunusov.

An own goal by Safari – the ball crossing the line after it hit the Iranian on the side of the head – doubled Thai Son Nam's lead and Duong Anh Tung could

have added a fourth two minutes before the break, only for his shot to clip the right post.

The Vietnamese did manage to go further ahead three minutes into the second half when Minh Tri claimed his second of the game with a shot from the left, but NAFT responded instantly when Khaled slammed the ball into the top corner.

NAFT then reduced the deficit to a single goal in the 26th minute when Thai Son Nam goalkeeper Ngo Dinh Thuan was not able to hold Rafid Hameed's shot from outside the area and Abdulelah made the most of his team's power play to push the ball over the line from close range.

Van Vu restored Thai Son Nam's two-goal lead a minute before Berzad Fereidoon's sending off in the 30th minute for a second bookable offence gave Thai Son Nam the perfect opportunity to forge further ahead and, a little over halfway through the two-minute penalty period, Quoc Nam converted after Nguyen Bao Quan's initial shot was blocked.

NAFT increasingly used the power play with Abdulelah on the field as time ticked down, but even with the additional outfield player the Iraqi club could not find a way past the resolute Vietnamese and Van Vu added a seventh with barely seconds remaining.



## Tasisat Daryaei 4-3 Qadsia

Tasisat Daryaei became the first Iranian club since 2012 to win the AFC Futsal Club Championship, handing Qadsia a 5-4 defeat to claim the continental title at the Nagshe Jahan Stadium on Friday.

Asghar Hassanzadeh scored twice and there were single strikes from Ghodrat Bahadori, Reza Sangsefidi and Vahid Shamsaee as the Tehran side claimed the title.

Hamad Hayat and Abdulrahman Alwadi, also with a brace, were on target for the Kuwaiti club while Abdulrahman Altawail's late goal made for a nervous finish for the home team.

Tasisat had controlled proceedings for much of the game but were forced to survive the loss of Sangsefidi, who was sent off for a second bookable offence in the 30th minute.

Tasisat had cruised to victory when the teams met in the group stages, the Iranians securing a 9-2 win, but with an additional week of match conditioning under their belt, Qadsia were a stronger proposition in the final.

Despite Qadsia's improvement, however, it was Tasisat who took the lead after just two minutes when the ball was worked out to the left to Hassanzadeh and he smashed his effort into the corner.

But it wasn't long before Qadsia were testing second string Tasisat goalkeeper Mehdi Mostafaei, who took

over between the posts from the suspended Mostafa Nazari. Alwadi set his sights on goal from just inside the Tasisat half in the fifth minute, but Mostafaei pushed the ball away for a corner.

There was a similar outcome at the other end a minute later when Mohammad Zarei tried his luck, but a further minute later the Iranians doubled their lead, Shamsaee clipping his pass through to Bahadori, whose left foot shot from distance speared into the top corner.

Qadsia refused to be overawed and continued to push forward, with Alwadi hitting the post in the 11th minute as Fabio Cortez's team fought for a foothold in the game.

With their two-goal cushion, though, Tasisat were content to play out the half as best they could, using the power play to control possession and run down the clock, depriving the Kuwaitis of the opportunity to put themselves on the scoreboard.

Two minutes after the restart, Sangsefidi scored Tasisat's third when he sprinted onto Hassanzadeh's pass through the legs of the defender but less than a minute later the Kuwaitis struck when Hayat netted from close range.

Sangsefidi then picked up his first booking for simulation and, within seconds was given his marching orders by referee Tomohiro Kozaki from Japan for disputing the initial call too vociferously.



A man up for two minutes, Qadsia had the opportunity to pull themselves back into the game and, just before the end of their advantage, Rafael thought he had scored only for Mostafaei to somehow keep the close-range effort from crossing the line.

Qadsia grew increasingly desperate and, while on a power play, conceded a fourth when Shamsaee intercepted the ball in his own half before turning

quickly to slot the ball into the unguarded net from distance, but Alwadi's powerful strike from the right a minute later kept the Kuwaitis in with a chance.

Hassanzadeh's second of the game, two minutes from time, was a carbon copy of Shamsaee's goal, only for Alwadi's second to cancel that out almost immediately and Altawail's goal inside the final minute provided a thrilling finish.



# TOURNAMENT ANALYSIS • Medical Report

The following is a medical report for the AFC Futsal Club Championship IR Iran 2015 held in Isfahan, Iran from July 31 until August 7, 2015.

Surveys of injuries and illnesses using the standard F-MARC injury reporting form were distributed to the medical representative of each team during the Team Doctors/Team Physiotherapist Coordination Meeting on July 30, 2015 (Group A, B, C & D).

The AFC appointed two (2) Medical Officers who supervised the medical services and carried-out doping control testing namely:

1. Dr. Arya Roy (India); and
2. Dr. Sarban Singh Sandhu (Malaysia)

Information was also obtained by the team’s medical staff. Most teams had one medical doctor and/or one therapist as well as other staff such as masseurs and athletic trainers.

Gharazi General Hospital had been designated for matchdays and Amin and Alzhra Hospital as a stand-by medical centre during non-matchdays. These hospitals provided excellent services in terms of diagnosis, investigation and treatment of injured players.

The medical support of the LOC provided good coverage, assistance and services under the guidance of Dr. Pooya Daneshver. There were no major injuries during the tournament.

## Injuries/illness during the tournament

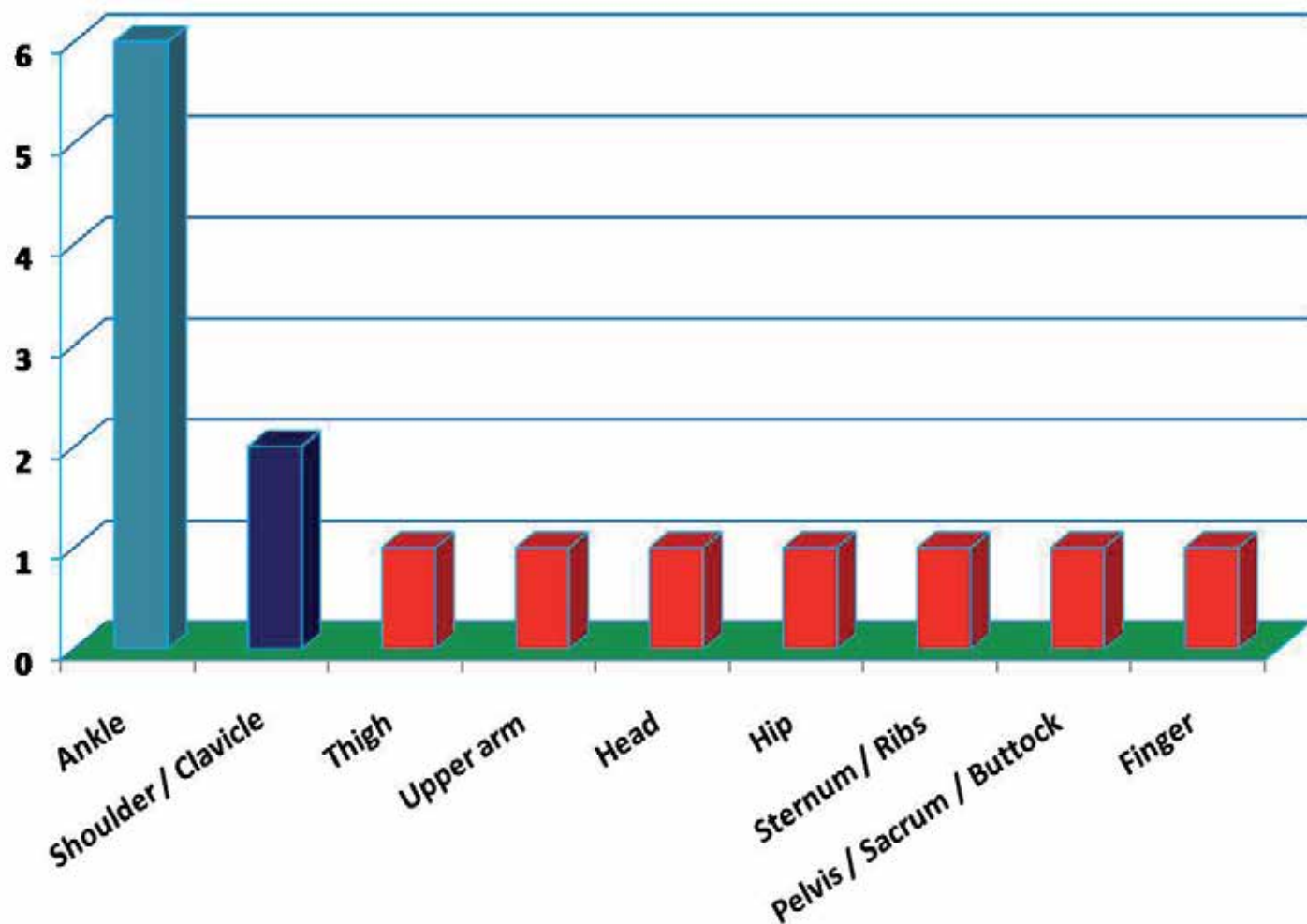
The AFC Medical Officer appointed for this tournament gathered information through the following:

1. Injury reporting forms submitted by the Team Medical Officer/Physiotherapist;
2. Observation and involvement with the injured player (if required); and
3. Discussions and interviews with the team medical representative.

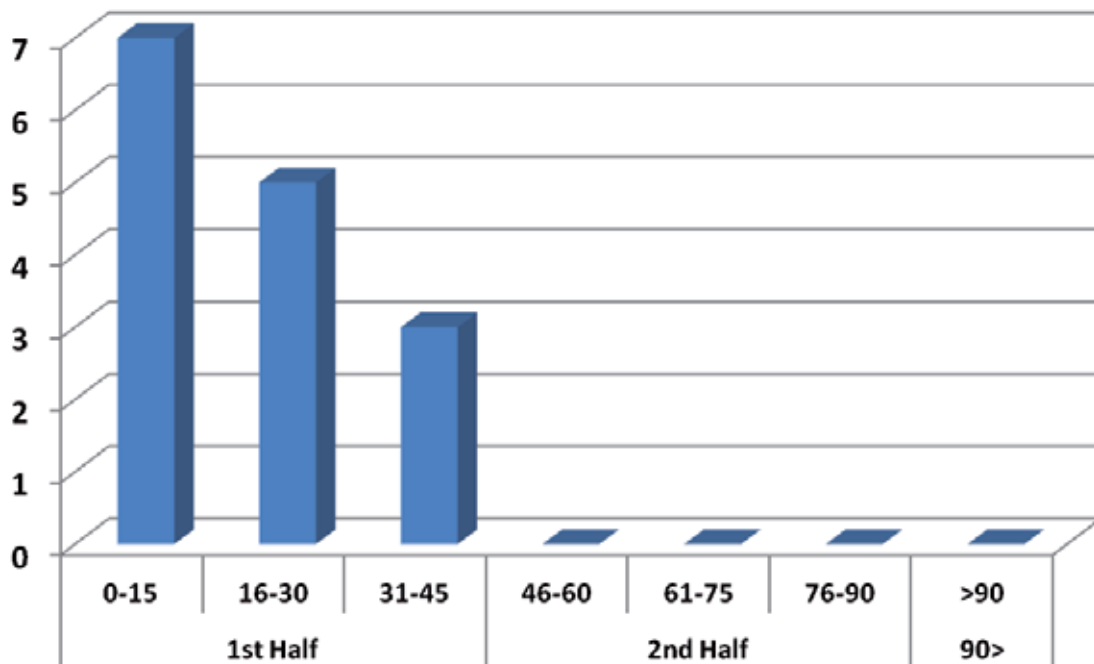
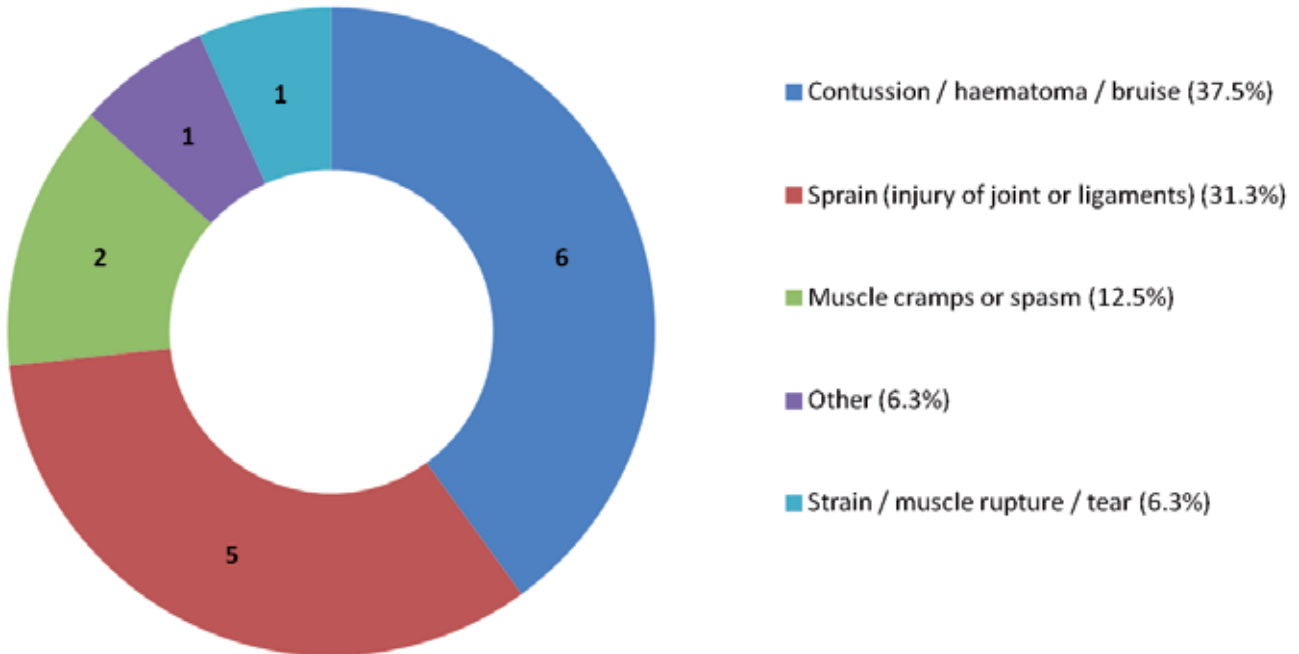
A total of 16 injuries were reported during the match with a ratio of 0.8 (16/20). Only three (3) injuries were reported during training days. The team's Medical Doctor/Physiotherapist assessed a total of seven weeks of enforced absence for players due to sustained injuries such as ankle sprains and muscle tears.

The following is a list of the injuries that were sustained:

From the sixteen (16) injuries reported the most frequent diagnosis was contusion, sprain (injury of joint/ligaments) and muscle cramps/spasm. The data also showed that higher number of injuries occurred at the first half of matches.



The team doctors/team physiotherapist reported ten (10) illnesses - minor cases such as coughing, flu and fever - which were all treated through oral medication and rest.

At the Abbasi Hotel, where the AFC headquarters were situated, a number of conditions were examined and treated by the medical officer. All cases were satisfactorily resolved (headaches, sore throat, coughing and flu).

## Doping Controls

At each game, doping controls were carried out on players selected at random from each team. A total of 36 tests were carried out. The results showed that all thirty-six (36) were reported negative for doping.

The samples have been analyzed at the WADA accredited laboratory in the New Delhi National Dope Testing Laboratory in India. The co-operation from the players selected for testing and their accompanying medical representatives was excellent.

The Competition, Events and Hospitality Department, as well as the Medical Department provided invaluable support, especially in the following areas:

- Communication to the Teams regarding the medical related activities;
- Organisation of logistical arrangements of the medical meetings with the local medical committee and the 12 team doctors prior to the competition;
- LOC organisation of the transport of samples to the testing laboratory; and
- Follow-up on test results and general correspondence.

From a medical point of view, the AFC Futsal Club Championship IR Iran 2015 was successfully organized. There were no major injuries or medical incidents during the tournament. Participating players, staff and members of the AFC delegation had quick access to medical services and care. All conditions were satisfactorily resolved.

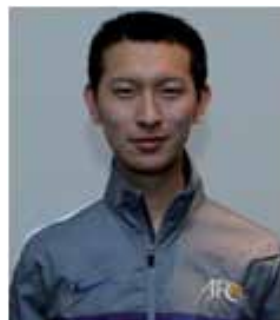

## INTRODUCTION

Some 14 AFC Match officials and two standby referees were appointed for the sixth AFC Futsal Club Championship. All the appointed referees were given the opportunity to be assessed, guided and supported during the tournament and they performed very well. A Referees Fitness Instructor was also appointed for the Championship.

## ARRIVAL & COORDINATION MEETING

All the Futsal Referees, Referees Instructors and Referees Fitness Instructor reported on July 28, 2015.

## PREPARATORY COURSE

The aim of the Preparatory Course was to ensure that the referees were ready, both physically and mentally for the competition. Three main elements conducted during the course were:

1. Fitness Test
2. Theoretical Session
3. Practical Session

## Fitness Test

The fitness test for Referees was conducted on July 29, 2015 at Enghelab Eslami Sport from 1900 to 2000 hrs. The Referee Fitness Instructor conducted the test with support from the Futsal Referees Instructors and the LOC. All appointed Futsal Referees passed the required time for the fitness test. One of the standby referees failed the test. The medical team and ambulance were present to assist



## Theoretical Session

Presentations by the Instructors added a lot to referees' knowledge. Two sessions were conducted on July 29 and 30, 2015. Referees were urged to be committed, courageous and be consistent when they perform on the pitch.

The key points covered and delivered were as follows:

1. Consistency/uniformity on foul recognition/degree of foul
2. Protecting the players
3. Letting the game flow
4. Substitution bench control
5. Other related topics

## Practical Session

Two practical sessions were held at the tournament's main venue. Futsal Referee Instructors conducted the simulation training on the positioning, movement, signalling etc... LOC also provided 14 players to support the referees' practical training.



## APPOINTMENT OF REFEREES



The appointment of referees was announced one day before the match (after the debriefing session) and then distributed to the referees. The lists of appointments were given to the Head of Delegation, Head of Administration and Match Commissioners. Subsequent appointments were distributed to the relevant officials after discussion with the Instructors

for each matchday. Appointments were based on the neutrality, referees' performance etc...

After the quarter-finals, six referees were released from the competition: Referees from China, Iraq (2) and Iran, Malaysia, (1)





## PHYSICAL TRAINING

A total of 20 matches were played, four matches were played every day for three consecutive days (group stage). The primary physical training emphasis during the tournament was “recovery” – in order to prepare for the consecutive matches (to reduce fatigue from the previous match, and to reset the body for the next match). Physical training and technical sessions were conducted at Hasht Behesht Garden, Esfahan (Located near to Abbasi Hotel). The sessions were conducted by the appointed AFC Fitness Instructor.

## DAILY BRIEFING AND DE-BRIEFING

Briefing and de- briefing sessions were held in the Abbasi Hotel, from 0900 – 1000. The debriefing sessions recapped the referees’ performances and corrected or explained the referees’ decisions during the previous day’s matches. The appointed Referees Assessor conducted the sessions and were aided by match DVDs with which they could highlight the appropriate incidents. Team tactics from the games were also discussed.

## HOSPITALITY BY LOC

On the refereeing side, LOC did exceptionally well. The LOC provided good assistance and support to the referees and the instructors. The transport during training and on matchdays, was very well coordinated. The referees were given free internet access in the hotel however, due to policies, the hotel did not offer a jacuzzi, sauna, steam bath, gym or swimming pool.

## OVERALL PERFORMANCE OF REFEREES

All the matches were generally played in the spirit of fair play and the players respected the decisions of the referees. There were no major errors committed by the match officials which affected the result of the match. The teamwork, cooperation and communication among the referees was encouraging. The overall performance of the referees was very good.

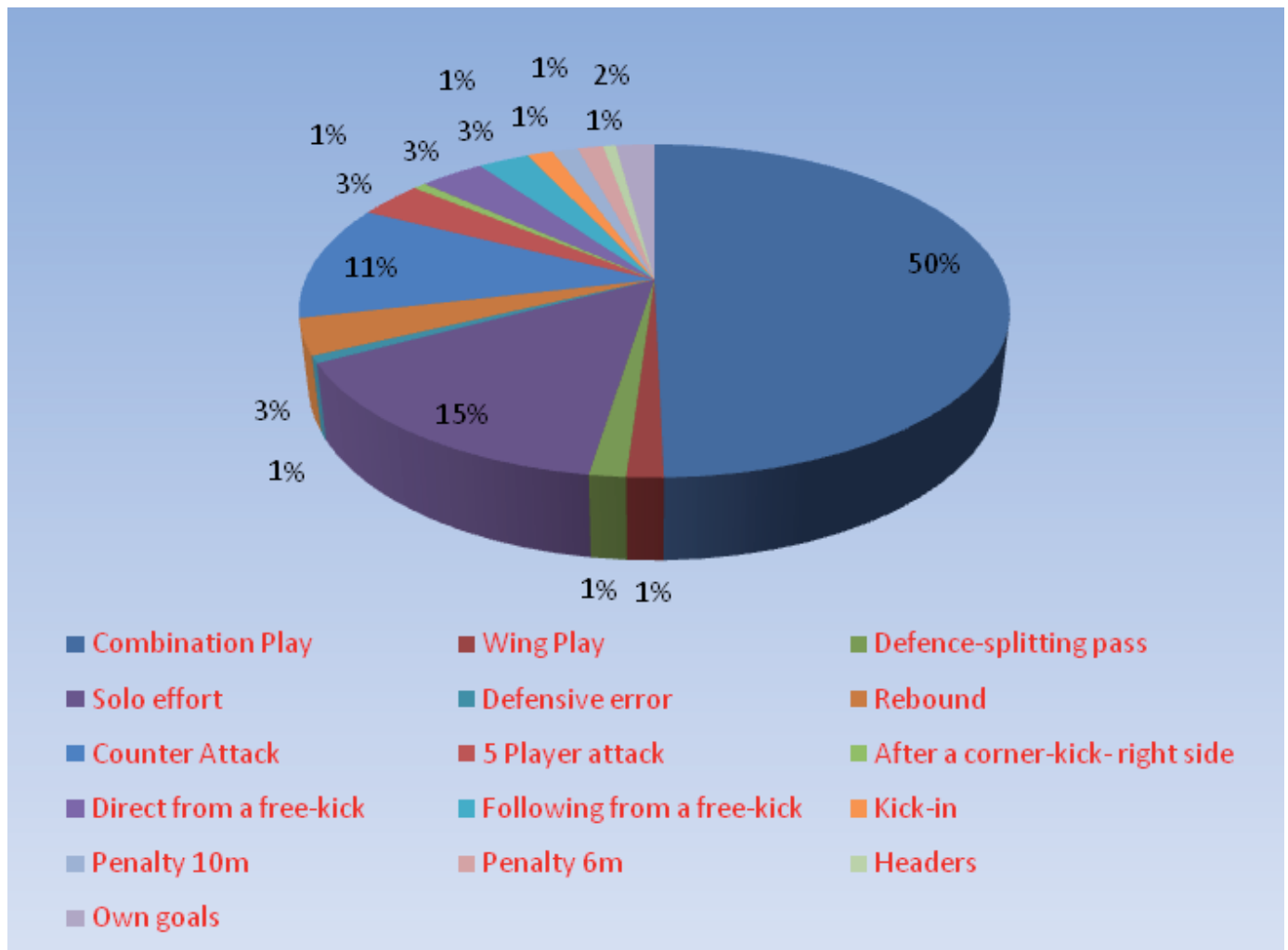

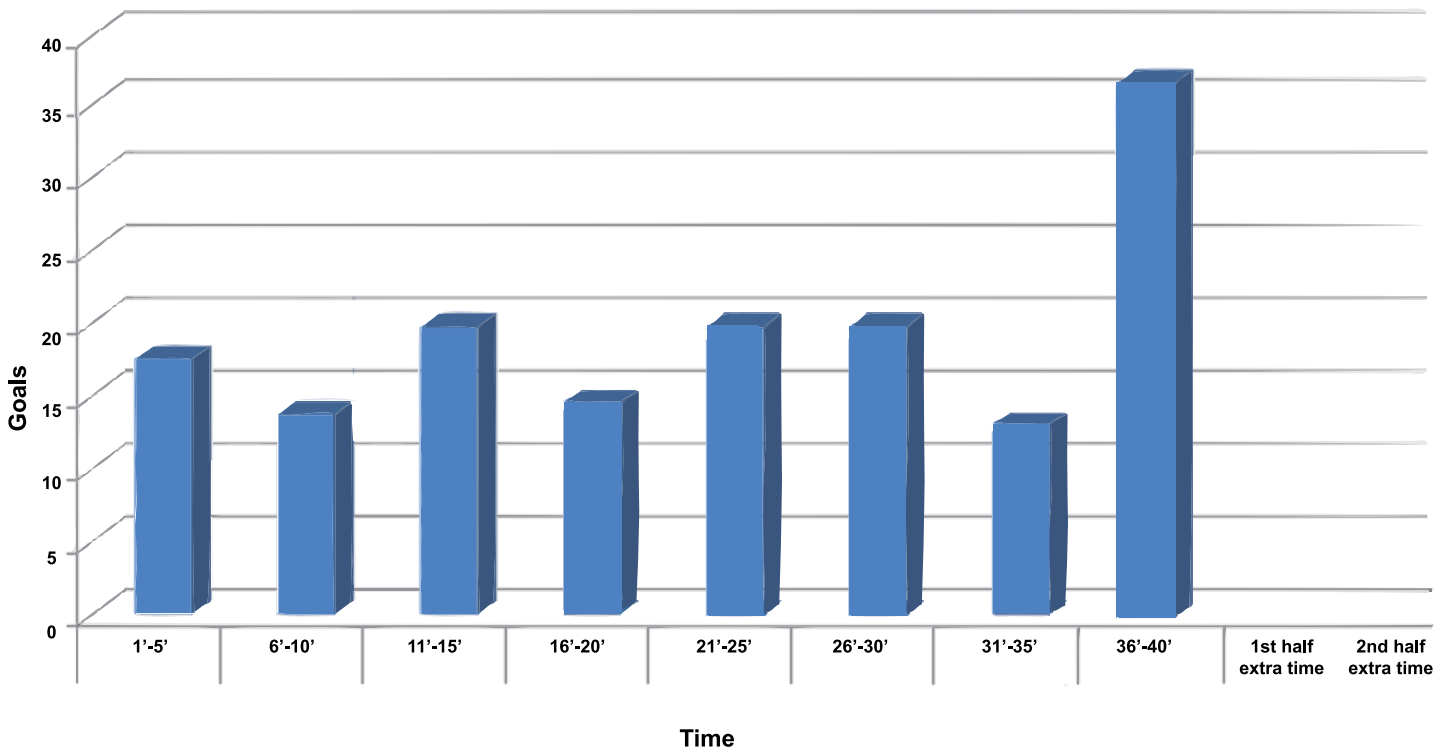

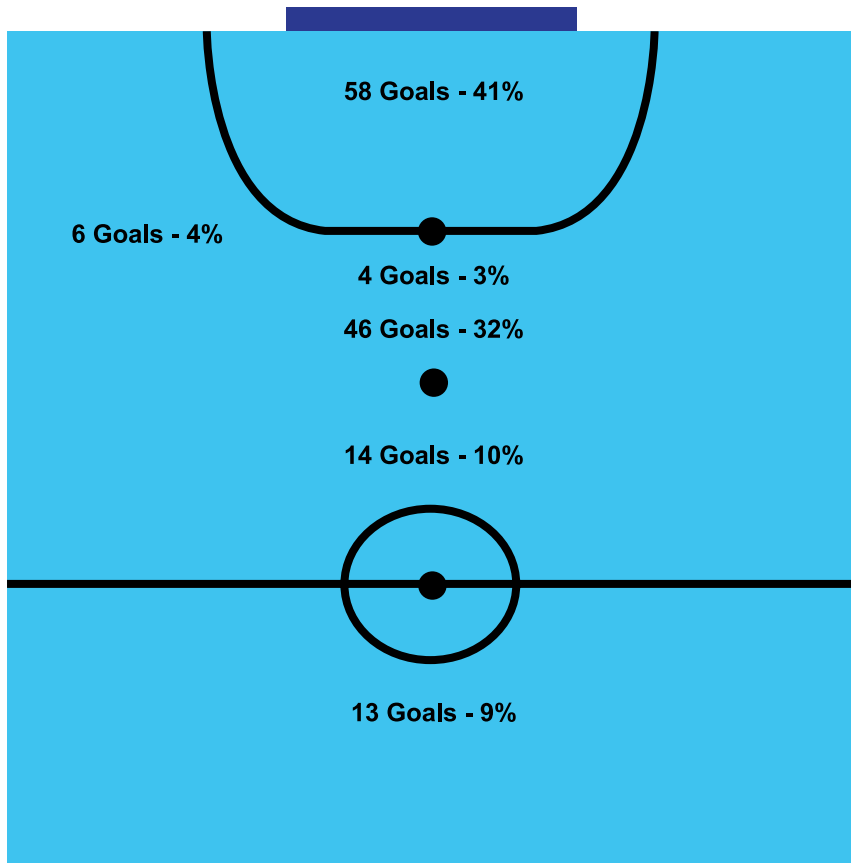

Teams are assessed in five categories, with a further category relating to the behaviour of the public. This is how the points are calculated.

**1. Red and Yellow Card (max. 10 marks):**

If a player who is on a yellow card (-1 point) commits another yellow card offence, only the red card will count (-3 points). But if a player who has already been cautioned then commits a red card offence, both cards will count (so the player will receive -4 points). This is the only section in which it is possible to receive a score below zero.

**2. Positive Play (max. 10 marks):**

This is designed to encourage attractive play that will increase the enjoyment of spectators and the following areas are taken into consideration:

Positive

- Using attacking tactics, not defensive
- Speeding up the game
- Efforts to gain time (e.g. bringing the ball back into play quickly even if the team is in a winning position)
- Continuing to push for goals when in a winning position

Negative

- Slowing down the game
- Time wasting
- Tactics based on foul play
- Play-acting (simulation)

**3. Respect towards the opponent (max. 5 marks):**

Players should respect the Laws of the Game and abide by the spirit of Fair Play. The Fair Play delegate's assessment will not double count items already covered in the 'Red and Yellow cards' category, but the seriousness of the offences punished by cards may be considered. This category will also include offences overlooked by the referee. Any single major incident between players may have a significant bearing on the final score.

**4. Respect towards the referee (max. 5 marks):**

Players are expected to respect the officials - including assistants - at all times. The Fair Play delegate's assessment will not double count items already covered in the 'Red and Yellow cards' but the seriousness of the offences punished by cards may be considered. Any single major incident may have a significant bearing on the score. A positive attitude, including the acceptance of doubtful decisions without protest, will be rewarded with high marks

**5. Behaviour of the officials (max. 5 marks):**

Team officials, including coaches, are expected to develop the sporting, technical and tactical level of their team – and instruct players to behave in accordance with the Fair Play principles. Positive and negative aspects of the team officials' conduct will be assessed – such as whether they calm down or provoke angry players or fans and how they accept the decisions of the referee. Co-operation with the media will also be taken into account. Any single major incident may have a significant bearing on the final mark, as will breaches of the regulations governing the dugout and technical area.

For categories 1-5, the overall assessment of a team is obtained by adding up the points given for the individual categories, dividing this sum by the maximum points score (40) and multiplying it by 10.

Total Number of points (x 10 / (40\*)).

In addition, there is one further category assessed by the Fair Play delegate

**6. Behaviour of the crowd (max. 5 marks):**

All teams begin with a score of 5 points. A maximum of a further 5 points can be added for:

- Verbal support in acceptable form
- Covert recognition of outstanding play by the opponents

A maximum of 5 points can be deducted for:

- Persistent foul and abusive language
- Persistent abuse of the officials' decisions
- Aggressive and threatening conduct towards opposing fans
